

# **HUDSON VALLEY RENEGADES (19-17, 19-17)**

MORABITO FUEL: OF Nick Morabito has reached safely all 10 games since making his High-A and Cyclones debut on May 7 at Rome and enters play on Tuesday riding a 21-game on-base streak dating back to his time in the Florida State League...Since the streak began on April 20, the third-year pro is hitting .437/.545/.493/1.038 with 16 runs scored, four doubles, four RBI, and 19 stolen bases...The now 21-year-old leads Minor League Baseball in on-base percentage (.510)...He is also second in batting average (.383), fourth in wOBA (.48), fifth in wRC+ (193), and tied for fifth in stolen bases (23).... Morabito has also collected a six-game hitting streak since last Sunday...He is 10-for-23 (.435) with five runs scored, two doubles, three walks, and 10 stolen bases...Morabito stole three bases last Wednesday and did it again last Saturday...That mark is tied for the most by a Cyclone in the previous 23 years...The McLean, Va. native enters the day tied for seventh in the South Atlantic League in stolen bases (12) despite playing just 10 games.

JONAH'S WHALE OF A START: RHP Jonah Tong's stretch of innings to start the year without allowing an earned run came to a close on May 8 at Rome at 26.0 frames... In eight appearances (six starts) between St. Lucie and Brooklyn, the 20-year-old is I-O with a 0.86 ERA (3 ER in 31.1 IP)...Tong is third among qualifiers in Minor League Baseball in ERA (0.86)...The Markham, Ont. native is also fourth among qualifiers in Mil.B in strikeout rate (39.5%) and his strikeout-to-walk rate (28.7%) is ninth...Tong's 51 strikeouts are tied for 18th-most in the minors for 18th-most in the minors.

**BROOKLYN BOUND:** Brooklyn made roster moves ahead of Tuesday's series opener...RHP **Kade Morris** was transferred from Single-A St. Lucie and INF **Mateo Gil** was transferred from Double-A Binghamton...Morris was the Mets' third-round pick last year, departing the Florida State League ranked sixth in innings pitched (34.2) and 10th in ERA (3.63)...Overall, the 21-year-old was 0-3 with a 3.63 ERA (14 ER in 34.2 IP), II walks, and 38 strikeouts in seven starts...He is ranked as the Mets' No. 21 prospect per Baseball America...Gil returns to the Cyclones after starting the year on Coney Island...In 12 games with Brooklyn, the 23-year-old was 8-for-37 at the plate (.216) with two home runs and five RBI...Gil was 2-for-14 (.143) with a home run in four contests at Double-A

BINGO!: The Cyclones transferred OF Omar De Los Santos and TWP Nolan Mc-**Lean** to Double-A Binghamton prior to Tuesday's series opener...De Los Santos departs Brooklyn as the franchise's single-season (37) and all-time (59) stolen base leader... The 24-year-old was second in the South Atlantic League and tied for second in Minor League Baseball with 25 steals at the time of his promotion...McLean homered in his final game with the Cyclones on Sunday and accrued a 2-1 record with a 0.82 ERA (2 ER in 22.0 IP) in his final five starts...The Willow Springs, N.C. native had 12 extra-base hits in 74 plate earances, 20 fewer than any other player with that total in the circuit.

LARRUPIN' LORUSSO: INF Nick Lorusso has quietly been one of the top hitters in the South Atlantic League in 2024...The Connecticut native's season-long hitting streak was snapped at nine on May 11 and his team season-high-tying on-base streak was snapped at 12 in the opening game of Thursday's doubleheader....The 23-year-old is tied for fourth in the South Atlantic League in triples (2) and tied for seventh in doubles (9)... Among Mets' minor leaguers, Lorusso is tied for second in doubles (9), tied for third in triples (2), tied for fourth in extra-base hits (14), tied for fifth in RBI (21), ninth in slugging (.461), and 10th in total bases (53).

GET THOSE STEPS IN: The Cyclones' offense worked a season-high 12 walks in Saturday's win over Bowling Green...Brooklyn's previous season-high was 11 on April 21 art Jersey Shore and April 24 vs. Wilmington...Saturday's 12 free passes tied the Cyclones' franchise record...Brooklyn also coaxed 12 team walks on April 7, 2023, vs. Jersey Shore and on August 11, 2016, vs. Vermont...Individually, INF **William Lugo** has accumulated walks in droves in 2024...Lugo's 30 free passes are tied for third most in the league...Lugo's 20.7% walk rate is also fifth in the league and 14th in all of Minor League Baseball.

