Round Rock and El Paso are scheduled for the series finale from Dell Diamond on Sunday afternoon. Chihuahuas RHP Anderson Espinoza will start against Express LHP Cody Bradford. First pitch is slated for 1:05 p.m.

### A WALK-OFF WIN

The Express snuck by the Chihuahuas for a 6-5 win on Saturday. In the first, El Paso SS Matthew Batten scored on an infield single from DH Tim Lopes. DH Yoshi Tsutsugo belted a three-run home run to give the E-Train a 3-1 lead in the home-half. In the third, 3B Davis Wendzel plated the fourth run of the game for the Express after an RBI single. In the fifth, 3B Jose Iglesias hit a sacrifice fly to pull El Paso within two. 1B Alfonso Rivas followed with a single that scored Iglesias to make it a 4-3 game. In the ninth, El Paso had the bases loaded with one out and an error tied the game at four. A bases loaded walk from RHP Yerry Rodriguez gave El Paso a 5-4 lead. In the home-half with the bases juiced, C Sam Huff drew a walk to tie the game at five. Crim launched a single down the first base line to send the winning run home.

### BRADFORD BACK FOR MORE

Express LHP Cody Bradford is scheduled to start on Sunday against the Chihuahuas. The southpaw was optioned to Round Rock on Tuesday after making his MLB debut on Monday night in Arlington. In seven starts this year for the E-Train, Bradford has allowed more than one run in just one outing.

### ANDERSON ON A MISSION

RHP Grant Anderson tossed a three-up, three-down third inning. He had struck out six straight batters dating back to his relief appearance on May 17 vs EL Paso. With his 2.1 scoreless innings yesterday, his scoreless streak extended to 6.0 innings. Over his last three outings, he has struck out 15 of the last 26 batters he's faced.

### WENDZEL WORKING IT

With two singles yesterday, 3B Davis Wendzel is riding a five-game hitting streak dating back to May 14. He is batting .333 (7-for-21) with two home runs, two doubles, and six RBI in that span. The righty has lifted his OPS to .717.

### TSUTSU-GONE

Round Rock DH Yoshi Tsutsugo belted his first home run in 25 games yesterday. His last came on April 25 at Sugar Land. The homer was his first at Dell Diamond this year. His three RBI also matched a season high. He last had three on May 5 at Reno and he has posted 17 total on the season.

### WALK-OFF WINS

The Express have won in walk-off fashion four times this season. In 2022, Round Rock walked it off six times. Saturday night saw the first walk-off hit of the season for 1B Blaine Crim. INF Yoshi Tsutsugo, OF J.P. Martinez and OF Rafael Ortega join Crim as E-Train members who were in the batter's box for a walk-off this year.

### ONE-RUN WINS

Round Rock improved to 8-2 in games decided by one run this season. The Express are three games above the .500 mark but have a negative run differential of -1.

### MAKING MORE MOVES

RHP Tyler Zombro was signed by Texas to a minor league contract and assigned to Round Rock on Sunday morning. After suffering a fractured skull in 2021, Zombro made two appearances with Triple-A Durham in 2022 before undergoing thoracic outlet surgery. In a corresponding move, RHP Jacob Barnes was released.

EXPRESS MANAGER DOUG DAVIS

The 2023 season marks Round Rock Express Manager Doug Davis's Pacific Coast League debut. Davis spent the previous two years as the manager for the Scranton Wilkes-Barre RailRiders, the New York Yankees Triple-A affiliate. Davis brings over 25 years of coaching experience to the Express dugout. Since he began coaching in 1995, he has led a minor league team for 10 total seasons and has accumulated a career 673-588 record. He spent the 2003-2004 seasons as the bench coach for the Florida Marlins, where he won the 2003 World Series.



In two seasons as the manager for Scranton Wilkes-Barre, Davis led the RailRiders to a combined record of 158-119. Last season, he helped oversee a pitching staff that led all Triple-A teams with a 3.89 ERA. Prior to his time as skipper, Davis spent three years in three different roles with Scranton Wilkes-Barre from 2017-2019. In 2017, he was the defensive coach before moving over to bullpen coach in 2018. In 2019, Davis was named the bench coach.

Before joining the New York Yankees organization, Davis spent 11 years in the Toronto Blue Jays system in a variety of roles. Before he was named manager of the RailRiders in 2021, Davis hadn't held a manager title since 2008. He has also been a minor league field coordinator for the Montreal Expos (2001) and Florida Marlins (2002, 2005). His coaching career began in the Yankees system in 1995.

A catcher and infielder in his playing days, Davis was a ninth-round selection by the California Angels in the 1984 MLB Draft. He played professionally for 11 seasons between the Angels, Rangers and Kansas City Royals organizations. He appeared in seven games in the big leagues and tallied six games in 1988 with the Angels, while appearing in one game for the Rangers in 1992. He is a native of Bloomsburg, Pennsylvania.
