YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels shut out the Altoona Curve, 6-0. Akeel Morris threw a career-high seven innings, surpassing his previous career high of 6.1 innings, which he last did in 2011 with the Kingsport Mets. Joey Marciano tossed the final two frames to finish the shutout. Brandon Martorano gave Richmond a 1-0 lead in the top of the third with an RBI double. David Villar stretched the lead to 3-0 with a ground-rule double that brought in two runs in the sixth. Richmond scored three runs in the sixth to open a 6-0 lead with consecutive RBI singles by Diego Rincones, Sandro Fabian and Heath Quinn. It was the eighth shutout win this season for the Flying Squirrels, which is the fourth-most in the Double-A Northeast.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels play the third of a six-game series against the Altoona Curve, Double-A affiliate of the Pittsburgh Pirates. The Flying Squirrels are 25-31 against teams from the Southwest Division and 11-15 in road games against division opponents. The two teams met for a six-game series at The Diamond from June 1-6, with the Curve winning four games.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have gone 12-18 since July 21 but have won six of the last seven games since August 18. They are in fifth place in the six-team Double-A Northeast Southwest Division, 10.5 games behind first-place Akron. For the season, the Richmond offense is ranked ninth in the league with a .238 batting average. The pitching staff is ranked third in the league with a 3.96 ERA for the season.

THE CURVE have lost three of the last four games. They split last week's six-game series against the Patriots. The Altoona offense is ranked tied for fifth in the league with a .250 batting average and the pitching staff is ninth with a 4.68 ERA. Altoona's roster includes seven of MLB.com's top-30 Pirates prospects, including SS Oneil Cruz (No. 3), RHP Roansy Contreras (No. 6 - on IL), 1B Mason Martin (No. 17), OF Matt Frazier (No. 23), OF Canaan Smith-Njigba (No. 28 - on IL), RHP Cody Bolton (No. 29 - on IL) and OF Jack Suwinkski (No. 30).

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander Matt Frisbee makes his ninth Double-A start and his fourth since returning to the Flying Squirrels from Triple-A Sacramento. He last pitched last Friday at The Diamond against Erie and allowed three runs over 7.0 innings in a no-decision, striking out six batters. In his three starts since returning to Double-A, Frisbee has gone 1-0 with a 4.96 ERA (9 ER/16.1 IP). Frisbee was selected as the Double-A Northeast Pitcher of the Month for May. He was promoted to Triple-A on June 3 and made 11 appearances (nine starts) for Sacramento, going 1-6 with a 7.64 ERA. He was assigned back to the Richmond roster on August 6. On May 13 at Harrisburg, Frisbee worked 6.0 perfect innings in the Flying Squirrels' first-ever nine-inning no-hitter. He spent most of the 2019 season with San Jose, going 9-8 with a 3.17 ERA in 22 outings (20 starts). He went 4-2 with a 1.91 ERA in his last 10 appearances (56.2 IP) of the season while picking up 60 strikeouts. Following the season, Frisbee was named a Giants Organizational All-Star by Mil.B.com. He was drafted by the Giants in the 15th round in 2018 out of UNC Greensboro. For more on Frisbee, see page two.

FOR ALTOONA: Right-hander Osvaldo Bido makes his 17th start of the season and his second against Richmond. Last time out, Bido pitched 6.2 innings and allowed two runs in a win against Somerset on Friday at PNG Field. After going 0-4 with an 8.55 ERA in five July starts, Bido has gone 1-1 with a 3.79 ERA in four starts this month. He faced the Flying Squirrels on June 5 at The Diamond and allowed one unearend run over 5.2 innings to pick up his first win of the season, lowering his ERA to 2.01 at the time. Bido was signed by the Pirates as an international free agent in 2017. He spent most of 2019 with Low-A Greensboro, going 11-5 with a 3.55 ERA in 20 starts. He also made five starts for High-A Bradenton and went 1-3 with a 2.25 ERA. Bido is currently ranked tied for ninth in the Double-A Northeast with 16 games started.

BIG FLIES IN BUNCHES: The Flying Squirrels have hit 27 homers in the last 13 games since August 10, which is the second-most in the Double-A Northeast. In that stretch, David Villar and Diego Rincones have 14 five home runs, Sandro Fabian has four, Brandon Martorano, Andres Angulo and Heath Quinn have two and Vince Fernandez, Jacob Heyward, Shane Matheny, Mitchell Tolman, Frankie Tostado, Simon Whiteman and Will Wilson each have one. All but two active Richmond position players have homered int hat span. The Flying Squirrels hit 15 homers during a six-game set at Bowie from August 10-15 and added 10 homers during last week's six-game series at The Diamond against the SeaWolves. They added two homers in Tuesday's series opener at Altoona.

