SOMERSET PATRIOTS NOTES

- The Somerset Patriots opened up a six-game series on the road against the Binghamton Rumble Ponies, winning on Tuesday night at Mirabito Stadium by a final score of 7-6.
 - The win was powered by Somerset’s first three-home run game of the season, including the go-ahead and game-decisive home runs on back-to-back pitches in the ninth inning by Carlos Narvaez and Delvin Perez.
 - The sequence marked the Patriots’ first set of back-to-back home runs this season, after accomplishing the feat four times in 2022, first doing it on May 29 last season.
 - The win was Somerset’s second of the season when having overcome a three-run deficit (4/7).
 - It was also the Patriots’ second win of the season when tied after seven innings (4/7).
 - The Patriots’ pitching staff struck out a season-high 14 batters and walked a season-high 12 batters in the contest.
 - Improved to 9-9 all-time vs. Binghamton.
- **RHP Blane Abeyta** (3.0 IP, 1 H, 2 R, 2 ER, 5 BB, 6 K) started in his Double-A debut and did not record a decision.
- **3B Tyler Hardman** (1-for-4, HR, 2 RBI, 2 R, K) hit his second home run of the season, a game-tying two-run in shot in the top of the 4th inning—one half-inning after Binghamton took the game’s initial 2-0 lead.
 - Hardman extends his streak as the only Patriot this season to have hit safely in every game he has played.
- **LF Everson Pereira** (2-for-4, R, BB, K) secured his second multi-hit game of the season, becoming the first Patriot to do so in 2023.
 - Pereira also reached base safely three times for the first time this season.
- **DH Carlos Narvaez** (1-for-4, HR, 3 RBI, R, 2 K) hit the go-ahead three-run home run in the top of the 9th inning that gave the Patriots a 6-5 lead, after they fell behind 5-3 in the last half-inning.
 - The home run marked Narvaez’s first Double-A hit, home run, RBI and run scored.
- **2B Delvin Perez** (1-for-4, HR, RBI, R, 2 K) homered on the next pitch after Narvaez, which proved to be the decisive run in the game.
 - The home run was the first in Delvin Perez’s Yankees organizational career, in his second game with the Patriots.
- **RHP Justin Maese** (1.2 IP, 3 R, 3 ER, 3 H, HR, BB, K) earned his first win as a member of the Yankees organization, after allowing two runs (three total, one inherited charged to Alex Mauricio) in the 8th inning, which broke a 2-2 tie to give Binghamton a 5-2 lead entering the 9th inning.
