## **CONINE HOMERS AGAIN, JAX WINS 7-4**

Griffin Conine homered for the fourth straight day as Jacksonville earned a series win on Sunday with a 7-4 victory over Charlotte. The Jumbo Shrimp jumped out to a lead with a four-run second courtesy of a Conine RBI single, Jonathan Davis RBI double and two-run single from Javier Sanoja. Conine crushed a two-run bomb in the third. After the Knights scored two in their half of the third, Troy Johnston collected an RBI single in the fourth. Michael Chavis went vard in the bottom of the fourth. A Charlotte run in the eighth set things at 7-4.

### BACK ON THE RIGHT PATH?

After getting swept in a doubleheader at Charlotte on Thursday, Jacksonville was just 9-22 (.290) in its previous 31 games. The Jumbo Shrimp responded with three consecutive wins to take the series against the Knights - the club's second series win in their last three sets. On the season, Jacksonville is 4-1-0 over their five road series. They are just 1-4-1 in their six home sets, losing three consecutive series with a 3-15 (.167) record during that span.

## X MARKS THE SPOT

In 2023, Xavier Edwards registered one of the most illustrious seasons in Jacksonville's Triple-A/Double-A history (1962-present). His .351 batting average was the best in club single-season history, with his .429 on-base percentage ranking second. After an injury scuttled the beginning of his season, Edwards has picked up right where he left off in 2024. The Coconut Creek, Fla., native has hits in 11 of his first 13 games with the Jumbo Shrimp, compiling a remarkable seven multi-hit contests. In all, he is 19-for-52. slashing .365/.411/.481/.892 with four doubles, one triple, three RBIs, four walks and four runs scored.

## FRIENDS CLOSE, ENEMIES CLOSER

A remarkable 40 of Jacksonville's 63 games (63.4 percent) in 2024 have been decided by three runs or fewer, including 22 of the club's last 32 contests. After beginning the year 12-3 (.750) in these narrowly-decided contests, the Jumbo Shrimp have suddenly struggled in games determined by no more than three runs: Jacksonville has lost 20 of its last 25 games decided by three runs or fewer for an overall record of 17-23 (.425) in these affairs.

## **ROAD IS WHERE THE HEART IS?**

Jacksonville's 11-22 (.333) home record is the worst such mark in the IL, while the club's 17-13 (.556) road record is one of only six winning away records in the circuit this year. On the road, the Jumbo Shrimp have scored 160 runs in 29 games (5.3 per game), more than a full run better than what they average at home (134 runs in 33 games, 4.1 per game). The Jumbo Shrimp have surrendered 181 runs (11th-most in Triple-A) in 33 home games (5.5 per game) compared to 135 (tied for sixth-fewest) on the road (4.5 per game).

### GRIFFIN-DOR, WHERE DWELL THE BRAVE AT HEART

In eight games from April 26-May 5, Jacksonville outfielder Griffin Conine suffered through a 2-for-30 (.067) stretch with 12 strikeouts. In the 29 games since, however, the former Duke Blue Devil has gotten hot. Conine is 31-forhis-last-94, slashing .330/.434/.713/1.147 with six doubles, 10 home runs, 28 RBIs, 18 walks and 21 runs scored, He's homered on four consecutive gamedays - the longest streak since Tristan Gray went yard in five straight games from April 2-6. Among the 126 qualified hitters in the IL, Conine ranks 11th in HR/FB (28.3 percent). The 26-year-old has has driven in at least one run in 18 of those 29 games, with multiple RBIs in eight contests.

## LITTLE GUY, BIG RESULTS

Over his first 11 games in Triple-A, Javier Sanoja was just 6-for-39 (.154) at the plate. However, the 5-foot-7 Venezuelan struck out in only two plate appearances. His contact ability has manifested itself in a huge way of late; Sanoja has reached base safely in 27 of his last 30 games, notching 15 multi-hit contests. During this span, he is 45for-121 (.372/.426/.554/.980) with 10 doubles, three triples, two home runs, 22 RBIs, 13 walks and 19 runs scored. Among the 211 IL hitters with at least 110 PA, Sanoja has posted the highest opposite-field rate (51.0 percent) and the fourth-lowest swinging-strike rate (4.0 percent).

Jacksonville has homered in six consecutive games, their most since going vard in 13 straight contests from July 1-18. 2023... Kyle Tyler has yielded two runs or fewer in each of his last four starts. Over that span, he is 2-1 with a 2.37 ERA (19.0 IP, 14 H, 5 R, 5 ER, 8 BB, 13 K, .215 BAA).

## **ABOUT KYLE**

-Tyler was originally selected by the Los Angeles Angels in the 20th round of the 2018 draft out of the University of Oklahoma.

-In March and April 2022, Tyler was designated for assignment and claimed five different times, finally ending up in the San Diego Padres' organization.

-Tyler made his MLB debut on September 5, 2021 for the Angels in a game against the Texas Rangers. He went 3.0 scoreless innings, yielding one hit and striking out two in a 7-3 Texas victory.

-Following the 2023 season, Tyler signed a minor league deal on November 28,2023 with the Miami Marlins.

## 2023 SEASON

-Tyler posted neutral platoon splits. In 272 plate appearances, left-handed hitters batted .293/.369/.418/.787 against him. Comparatively, in 345 plate appearances, right-handed batters hit .280/.345/.447/.792 against him.

Tyler closed the season strong. In three September starts, he went 1-0 with a 2.60 ERA. Over 17.1 innings, he ceded 16 hits (.232 batting average against) with 19 strikeouts against five walks.

## 2022 SEASON

-Tyler threw a total of 29.1 innings between the San Diego Padres, Triple-A  $\rm El$  Paso and Triple-A Sacramento.

-Tyler became a free agent on July 6, 2022 after the Padres designated him for assignment on July 3. He signed a minor league contract with the San Francisco Giants on July 13 and finished the season in their organization with Triple-A Sacramento.

## 2021 SEASON

-In 12 starts with Rocket City, compiled a 5-2 record and  $3.14\,\mathrm{ERA}.$  Over 66.0 innings, yielded 59 hits (.236 batting average against) with 67 strikeouts against 20 walks.

-Conversely, as a reliever, Tyler surrendered 5 runs, four earned, on five hits in 6.0 innings for a 6.00 ERA. He struck out six against two walks.

## ADDITIONAL CAREER NOTES

-While at the University of Oklahoma, Tyler majored in planned programming. At Westmoore High School, he maintained a 4.2 GPA.

-The 2015 Oklahoma Gatorade Baseball Player of the Year and a Louisville Slugger All-American, Tyler finished his senior season 10-0, posting a 0.70 ERA and 102 strikeouts in 60 innings pitched.
