THREE FRISCO HOMERS NOT ENOUGH IN WALK-OFF LOSS TO HOOKS:

The Frisco RoughRiders pounded three home runs, but fell Thursday night to the Corpus Christi Hooks 7-6 on a walk-off homer from Will Bush, from Whataburger Field. Frisco (13-11) wasted no time getting to Hooks (11-13) starter James Hicks in the first when both **John Taylor** and **Corey Joyce** blasted two-run home runs, putting the Riders ahead 4-0. The Hooks immediately countered with four runs of their own to tie the game in the home half of the first, but **Dylan Dreiling** plated a run with an RBI single in the second to re-grab the lead 5-4. The score held until the sixth when Mason Lytle pased a two-run double to put Corpus Christi ahead 6-5. **Max Wagner**, in his first game with the RoughRiders, then tied the contest with a solo home run to left field. In the bottom of the ninth with one out, **Ryan Lobus** (2-2) allowed the Bush walk-off home run to left-center, snapping Frisco's five-game winning streak. Amilcar Chirinos (1-0) recorded the final two outs of the ninth to earn the win for Corpus Christi.

AN AMAZING MONTH IN THE BOOKS:

With the first month of the season done, the Riders can look back at an extremely successful April on offense. Frisco's 33 home runs in the month were the most since May of 2022 (44 home runs in 26 games, the most in recorded franchise history since 2005), while they slashed .276/.362/.458/.820 and averaged 6.5 runs per game (recorded franchise record, min. 24 games in a month) with an RoughRiders April record 156 runs. Their .820 OPS was the third-best full month in recorded franchise history, trailing just June of 2007 (.892) and April of 2008 (.846). **Keyber Rodriguez's** 29 hits came within 1 of the April RoughRiders record of 30 (done 6 times, most recently by **Luisangel Acuña** in 2023). **Frainyer Chavez** scored 24 runs in the month, setting a new recorded franchise record in April (breaking the previous record of 21 by **Alejandro Osuna** in 2025). **Orlando Martinez's** 10 doubles are a Riders April recorded franchise record and tied for the fifth-most in a month ever.

DAVALILLO DEALING DIMES:

RoughRiders starter **David Davalillo** threw the first quality start of the season for the RoughRiders on Sunday against Tulsa, striking out 10 over 6.0 shutout innings. His 10 strikeouts tied a career best and were the most in a start for the RoughRiders since **Leandro Lopez** struck out 10 on July 24th, 2025 at Wichita. On top of being just one of 10 Double-A starts this year with 10 or more strikeouts, it was just the 6th time in recorded franchise history (since 2005) that a RoughRiders starter whiffed 10 in the month of April, when most starters are still ramping up their pitch count. **Kohl Drake** dropped 10 K's over 4.1 innings in a April 23rd start last year, but before that, **Emerson Martinez** was the last RoughRiders starter to K 10 in April, doing so on April 18th, 2019 against Midland. The Frisco strikeout record holder is **Robbie Erlin**, who chopped down 14 Corpus Christi Hooks via strikeout on June 26th, 2011.

THAT OFFENSE WOKE UP FROM A SLUMBER:

The RoughRiders have been swinging the bat well in their last 6 games, going 5-1. During the stretch, it's been the Frisco offense that's helped them to victory, scoring 49 runs to lead the league (8.2 R/G), slashing .276/.375/.469/.844 with 8 home runs. The Riders have scored in the first inning in every game, totalling 18 runs in the initial frame during the last 6 games. Frisco's 31 runs in the first inning this year are the tied for the most in the minors, hitting a MiLB best .351 (34-for-97) in the first with 6 home runs. On Wednesday, the Riders scored 10 runs, marking the 6th time in the month they had scored at least 10 runs in a game. It was the first time the Riders had done so 6 times in a month since April 2023.

ORLANDO, WHERE DREAMS COME TRUE:

Riders outfielder **Orlando Martinez** has been one of the best hitters in the league this year. After collecting five doubles in the first two games of this series combined, he is tied for the Texas League lead with 10 two-baggers. He places 7th in the league with a .314 batting average, T-9th in RBIs (17), 6th in hits (27) and T-6th in extra-base hits (12). In his last 14 games, he is batting .357 (20-for-56)/.419/.643/1.062 with 10 doubles, 2 homers, 14 RBIs and 9 runs. The owner of nine multi-hit games this year, he has not hit safely in more than three games in a row this year.