RUNNING WILD AND FREE: Brooklyn swiped a season-high seven bases in last Saturday's triumph at Bowling Green...LF Omar De Los Santos and RF Nick Morabito each stole three bases, while CF Stanley Consuegra added a single swipe...The Cyclones' previous season-best was four on three occasions, most recently on May 8 at Rome...Brooklyn fell one stolen bag shy of matching the franchise record of eight set on August 2, 2017, vs. Tir-City...DH Walter Rasquin and RF José Moule Medina cach at the three bases in that affeir while 2P Edeards Ferring and CF Quien Product. each stole three bases in that affair, while 2B **Edgardo Fermín** and CF **Quinn Brodey** snatched the other two...The seven steals were the most in a game for the Cyclones since they also stole seven bases on August 15, 2018, vs. Vermont...During last week's

vs. HUDSON VALLEY: Brooklyn returns home to play a six-game series against the Yankees' High-A affiliate...The Renegades possess four of New York-AL's top 30 prospects per MLB Pipeline: LHP **Kyle Carr** (11), INF Roc Riggio (18), INF Jared Serna (19), and OF Jace Avina (28)...The Cyclones went 14-10 against Hudson Valley in 2023, including a 6-6 record at Maimonides Park and a 8-4 mark at Heritage Financial Park in Wappingers Falls...Since 2001, Brooklyn is 140-144 all-time (.493) against Hudson Valley in 284 matchups.

START ME UP: The Cyclones' starting rotation has been one of the best in Minor League Baseball in 2024...Brooklyn holds the best ERA for starting pitchers in the South Atlantic League at 2.74...The Cyclones have the only starting staff with a sub-3.00 ERA in the circuit and hold a mark 0.68 runs better than the next team (Aberdeen; 3.42)...That ERA is also third at the High-A level and seventh among full-season MiLB squads...Cleveland's Double-A Akron holds the best mark in the minors (2.27), while Detroit's High-A West Michigan (2.38) possesses the best ERA at the level...The Cyclones' 11.26 strikeouts-per-nine implinger ratio is also sixth-best in Mil B and second-highest at the High-A level nings ratio is also sixth-best in MiLB and second-highest at the High-A leve

ORELLANA'S OVERWHELMING START: RHP Douglas Orellana set a personal and ORELLANA'S OVERWHELMING START: RHP Douglas Orellana set a personal and team season-high with 10 strikeouts on May 11 at Rome and continued his impressive start to 2024 on Friday night...Orellana is tied for ninth among South Atlantic League pitchers with 41 strikeouts...Additionally, among arms with 29.0+ innings of work, Orellana is second in the league in ERA (1.23) and ranks third in opposing OPS (.475), fifth in batting average against (.165), and sixth in WHIP (0.99)...Orellana's 1.23 ERA (4 ER in 291 IP) is the sixth-lowest in Minor League Baseball among pitchers with 29.0+ innings of work...The 22-year-old whiffed 10 in his start against the Emperors, the second double-digit strikeout game of his career...The Caraças, Venezuela native punched out a career-high 11 over four frames in Game 2 of a doubleheader for the Florida Complex League Mets on July 14, 2022...Orellana was the first Cyclone to strike out 10+ hitters in a single game since RHP Robert Colina punched out 10 in six innings in a win at Greenville on September 2, 2023.

HOME COOKING: The Cyclones enter play on Tuesday with a 12-6 record at Maimonides Park, but a 8-13 record in opposing ballparks...So far in 2024, Brooklyn holds the sixth-best home ERA (2.32) in Minor League Baseball...Chicago-AL's Double-A Birmingham (2.01) has the lowest mark in MiLB...Additionally, the Cyclones are fifth in opposing OPS (.570) and tied for sixth in batting average against (.200) in home games...In visiting parks, the Cyclones ERA is 4.70..They also maintain a .685 opposing OPS and a .245 batting average against on the road.

