Lansing is 11-9 against Great Lakes this year and 147-147 all-time after winning three of the first five games of this series. The Nuts are currently 6-5 during their 12-game, 13-day homestand vs. Fort Wayne and Great Lakes,

Last Night: Lugnuts 7, Loons 5. In front of 7,780, the Nuts received home runs from Brennan Milone and Junior Pérez and six scoreless innings from relievers Kumar Nambiar, Mac Lardner and Stevie Emanuels to beat Great Lakes on Saturday night. Center fielder Pérez finished the game 3-for-3 with a single, double, home run, walk, two runs scored and an outfield assist.

Among the League Leaders: Daniel Susac is second in batting average (.301), tied for third in hits (103), eighth in slugging percentage (.444), ninth in OPS (.811) and tenth in total bases (152). Junior Pérez is fourth in steals (37) and tied for ninth in doubles (23). Danny Bautista, Jr. is sixth in hits (101) and eighth in batting average (.275).

Rocking the RockHounds: Opening Day starter Joelvis Del Rosario debuted in Double-A yesterday with six innings of one-run ball, walking none and striking out five in an 8-1 Midland win over San Antonio.

Home Cooking: The Lugnuts' offense has excelled on Michigan Ave. this season, topping the circuit in home batting average (.259), home base hits (491) and home total bases (780), and ranking second in doubles (102), triples (17) and tied for second in home roundtrippers (51).

Pitcher's Best Friend: After turning two more double plays yesterday, the Nuts now lead the league with 107 double plays turned.

Saving the Day: The Lugnuts have been playing closer and closer games as the season has gone on. By month: seven saves in 20 games in April (35%), nine in 27 games in May (33%), 15 in 24 in June (63%), 20 in 24 games in July (83%), and 14 in 17 games played in August (82%).

Turnaround: Outfielder Junior Pérez opened the year batting .082 (5-for-60) in his first 20 games, including a streak of 32 consecutive hitless at-bats. Since then, he is hitting .279 (82-for-294). His slash line by month: April - .089/.192/.089, .281 OPS; May - .238/.295/.438, .733 OPS; June - .256/.326/.372, .698 OPS; July - .262/.361/.393, .754 OPS; August - .328/.416/.567, .983 OPS. He has reached base 43 times in the last 21 games thanks to 29 hits and 14 walks.

Historic on the 4th: A crowd of 11.521 packed in to Jackson Field on July 4, the largest home attendance in Lansing since July 4, 2013. It was also the largest single game crowd in all of High-A, let alone the Midwest League, and an attendance larger than any crowd drawn by every Minor League Baseball team save for six Triple-A teams (Buffalo, Albuquerque, Salt Lake, Indianapolis, Norfolk and Round Rock) and one Double-A team (Frisco).

The Cycle: On June 21 at Wisconsin, Jack Winkler went 4-for-4 with a single, double, triple, home run and four RBIs, becoming the eighth player in team history to hit for the cycle. The other cycles: Corey Patterson (7/5/99 at South Bend); Donnie Hood (4/21/03 vs. Dayton); Chip Cannon (6/2/05 vs. Clinton); Travis Snider (7/7/07 at Fort Wayne); Brad Glenn (7/26/10 vs. Clinton); Edward Olivares (4/24/17 vs. South Bend); and Ryan Gold (4/18/19 vs. Dayton).

They Know Their Trade: Lansing has three players acquired via trade by the Oakland Athletics on its roster: Christian Fernandez (Tampa Bav Ravs. 7/9/22. for Christian Bethancourt); Euribiel Ángeles (San Diego Padres, 4/3/22, for Sean Manaea, and a 2021 member of the Fort Wayne TinCaps); and Junior Pérez (San Diego Padres, 6/30/20, for Jorge Mateo).

First-Round Pedigrees: The Lugnuts' roster has the A's last two first-round selections in catcher Daniel Susac, taken 19th overall out of Arizona last year, and shortstop Jacob Wilson, the sixth overall pick this year from Grand Canyon University. The A's 2021 first-round selection, shortstop Max Muncy, opened the year on the Lugnuts roster after first joining the team last year, where he was teammates with 2020 first-rounder Tyler Sodestrom. Muncy is now withMidland; Soderstrom is in the Majors.

Big League Nuts: Eight Lugnuts have made their MLB debuts in 2023, totaling 181 all-time. Those eight: Ryan Noda on March 30; Hogan Harris on April 14; Mason Miller on April 19; Garrett Acton on May 14; Samad Taylor on June 18; Tyler Soderstrom on July 14; and Lawrence Butler and Hagen Danner on August 11. Davis Schneider, who debuted with Toronto on August 4, played for the Nuts in the 2017 Crosstown Showdown but did not play in any regular season Lansing games.

TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2009: It was a nightmarish start for Fort Wayne's Dexter Carter: HBP, single, RBI single, HBP, two-run single, single, RBI single, strikeout, RBI walk, and then a three-run double by leadoff hitter Chris Emanuele in the second tour around the order, knocking Carter out of the game. In all, the Lugnuts scored eight runs in the 1st on their way to a 15-7 victory at Parkview Field. 3B Mark Sobolewski went 4-for-6 with a double, a home run, and four RBIs, and the Lugnuts collected 18 hits in all.

2014: 19-year-old Miguel Castro impressed with seven shutout innings, scattering three hits and a walk while striking out three, but host West Michigan scored two runs in the eighth off Matt Dermody to win, 2-0.

2017: Nick Sinay was hit by a pitch for the 36th time, tying the Midwest League single-season record set by Clinton's Jonathan "Dirt" Greene in 2008, but the Lugnuts lost to South Bend, 8-6, at Cooley Law School Stadium. It was one of three Nuts HBPs in the game, giving them 104 total, nine away from tying the MWL record.

In a Nutshell: The last Pitt Panther to appear in a game for the Nuts before Myers this year was also the only other Panther to play for the Nuts: T.J. Zeuch (pronounced "Zoyk"), the 21st pick in 2016, who made two starts in the Midwest League for Lansing in 2016, spent last season with the Cincinnati Reds, and is currently in Lehigh Valley (Triple-A - Philadelphia)... @mitch_myers9.

International Respect: Mitch is ranked No. 3 in the world in the video game *Super Monkey Ball...* he is also considered the top chess player in the Lugnuts' clubhouse.

Hometown Hero: Hometown of Lanett's motto is "The Gateway to Alabama," since it sits directly on the Eastern border to Georgia, directly bordering West Point, Georgia... pitched for Valley High School as a freshman and sophomore and Opelika High School as a junior and senior, posting a career 1.22 ERA with a fastball/curveball mix, playing third base, and batting third... father Barry starred in baseball at Jacksonville State.

The Buc Starts Here: Initially committed to University of Alabama, but coach instability led to Mitch joining juco Florida Southwestern State instead, making 15 appearances, 14 starts, in both 2017-18 and 2018-19... as a freshman: 5-6, 4.28, 2 CG, 73 2/3, 35 BB, 62 K, 1 HR... as a sophomore: 7-2, 3.29, 3 CG, 79 1/3, 23 BB, 88 K, 3 HR... became one of 10 Bucs to sign on with a D-I program (not including Ryan Gusto, who was drafted in the 11th round by the Astros).

Onward to Pitt: Upon transferring to Pittsburgh, made four starts in 2020 (2-2, 3.52, 23 IP, 4 BB, 30 K, 0 HR) before the season was shut down, with 10 strikeouts in six shutout innings vs. Lehigh... followed in 2021 as Pitt's Friday starter: 13 GS, 5-5, 3.21, 1 CG, 81 1/3, 23 BB, team-leading 83 K, 6 HR... tossed 9-IP CG at Virginia, 3/20/21, allowing three hits, one run, and whiffing five.

2022 Professional Debut: After signing for \$125,000 as the Athletics' 12th-round selection in 2021, did not appear in a Minor League game until 2022, spent entirely with Stockton... led Ports in starts (22, six more than the closest teammate), innings (124 1/3, 28 1/3 more innings than the closest teammate), and double plays (10)... worked seven innings five times, 6 2/3 innings once, 6 1/3 innings twice, and six innings four times: 12 starts of 22 starts lasting at least six innings... struggled in 12 games, 11 starts, at home (7.11 ERA, .304 avg, 16 HR, in 57 innings) compared to 11 starts on the road (4.14 ERA, .269, 10 HR in 67 1/3 innings)... lefties and righties hit nearly identically: .286/.355/.536 for lefties, .285/.339/.525 for righties, though righties hit 17 of the 26 home runs allowed... struggled mightily in first innings, allowing .353/.402/.627 slash line and six home runs... opposing base stealers swiped 10 bases in 16 attempts.

2023 with the Lugnuts: Opened season as the Nuts' Wednesday starter... tossed first quality start of the year on April 27, allowing two runs (both in the 5th) in six innings vs. Quad Cities April 27... followed up with a second quality start on May 4 vs. Dayton, though he once again received a nodecision... struck on the back of the head by a line drive against Peoria on June 13 and spent two weeks on the Injured List, missing his scheduled start at Wisconsin before returning to action at Great Lakes on July 3... tossed another quality start (6 IP, 4 H, 1 R, 0 BB, 6 K) against Quad Cities on July 27... 5.90 ERA / 1.77 WHIP / .318 avg. in home games (11 GS, 50 1/3 IP) compared to 3.71 / 1.29 / .244 avg. in road games (8 G, 6 GS, 34 IP).




