### Highlights

After a four pitch walk to begin the game, Columbus pitching allowed only one other Saint to reach base safely, as **Ben Krauth** (3.0IP, 1BB, 2K), **Dalbert Siri** (2.0IP, 1H, 2K), **Anthony Gose** (2.0IP, 3K) and **Jordan Stephens** (2.0IP, 4K) combined for the shutout.

### Tonight's Game

The Clippers will send RHP **Heath Fillmyer** to the mound tonight, attempting to run the home win streak to three (would be second three game home win streak this home stand, started year 2-10 at home). St. Paul will counter with LHP **Charlie Barnes**. The Clippers are 2-5 (.286) against left handers this year. Barnes has never pitched against the Clippers in his career.

### vs. the Saints

This series marks the first ever matchup between the Clippers and the St. Paul Saints. In 2019, Columbus split the season series against the baby Twins with Rochester, 3-3, after having won 2018, 4-2 (outscored by a combined 57-39 from 2018-19, as the Clippers went 6-1 in 1-run games). The series win over Rochester in 2018 was the first for Columbus since 2015.

### Pummeled Pitching

Huntington Park has zoomed back to the top of the IL in homers per game (3.24), following 47HR in the last 13G. Unfortunately, 29 of those 47 have been surrendered by Columbus (149HR allowed in last 74G in the regular season at HP). Almost 22% of hits allowed at home have left the yard (41 of 190), the highest rate in the IL (led the league in 2019, as 20.4% of hits allowed at HP were homers).

### Hammering Gimenez

**Andres Gimenez** homered in each of six games from 6/13-6/19, after never having homered in consecutive games in his career (7HR and 15RBI since 6/13, most in IL; .929SLG ranks 2nd). Prior to his surge, Gimenez laid down three sac bunts over four games from 6/6-6/9 (3-0 when Gimenez executes a sac bunt, 6-2 when he homers). However, Gimenez has missed his last four sac bunt attempts.

### Reyes Rehab

**Franmil Reyes** went 0x3 on Tuesday night, his first action since going on the DL with a left abdominal strain on 5/23, and followed with an RBI single last night. Reyes was batting .257/.316/.576 with 11HR and 29RBI in 40G (144AB) prior to his injury. He had struggled over his final 16G in Cleveland, homering only four times in 54AB (.463SLG), while batting .185 (only one multi-hit game).

### Johnson Streaks

**Daniel Johnson** is riding a 10G on base streak (since 6/13, .395OBP), his second double digit streak of the season (first Clipper with multiple). A hit tonight would extend his hitting streak to 7G (8x22, .364 over last 6G), making him only the second Clipper to reach the mark (**Ernie Clement**, 7G from 5/6-5/27). After four straight multi-K games (6/13-6/17), he has struck out in only two of the last six.

### Work to Do

**Owen Miller** has five hitless games in nine chances since his return to Columbus (four hitless games in 16G before promotion), batting .194 (6x31). He went hitless in four straight from 6/18-6/22 (14AB), watching his average sink to .333 on 6/23 (season low). Miller is 10PA short of qualifying for the batting title and adding them as hitless at bats would place him in 8th (would also rank 8th in OBP).

### Take Two

The double from **Nolan Jones** last night was his IL-best 15th of the year (**Oscar Mercado** is tied for 3rd, 13) and the 92nd for Columbus (leads IL). As a team, the Clippers doubled in 26 straight from 5/22-6/20 and 42 of 44 on the year (doubleless in 25 games during 2019, 10 times in first 44). Jones is slugging .552 over his last 17G, collecting 10 doubles and a pair of HR (6X28 through first 26G).

### Double Struggle

**Gavin Collins** and **Tyler Krieger** are starting together for the second time since 5/29 vs. Nashville. Following that game, they have hit a collective .079 (5x63) with Krieger going 3x29 and Collins 2x34. The Clippers are 2-2 when they start the same game, as they hit .286 (8x28) when starting with each other (.105, 11x105, without). Since **Ryan Lavarney**'s last game (6/16), Clipper catchers are 1x23.

### Hill Rehab

The bullpen provided 6.0IP of nearly perfect work last night (1H, 0ER), marking the seventh time this season with at least 5.0IP and 0ER (only six such games in all of 2019). Prior to last night, relievers had given up at least 1ER in 12 straight at home (62.1IP, 48ER). They'll get a boost tonight with the addition of **Cam Hill** on rehab (on DL all season, broken wrist; has not pitched this season).

# Columbus Clippers Game Information

## This Date in Clipper History

6/25/1992

**Hensley 'Bam-Bam' Meulens** turned in one of the greatest performances in Columbus baseball history during a 13-3 romp over the Red Sox in Pawtucket. Meulens went 4x4, hitting 3HR and driving in 8RBI (at the time, tied franchise record for HR and set record for RBI). He was named to his 2nd IL All-Star team in 1992 after leading the IL in HR (26) and RBI (100).

## Huntington (Small) Park

In each of the first 11 years since the move downtown, Huntington Park has ranked among the top two in the IL in homers per game, totaling 2.25 per contest (1,763HR, 783 games). In 2019, HP averaged over three per game for the first time ever (seventh time averaging over a pair), as the Clippers surrendered a record 127HR and just missed out on triple digits themselves (97HR was second highest team total). Including the postseason, the Clippers have been out-homered over the life of the park (964 to 921).