POWER SURGE: This season, the Flying Squirrels rank fourth in the Double-A Northeast with 110 home runs. The team is on pace to hit 135 home runs this season in 120 games. On Tuesday, **Andres Angulo** hit the team's 110th home run of the season, breaking the previous franchise record of 109 from 2013. This year, the team has combined for a .401 slugging percentage, which is ninth in the league but would be the highest in the franchise's history (Ahead of a .382 mark from 2013). The Flying Squirrels have hit 53 homers in home games at The Diamond this year, the most in franchise history.

LEAVING THE YARD: The 2021 Flying Squirrels have five players who have reached double-digits in home runs this season, including **Vince Fernandez** (14), **David Villar** (14), **Sandro Fabian** (13), **Frankie Tostado** (11) and **Heliot Ramos** (10). Five players with 10 or more homers ties a franchise record, matching the 2013 season, which included **Jarret Parker** (18 - tied for most in a season in team history), **Adam Duvali** (17), **Javier Herrera** (16), **Andrew Susac** (12) and **Mark Minicozzi** (10).

BACK IN THE SWING OF THINGS: In his last 13 games since August 10, David Villar is batting .314 (19-for-46) with five homers, seven doubles and nine RBIs. He now leads the team with 16 home runs this season, which is also tied for the fifth-most in a season in franchise history and is two homers shy of matching the single-season franchise record. On August 12 at Bowie, Villar snapped a season-high stretch of 25 games without a homer. He finished that series with three home runs and homered in each of the last two games of last week's series against Erie at The Diamond.

FABULOUS FABIAN: Over the last 13 games since August 10, **Sandro Fabian** is hitting .314 (16-for-51) with four homers and 17 RBIs. He has 13 home runs this year, which is a new career high. Fabian has picked up 13 RBIs over the last nine games since August 14, with multiple RBIs in four of those contests.

GO, DIEGO, GO!: Over his last 31 games since July 17, Diego Rincones is batting .319 (26-for-113) with nine homers, six doubles, one triple and 26 RBIs. Over his last 20 games since August 3, Rincones is batting .346 (27-for-78) with five homers, five doubles and 15 RBIs. He added a walk-off single last Friday night to cap a three-run bottom of the ninth for the Flying Squirrels in a 7-6 win over the SeaWolves. Rincones homered on Saturday night and hit a go-ahead homer in the seventh in the series finale against the SeaWolves on Sunday night. He went deep for the third straight game on Tuesday at Altoona. He has picked up at least one RBI in five straight games since Friday with seven total RBIs, batting .391 (9-for-23) with three homers.

TAKE A WALK: In 2019, **Jacob Heyward** set the single-season franchise record with 80 walks, surpassing the previous mark held by **Mark Minicozzi**, who walked 62 times in 2013. Heyward has walked 28 times this season. For his career with the Flying Squirrels, Heyward has worked 108 walks, which sits him in second in the team's history in career walks. The franchise career walks record is held by **Ricky Oropesa**, who walked 113 times in his four seasons with Richmond from 2013-2016.

IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS: David Villar is tied for eighth with 16 homers, eighth with a .372 OBP, tied for seventh with 90 hits, ninth with 23 doubles, tied for fifth with 41 walks, and seventh with 39 extra-base hits, tied for seventh with 161 total bases and ninth with 58 runs scored. Simon Whiteman is eighth with 15 stolen bases. Trenton Toplikar is ranked ninth with a 5.20 ERA and tied for eighth with 81 strikeouts. Joey Marciano (34/3rd),Patrick Ruotolo (33/4th), Matt Seelinger (31/T-5th), Frank Rubio (31/T-5th) and Raffi Vizcaino (30/T-8th) are in the top-ten in the league in games pitched. Patrick Ruotolo is fourth with nine saves and R.J. Dabovich is tied for ninth with six.

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have four players included in *Baseball America*'s Top-30 Giants prospects: **Will Wilson** (10), **Tristan Beck** (14 - on IL), **Diego Rincones** (23) and **R.J. Dabovich** (30). **Simon Whiteman** is rated by *Baseball America* as being the "Fastest Baserunner" in the Giants system and Rincones is rated as having the "Best Outfield Arm." Two players, Wilson (15) and Beck (29), are also ranked in MLB.com's Top-30 Giants prospects.