KING STANLEY: OF Stanley Consuegra is Brooklyn's all-time leader in several categories, including 71 extra-base hits, 31 home runs, and 103 RBL...The 23-year-old is also four hits away (160) from matching OF Alex Ramírez's (164) franchise record for base knocks...He is also four doubles (34) from matching Ramírez's franchise mark (38)...On the final day of the 2023 regular season, he broke a tie with C Francisco Alvarez for Brooklyn's single-season home run record (23)...Consuegra also surpassed Alvarez (22) for the franchise record in career home runs on August 23 at Asheville...The Dominican native also broke the franchise's single-season record for extra-base hits (42) and tied the mark for RBI (63) set by Ronny Mauricio in 2021.

A THOUSAND VICTORIES: Brooklyn's 2-1 victory at Rome on May 11 marked the 1.000th in Cyclones' franchise history...Brooklyn has record a mark of 1,002-847 (542) in 1,849 games since 2001...May 7's 6-2 victory in Rome marked the franchise's 200th since joining the South Atlantic League in 2021...The Cyclones are 204-216 (.486) in 420 games...Brooklyn captured its 900th franchise victory with a 6-5 triumph over Wilmington on August 14, 2022...Brooklyn's very first win came in a 3-2 victory on June 19, 2001, at Jamestown.

ATOP THE HEJ-ES: RHP Josh Hejka earned his first save of the season on May 5 vs. Aberdeen, making his Cyclones' franchise-record-setting 48th pitching appearance in the process...The 27-year-old broke a tie with **Hunter Parsons** (47) for the most pitching appearances in Cyclones franchise history...In his 52 career outings for Brooklyn since 2019, Hejka has accumulated a 5-1 record with a 2.62 ERA (24 ER in 82.1 IP) and 4 saves, walking list 21 and striking out 72 just 21 and striking out 72.

AMAZIN' STARTS HERE: The Brooklyn Cyclones have several Top 30 prospects according to Baseball America and MLB Pipeline...The 'Clones have three of the Top 30 per BA: Kade Morris (21), Jonah Tong (22) and Calvin Ziegler (29)...Ziegler is currently on the full-season injured list...Plus four of the Top 30 per MLB: Tong (20), Ziegler (23) Wilfredo Lara (24), and OF Nick Morabito (26).

LAST TIME OUT: Collected his fourth-straight no-decision last Wednesday afternoon at Bowling Green...Surrendered a season-high three runs (two earned) on a career-high five hits in a season-low 3.2 innings...Walked two and struck out four...Tossed a pair of wild pitches...Hurled a season-high 89 pitches and 57 strikes (64.04%)...Relieved by RHP **Jawilme** Ramírez with the bases loaded and two out in the bottom of the fourth and Brooklyn trailing 3-0...All three bequeathed runners were stranded...Cyclones rallied to take a 4-3 lead, but ultimately fell to the Hot Rods, 14-5.

PROSPECT RADAR: Tong is considered the New York Mets' No. 22 prospect in 2024 according to Baseball America and No. 20 by MLB Pipeline...The 20-year-old is the highest-rated prospect on the Cyclones' roster.

2023: After he did not pitch in 2022 after being drafted, Tong started the campaign and made his professional debut in the Florida Complex League...Registered an 0-1 record with a 6.39 ERA (9 ER in 12.2 IP), 13 walks, and 25 strikeouts in seven appearances (five starts)...Transferred to Single-A St. Lucie on August 22...Composed an 0-1 mark with a 5.40 ERA (5 ER in 8.1 IP), nine walks, and 13 strikeouts in three starts...Returned to the FCL Mets on September 7.

TRAVELING MAN: A native of Canada, Tong's journey to professional baseball has included a lot of travel...After attending Bill Crothers Secondary School in Unionville, Ont., Tong moved on Georgia Premier Academy in Statesboro, Ga. for his final high school season...Prior to the 2022 draft, Tong participated in the MLB Draft League as a member of the Frederick (Md.) Keys...Accumulated an O-1 record with a 10.80 ERA (14 ER in 11.2 IP), 10 walks, and 14 K's in four outings (three starts)...Was a teammate of Aberdeen's RHP Zachary Fruit and former Cyclones and current Double-A Binghamton RHP Jordan Geber, whose rotation spot he is taking...He was also committed to North Dakota State University before signing his professional contract.
