WSH AFFILIATE NOTES

Double-A Harrisburg came out on top in a low-scoring pitchers duel last night, 3-2 over Chesapeake (BAL)...LF **SAM BROWN** homered and doubled in the win, going 2-for-4 with three RBI in the victory.

65 LOOKS GOOD ON YOU: Looking to build off of their 8-1 win on Wednesday, the Rochester Red Wings came back from a 5-2 deficit, scoring eight unanswered runs to win their International League-leading 65th game of the season 10-5...C **MAXWELL ROMERO JR.** homered twice and drove in four runs as part of a three-hit effort, while SS **TREY LIPSCOMB** notched his third consecutive multi-hit game...1B **RILEY ADAMS** extended his hitting streak to 10 games, going 1-for-4 with a double and two RBI...the Red Wings look to make it three-in-a-row and guarantee at least a series split tonight, sending LHP **JARED SIMPSON** to the mound against RailRiders right-hander Adam Kloffenstein...

65 wins are the most in Triple-A and third-most in Minor League Baseball, behind just Double-A Bowling Green (73, TB) and Tulsa (66, LAD).

HOMER-LESS SIMPSON: Making his sixth appearance and third start as a Red Wing tonight will be southpaw **JARED SIMPSON**...he turned in 1.0 scoreless inning of relief in Tuesday's series opener against the RailRiders, allowing one hit while striking out a pair and walking one...across five outings as the opener between Rochester and Double-A Harrisburg this season, Simpson has not allowed an earned run across 6.0 innings of work, allowing three hits with six strikeouts, a 1.17 WHIP and .143 BAA...tonight will be his first appearance with the Red Wings on Friday, a day of the week where he boasts' a 1.42 ERA (1 ER/6.1 IP) across five appearances (1 GS) with Double-A Harrisburg this season, notching 12 strikeouts (17.05 K/9) with a 0.79 WHIP and .087 BAA...
Simpson has allowed just three homers in 46.0 innings this season for 0.59 HR/9...he is one of 15 pitchers in the Nationals Minor League system to allow three or fewer homers with 40.0 or more innings pitched.

MAX-IMUM EFFORT: C **MAXWELL ROMERO JR.** powered the Red Wings offense last night, going 3-for-4 with a pair of home runs, four RBI to tie a career-high (4 on 5/3 vs. AKR, w/ HBG), a walk and two runs scored...it marked his fourth career multi-homer game, third of 2026 and first since 5/31 at Reading (PHI)...his second homer in the eighth came off the bat at 111.1 MPH, the ninth-hardest hit home run by a Red Wing this season...Romero Jr. has now picked up a hit in four of his last five games since 7/31 vs. SYR, going 7-for-20 (.350) with seven RBI, a 409 OBP and .900 SLG over that stretch...

The Florida native's eighth-inning homer was the hardest-hit home run by a visitor at PNC Field in 2026...the Red Wings offense owns four of the five hardest-hit homers by visitors against RailRiders pitching this season, and have now hit the most home runs of any visiting team (11).

TREY-FECTA: SS **TREY LIPSCOMB**, batting second in the order for the second time this year, picked up a trio of singles while driving in two runs to finish 3-for-6, while adding a walk and a pair of runs scored...he has now turned in a multi-hit performance in all three games of the series, and has hit safely in nine of his last 10 dating back to 7/26 at BUF...over his last 42 games dating back to 6/12, the Maryland native holds a share of the International League-lead with 58 total hits, ranks fifth with 94 total bases, and a .356 batting average behind teammate **PHILLIP GLASSER** (2nd, .373)...he is also in a four-way tie for sixth place in runs scored (32) with recently promoted Washington National Andrew Pinckney, ranks eighth in RBI (33), and 10th in SLG (.577) and OPS (.975)...Lipscomb's third and final hit last night was his 280th with Rochester, surpassing Jake Noll (279) for second-most by any Red Wing in the Statcast era (since 2015) behind Darren Baker (321).

LIFE OF RILEY: With a two-RBI double in the sixth inning last night, 1B **RILEY ADAMS** has now hit safely in 10 consecutive games for the first time since he notched a 12-game streak with Double-A New Hampshire (TOR) on 5/21-6/2 in 2019...it is tied for the third-longest active streak in the International League, and is the fifth hitting streak by a Red Wing to reach double digit games in 2026...since the streak began on 7/26, Adams ranks third among qualified IL hitters in batting average (.417), is T-3rd in hits (15) with **TREY LIPSCOMB**, and fifth in OBP (.488)...he is now just 10 hits shy of 150 at the Triple-A level in his professional career.