## Record Destruction

The Clippers broke the established mark for homers in a season (182 in 1983) on 8/7/19 and finished with a total of 213 (most in the IL). From 5/14-6/2, they homered in 20 straight games (44HR total) and they had seven straight multi-HR games from 6/14-6/21 (22HR). On the mound, they broke the record for homers allowed (156 in 1998) on 7/31/19, giving up 198 for the year (2nd most in the IL).

## Ain't Over 'Til It's Over

From 2014-19, no team had more come from behind victories than the 210 posted by Columbus and no team produced a better winning percentage when trailing than the .353 of the Clippers (Scranton/WB was 2nd in win percentage, .338, and wins, 192). This year has seen the Clippers go 9-23 (.281) in games in which they trail, ranking 10th.

## Get What You Pay For

Columbus is the only team in the IL that has yet to play any free baseball this season, having played 84 straight games, including the postseason, since their last extra-inning rumble (7/31/19 vs. Louisville, an 11-8 loss in 11; only extra inning loss of the season, 8-1). Dating to the 1984 season (as far back as the day by day records go) this is the longest the Clippers have gone without extras (had 83 straight from 4/22-7/19/94; current run of 44 straight to start the season is a record, had 39 in 1987).

## Trending Downward

The current staff ERA of 5.33 is on pace to be the worst in franchise history (5.08, 1983) and anything over 4.71 will mark the fifth straight season in which the ERA has gotten worse. From 2011-16, the Clipper staff turned in a sub-4.00ERA five times in six seasons (zero such seasons from 1993-2010), including the best two ERAs of the past 32 years (3.33 in 2015 and 3.65 in 2016). The 6.19ERA at Huntington Park is by far the worst ever (5.29 in 2019, only time ERA has ever been over 5.00 at HP).

## Doing Damage

In 2019, the Clippers ranked tied for 5th in the IL with 112RBI with the bases loaded, while carrying a .252 average (10th, 36x143, 4HR). In both 2017 and 2018, the Clippers led the IL in RBI with the bases loaded (243RBI total) and paced the circuit in grand slams (16 total, no other team had more than eight).

## Free Swingers

After three straight seasons leading the IL in strikeouts, the Clipper lineup is threatening for a fourth, as they currently rank 5th (427K, 42 off the pace, St. Paul). The 2019 squad obliterated the franchise record, as they struck out 95 more times than the previous high (1,392; each of last three seasons rank among franchise's three worst, totalling 3,979K in 422G). While the record appears safe due to the truncated schedule, this year's version is averaging 9.70K per game.

## That's More Like It

In 2019, the Clippers were 50-30 (.625) when playing errorless baseball, while turning in a 31-29 (.517) mark with at least one error. Contrary to logic, in 2018 they actually had a worse winning percentage when playing mistake free (.514), than when committing at least one error (.530). The Clipper defense finished 1st in 2019 (.983) after falling to 6th in the IL in 2018, ending a run of three consecutive seasons ranked among the top three (2015-17 resulted in the three best seasons in franchise history).

## One On, No Out Success

When the leadoff batter of an inning reached base in 2019, the Clippers plated him nearly 60% of the time (over 51% only once in the last six seasons, 55% in 2016). Getting more than one base was a specialty of Clipper hitters, as they led the IL with 136XBH to lead off the inning, including 54HR (led the IL, had 28 leadoff homers in 2018). From 4/13-4/20/19, the Clippers hit 16 leadoff doubles over 72 innings, including four straight innings in a win at Louisville on 4/15/19.

## Good Baseball

**Andres Gimenez** advanced a runner with a sac bunt on 6/10 at Iowa and the runner came around to score in the win (3-0 when advanced runner scores). During 2019, the Clippers struggled in the bunt department, but when the advanced runners scored, they were 7-1. During 2018, Columbus was 23-2 in games in which a run was scored after a good bunt attempt.

## International Accolades

**Bobby Bradley** was named International League Player of the Month for May 2019, reaching base in 24 of 25 games during the month while hitting .302/.374/.740 with 12HR (led IL) and 28RBI. **Brandon Barnes, Eric Haase, Josh Smith** and **Asher Wojciechowski** were named to the 2019 IL All-Star Team and Bradley, Barnes and Haase were selected to the postseason squad.

## Manager Profile

**Andy Tracy** makes his Clippers debut in 2021, following **Tony Mansolino's** championship rookie year in 2019 (sixth Clipper skipper to win Governors' Cup in first season; **Gene Michael**-79, **Joe Altobelli**-80, **Frank Verdi**-81, **Bucky Dent**-87 and **Mike Sarbaugh**-10). This season marks Tracy's second year as a manager (first with Williamsport in the Philadelphia system), as he holds a career record of 51-69 (.425), 21-23 with Columbus (.477).

Fillmyer made his 2021 season debut on 5/27 with Lancaster in the Atlantic League, picking up the win at Gastonia with a quality start on 102 pitches (6.0IP, 3H, 1R, 1ER, 2BB, 9K). Additionally, former manager, **Chris Tremie** ('13-18) had a playing stint in the Atlantic League ('00).

### In Relief:

Following a start in his Clipper debut, Fillmyer pitched three times out of the bullpen to mixed results. He had a pair of perfect innings (2K, 26 pitches) at Iowa on 6/8, then allowed 4ER in 2.0IP at Iowa on 6/11 (37 pitches). In his most recent outing as a reliever, he gave up 1ER in 1.0IP vs. Toledo on 6/15 (20 pitches).