LEE SANG IT AND BANG IT:

Marcus Lee Sang has helped to carry the Frisco offense in the last three weeks. In his last 13 games, he has slashed .419 (18-for-43)/.519/.791/1.310 with 4 doubles, 4 home runs and 13 RBIs. In a two-home run game in Amarillo on April 16th, he hit a lazer that was 113 mph off the bat and a moonshot over the batters' eye, which went an estimated 466 feet. He lifted a go-ahead, two-run home run at Corpus Christi. The former Phillies farmhand is now hitting .329/.410/.548/.958 in 21 games to start the season while ranking 5th in the league in batting average (.329), 8th in SLG (.548) and 7th in OPS (.958).

YOU WANT THE HITS, WE GOT UM:

Through 24 games the RoughRiders are 1st in the Texas League with 225 hits. They are first in the league in batting average (.276) and 1st in runs (156, 6.5 runs per game). The RoughRiders have not led the Texas League in batting average since 2014. The Riders are 2nd in the Texas League in homers (33) while they are 2nd in SLG (.458) and 2nd in OPS (.820). For perspective, the Yankees led MLB last year with a .787 team OPS. The Riders and Drillers are the only two teams in the Texas League with 6 players carrying an .800 or better OPS with at least 50 at-bats.

VS. CORPUS CHRISTI:

The Riders went 12-11 against the Hooks in 2025 and have gone 36-19 (.654) against the Astros affiliate since the start of 2024. Since 2021, the Riders are 62-44 (.596) against Corpus Christi despite their losing record against the Hooks in their franchise history (286-290). In both 2024 and 2025 combined, the Hooks' .366 winning percentage is worst in all of Minor League Baseball.

-Tends to throw slider as his most-used pitch.

-Hometown of Bonao is the same hometown as former RoughRiders pitcher and current Miami Marlin Ronny Henriquez and 12-year MLB reliever Joel Peralta.

2026 SEASON

-Opened the season as the No. 14 prospect in the Rangers organization.

-Started the year with 4.2 no-hit innings against Corpus Christi as the Opening Day starter.

2025 SEASON

-Dominated in May, going 1-2 over four starts with a 1.61 ERA. Over 22.1 IP, he allowed 15 hits while surrendering six runs (four earned) and walking four to 23 strikeouts.

-Among those with at least 60 IP in the South Atlantic League, Lopez ranked second in ERA (2.19), fifth in strikeout rate (28.2%), sixth in opponent batting average (.197), fifth in Left on Base Rate (76.8%), first in ground ball rate (51.3%) and seventh in swinging strike rate (14.3%).

-Promoted to Frisco on July 20th, 2025.

-Finished the season 2nd in the Rangers organization with a 2.40 ERA (Josh Trentadue led the way with a 2.34 ERA), tied for 3rd with 116 strikeouts and 7th in innings pitched with 101.1.

-Along with teammate David Davalillo, Lopez was one of 12 MiLB pitchers to throw at least 100 innings and have an ERA under 2.50.

-Lopez (along with Davalillo) was one of 15 MiLB pitchers last year with at least 100 innings pitched, 22 games started and an under .200 batting average against (.198).

-Only 5 MiLB pitchers accomplished both of the feats in the last two bullets, two of them were Lopez and Davalillo.

2024 SEASON

-Missed most of 2024 with right forearm injury. Placed on the 7-Day Injured List on 5/26 and was transferred to the 60-Day Injured List on 7/24.

-Following the season, he was activated from the Injured List to pitch in the Arizona Fall League. With the Surprise Saguaros, he owned a 5.21 ERA while striking out 24 batters in 19.0 innings.

-AFL: On 11/1 at Peoria, struck out seven batters over 3.0 scoreless innings to earn AFL Co-Pitcher of the Week (with fellow FRI pitcher Josh Stephan).

2023 SEASON

-In first state-side season, threw career-best 57.0 IP for Low-A Down East.

-His 12.47 K/9 ranked 11th among Carolina League pitchers (min. 50.0 IP).

2022 SEASON

-Was named a Dominican Summer League Mid-Season All-Star

CHAD COMER

Years with Rangers: 10

Years with RoughRiders: 2 (1st as manager)

Comer returns to Double-A Frisco in 2026 after managing at the High-A level over the last three seasons. The native of Mansfield, Texas will enter his 10th season with the Rangers and his second in Frisco.

In 2022, Comer helped pilot the Riders to their second Texas League Championship in franchise history, serving as a development coach. Over the last three seasons, Comer managed High-A Hickory (2023-2024) and High-A Hub City (2025), going 197-191 (.508).