GLASS ACT: Although 3B **PHILLIP GLASSER** didn't register a hit in last night's offensive outburst, he still extended his on-base streak to 14 games, thanks to three free passes, he also scored two of Rochester's 10 runs...the three walks tied his career high for a single game, which he has done three other times (last 9/21/25 at WDR)...three walks are tied for the most by a Red Wing since Frammil Reyes drew four on 5/29/2023 vs. SYR...the Canton, Ohio native is slashing .298/.484/.340 with 15 walks during the 14 game stretch...

Glasser's first and only home run this season came off of Scranton W/B starter today, RHP Adam Kloffenstein, on 4/24 at SWB.

CALL TO ARMS: The Red Wings bullpen held Scranton/WB scoreless on just two hits across the final 4.0 innings last night...RHP **RILEY CORNELIO** came on first and turned in 2.0 hitless frames with four strikeouts, before RHP **EDDY YEAN** and RHP **JACK SINCLAIR** each logged 1.0 scoreless frame to finish things off...since returning from the All-Star break on 7/17, Red Wings relievers own the best ERA (2.59) in the International League and third-best among full-season Minor League teams...they also own a share of the IL lead (T-8th in MILB) with 107 strikeouts, and rank second in the IL behind Gwinnett (.209) with a .211 BAA over that stretch...

RHP **GUS VARLAND** is one of 13 IL relievers who have not allowed an earned run while logging at least 5.0 innings since the ASB.

RED WINGS REWIND...

...1933: 93 years ago tonight, the Red Wings played their first night game at Red Wing Stadium against the Newark Bears in front of about 15,000 fans, but fell 4-0...this came two years prior to the first Major League game under the lights between the Philadelphia Phillies and Cincinnati Reds at Crosley Field on 5/24/1935...the lights at Red Wing stadium were so bright, people could read the paper on the porches of Norton Street without any problem.

Entering his fourth professional season, all with the Nationals organization after he was selected in the eighth round of the 2023 MLB Draft out of the University of Iowa.

- Slated to make his third start and fifth appearance overall in game four of this six-game set down in Scranton. The left-hander has logged 6.1 innings to the tune of a 2.84 ERA, and hasn't allowed a run in five games as an opener between Double-A Harrisburg and Triple-A Rochester this season.
- Transferred to Rochester for his Triple-A debut on 7/19, after spending the entire season with Double-A Harrisburg...logged 33 appearances (3 GS, first of pro career) with a 2.04 ERA (9 ER/39.2 IP), while striking out 48 with a 1.36 WHIP and .182 BAA.
- Slated to make his second start with Rochester tonight...coming off his first start in game one on 7/30 (1.0 IP, 0 ER).
- At the time of his promotion, ranked sixth among all Eastern League pitchers (min. 25.0 IP) in ERA, and T-12th in BAA...led all Harrisburg pitchers in appearances.
- Did not allow an earned run through 10 appearances dating from 6/16 to 7/17, and 16 of his last 17 since 5/19...boasts a 0.82 ERA (2 ER/22.0 IP) with 23 strikeouts, a 1.00 WHIP and .137 BAA since 5/19.
- Has appeared in 86 career games (3 GS) with a 4.16 ERA (49 ER/106.0 IP), 133 strikeouts, 92 walks and a .195 BAA.

- Registered his first and only MLB save on April 8, 2024, vs. AZ.
- Has pitched in 262.2 Major League innings for Colorado and New York-AL.

- Sixth in the IL among qualified pitchers in ERA (4.00) and fourth in wins (7).
- Has made 127 appearances (113 GS) across his MiLB career, having just crossed 500 innings pitched in his final outing of 2025.
- Picked up his sixth win of the season and 30th of his professional career his last time out on 7/11 at Worcester, carrying a no-hitter into the sixth before finishing with 6.0 full, one-hit innings while allowing one earned with three strikeouts and a pair of walks.
- Across three Saturday games this season (2 GS), the soon-to-be 27-year-old is 2-0 with a 1.80 ERA (3 ER/15.0 IP), a 0.47 WHIP, .104 BAA, and a BB/9 of 1.20.
