**Tonight's Game:** The Nashville Sounds and the Memphis Redbirds play the third of a six-game series tonight. Sounds outfielder Jamie Westbrook went 2-for-4 with a double, a home run and four RBI to lead the Sounds to a 6-4 win over the Redbirds Wednesday night at First Horizon Park. Right-hander Colin Rea starts for Nashville against right-hander Johan Oviedo for Memphis.

**Colin Rea:** 31-year-old Colin Rea makes his fifth start of the 2021 season tonight. Rea is 1-2 with a 4.08 ERA in his first four starts with Nashville. He last pitched on September 3 at Louisville and earned his first win. He allowed just two runs on four hits and struck out three in 5.1 innings. Prior to signing a minor league contract with Milwaukee on August 13, the right-hander was previously pitching for the Fukuoka Softbank Hawks in Japan. In 2020, Rea pitched 14.0 innings for the Chicago Cubs and compiled a 5.79 ERA. The Iowa native went 5-5 in 20 appearances with a 4.82 ERA in 2016 with San Diego and Miami. He was selected by the Padres in the 12th round of the 2011 MLB First-Year Player Draft.

**Johan Oviedo:** 23-year-old Johan Oviedo starts for the Redbirds tonight. The right-hander is 1-5 with a 6.75 ERA in nine games (all starts) with Memphis in 2021. He has also pitched in 14 games (13 starts) with St. Louis this year and is 0-5 with a 4.91 ERA. With Memphis, Oviedo has covered 41.1 innings and has allowed 46 hits and 23 walks to go along with 39 strikeouts. He last pitched on September 3 in a start at Gwinnett where he received a no decision. Oviedo tossed 3.2 scoreless innings and struck out three. The Cardinals signed Oviedo as a non-drafted free agent on July 2, 2016.

**2021 Standings:** The Sounds have spent the following number of days in the Triple-A East Southeast Division standings in 2021: First: 23, Second: 59, Third: 5, Fourth: 37, Fifth: 2, Sixth: 0, Seventh: 0.

**Westbrook's Big Night:** Jamie Westbrook showed some power in last night's win going 2-for-4 with a double, a home run and four RBI. It was the first time this season Westbrook had doubled and homered in the same game.

**Rea Finding a Groove:** Tonight's starter Colin Rea got off to a rough start with the Sounds. In his first two appearances, he went 0-2 with a 8.10 ERA (6 ER/6.2 IP) and a .400 opponents average. In his last two starts with Nashville, the Iowa native is 1-0 with a 1.64 ERA (2 ER/11.0 IP) and 12 strikeouts.

**Home Sweet Home:** The Sounds return to First Horizon Park where they have enjoyed success in 2021. The club is 34-22 at home compared to 24-30 on the road. The 34-22 mark is the fifth-best home record in the Triple-A East, behind Toledo (38-16), Durham (37-18), Buffalo (37-19) and Gwinnett (33-21).

**Vs. Memphis:** The Sounds and Redbirds have played 14 games against each other this season with both clubs winning seven games going into tonight's contest. Regulars in the lineup who have experienced success against Memphis include Dustin Peterson, Zach Green, Brice Turang and David Dahl. Peterson is hitting .375 (18-for-48) with 11 runs, 4 doubles, 1 home run and 12 RBI in 11 games against Memphis. Additionally, in nine games against the Redbirds, Green is hitting .385 (10-for-26) with 7 runs, 3 doubles, 3 home runs and 10 RBI. In limited action against Memphis, Turang is hitting .321 (9-for-28) and Dahl is batting .474 (9-for-19) with 6 runs, 5 doubles, 1 home run and 4 RBI.

**Offensive Breakout:** The Nashville offense broke out in their 9-7 win on Tuesday night. The club mustered 16 hits and posted six runs in the third inning. The Sounds scored more than seven runs for the first time since their 13-12 win over Memphis on August 22.

**The Milwaukee Era:** A new era of Nashville Sounds baseball began on February 12, 2021 when the club announced its affiliation with the Milwaukee Brewers. The affiliation with Milwaukee came after the Sounds signed a 10-year Professional Development License (PDL) with Major League Baseball as part of the 20-team Triple-A East League. Within the Triple-A East League, the Sounds are a member of the seven-team Southeast Division.