Prior to Frisco, Comer was the hitting coach for the High-A Hickory Crawdads in 2021, after serving as a coach at various levels of the Rangers system from 2016-2019.

The former University of Texas at Arlington catcher played two seasons in the Atlanta Braves organization, reaching High-A Lynchburg in 2012. He was drafted by Atlanta in the 29th round of the 2011 draft after four seasons at UTA.

THOMAS ST. CLAIR

Years with Rangers: 5

Years with RoughRiders: 1

St. Clair joins the Riders as the pitching coach after leading a Hub City staff that finished third in the SAL with a 3.50 ERA in 2025. St. Clair also will serve as the assistant pitching coordinator in the Rangers farm system in 2026.

Initially, St. Clair came to the Rangers as a coach in the Dominican Summer League in 2022 before serving as a pitching coach for the ACL Rangers from 2022-23. Before professional baseball, he spent two and a half years as pitching coach and recruiting coordinator at North Carolina Wesleyan College.

The right-hander pitched three professional seasons in the St. Louis Cardinals system from 2017-19 after he was picked in the 24th round of the 2017 June draft, making 88 outings for the organization's Rookie and Single-A affiliates.

The Winston-Salem, North Carolina native played four years (2014-17) at Division II Lenior-Rhyne University in Hickory, N.C.

HITTING COACH

JASON HART

Years with Rangers: 13

Years with RoughRiders: 9

Hart returns as the hitting coach in Frisco for the first time since he served as the RoughRiders hitting coach from 2012-2019. Before that, most recently, he was the Major League hitting assistant for the Miami Marlins under current Rangers manager Skip Schumaker.

In 2015, Hart was named the Mike Coolbaugh Texas League Coach of the Year for his work with the Riders hitters. Prior to joining Frisco, Hart spent two seasons as the hitting coach with Low-A Hickory. His tenure with the Rangers began after he assisted the Single-A Clinton staff with coaching responsibilities for a portion of the 2008 season and continued when he accepted the role of hitting coach for the Arizona Rangers before the 2009 campaign.

Hart played professionally for parts of eight seasons from 1998-2006, with stints in the Oakland, Texas and Minnesota organizations. He made his Major League debut with the Rangers in 2002, when he batted .267 (4-for-15) with three doubles over a span of 10 games. He missed the 2004 campaign following the removal of a benign brain tumor, but returned to the field in 2005 and hit 21 home runs in 128 games with Frisco.

Originally drafted by Oakland in the fifth round of the 1998 draft, Hart was acquired by Texas in a January 2002 trade with the Athletics. He attended Southwest Missouri State University, where he paced the conference in homers in 1997 and was named a Missouri Valley Conference All-Star in 1998.

Hernandez joins the RoughRiders for his first season with the Rangers organization.

During 2020, Hernandez managed the Texas Collegiate League Frisco RoughRiders after the MiLB season had been canceled. In 2025, he served as a bench coach for Triple-A Jacksonville and spent 19 seasons with the Marlins as a coach and coordinator. As part of that stint, he served eight seasons as a manager, most recently in 2022 with High-A Beloit.

Hernandez started his coaching career at the University of Mobile in 1993 as a hitting coach and stayed there through 2001. From 2005-2006, Hernandez served as the hitting coach for the Independent Pensacola Pelicans.

Sullenger joins the Riders in 2026 as the Development Coach. He made his professional managerial debut in 2021, leading the ACL Rangers.

Before joining the professional ranks, Sullenger led the baseball program as head coach at Biola University in La Mirada, California, from 2013-2018.

Additionally, he worked one season in stadium operations for the Tampa Bay Rays. Sullenger attended Spotswood (Va.) High School and went on to play baseball at Florida Southern College (one season) and Liberty University (three seasons).

He holds a bachelor's degree from Liberty and earned a master's degree in Kinesiology with a focus in Athletic Administration/Coaching from James Madison in 2003.

Brown makes his Double-A debut in 2026. Before being the athletic trainer for High-A Hub City in 2025, Brown was the ACL Rangers athletic trainer in 2024.

Brown was also a student athletic trainer at Slinger (Wisc.) High School (2022) and Carroll University in Waukesha, Wisc. (2021).

The Louisville, Ky. native holds an associate's degree in Biology (McHenry County College), a Bachelor's degree in Exercise Science (Upper Iowa University), and a Master's in Athletic Training (Carroll University).

Platts is back with the RoughRiders for his third season and his fourth in the Rangers organization in 2026.

In his first year, he was the strength and conditioning coach for the Low-A Down East Wood Ducks before spending a season with the Cubs, working in the Dominican Summer League.
