FRES-NOTES

CAUTION: GRIZZ ARE HOT: The Fresno Grizzlies (35-23) agitated the Rancho Cucamonga Quakes (26-31) 8-2 Wednesday night from Chukchansi Park. Fresno extended their winning streak to five games after a complete performance from both sides of the ball. The Grizzlies also lengthened their home win streak to a season-long four games and improved to 16-4 all-time at Chukchansi Park against the Quakes. Fresno now sits 2.5 games back of Modesto with seven contests left to play in the first half. The Nuts suffered their fifth consecutive setback and their second in a row on a walk-off from the Visalia Rawhide. The Grizzlies offense logged eight runs on seven hits, 10 walks and two hit-by-pitches. Every starter reached base at least once with five batters getting on safely two or more times. In the bottom of the first, Fresno brought eight batters to the plate, notching two runs. The long frame sent Rancho Cucamonga starter Alex Makarewicz (0-2, loss) to the showers early after only 30 pitches and two outs recorded. Fresno worked four full counts in the inning. The Grizzlies expanded the advantage to 8-1 in the bottom of the eighth with a four-run frame (all with two outs). Fresno sent 10 batters to the plate with four reaching on the free pass and two swatting base knocks. EJ Andrews Jr. whacked a two-run wallop to dead center, his third clout of the year. Nick Gile scampered home on a Braulyn Wimmer infield single to short. Grizzlies' righty Bryan Perez (3-2, win) dazzled for a career-high seven innings of one-run ball. Perez allowed a bunt single to open the game and the Jeral Perez solo blast in the fourth. He issued two walks and punched out four. He had two different stretches where he retired nine consecutive and 11 straight batters. Cade Denton and Stu Flesland III wrapped up the last two frames for Fresno.

TIME TO SHAKE THE QUAKES: The Fresno Grizzlies and Rancho Cucamonga Quakes (Los Angeles Dodgers Single-A affiliate) continue their six-game series tonight at Chukchansi Park. This is the first of two 2024 regular season series between the clubs and the only meeting in Fresno. The Quakes started playing in Rancho Cucamonga in 1993 after relocating from San Bernardino. The team moved into the "Epicenter" on April 1, 1993. The Quakes played their first game at the stadium on April 8th against the High Desert Mavericks, winning 7-3. The Quakes continued to play their home games at the stadium, now renamed LoanMart Field. After being an affiliate of the San Diego Padres for the first eight years in Rancho Cucamonga, the team swapped affiliations with the Lake Elsinore Storm, beginning in the 2001 season. For the next 10 seasons, the Quakes were affiliated with the Los Angeles Angels. After that season, the Quakes once again changed affiliations, joining the Dodgers' system. They have been associated with the Dodgers since 2011, where many Dodgers stars go for rehab assignments.

LET EMENER EAT: Tonight, the Grizzlies hand the ball to LHP Austin Emener. The southpaw was selected by the Rockies in the 16th round of the 2023 MLB Draft out of East Tennessee State. In one season with the Buccaneers, Emener appeared in 15 games (eight starts), going 2-4 with one save and a 5.40 ERA. He became the first pitcher in the nation to throw a four-strikeout inning during the 2023 collegiate season (reached on wild pitch).

NO RUN SUPPORT FOR EMENER: Grizzlies' LHP Austin Emener has made nine starts this season and has yet to earn a win (0-3, 3.94 ERA). A big reason why Emener has not earned a win is from the lack of run support he has received. Fresno has scored 26 runs overall (2.89 runs a game) in games started by Emener. However, the team has only scored 16 runs (1.78 runs a game) when Emener is still pitching in the game. 12 of those 16 runs were plated in Emener's first two starts of the season, which means he has only received four runs of support in his last seven outings (0.57 runs a game). Four of those seven games included zero runs of support.

HAMMER TIME: Grizzlies' LHP Bryson Hammer has been nails out of the bullpen this season. Over 19 games, Hammer is 2-1 with two holds, four saves and a 1.32 ERA. Hammer has allowed only four earned runs in 27.1 innings this year (three of his 19 games have had an earned run). Half of those earned runs came in his first appearance of the season on April 5th thanks to a two-run homer by Bryce Eldridge. Since then, Hammer has permitted just two earned runs in 18 outings (no clutch). Hammer has not given up an earned run spanning 11 games (May 7-June 8; 14.2 IP, 6 H, 5 R, 7 BB, 17 K).

NEW MAN AT THE TOP OF THE LINEUP: Grizzlies' OF Caleb Hobson has relished his new role as the team's leadoff hitter. Since Hobson has been plugged into the leadoff spot, he has reached base 37 times in 75 plate appearances (16 games). In seven of those 16 games, Hobson has made it on base three or more times, combining to score 20 runs. Part of Hobson's success is in his first at-bat of the game, where he is 4-for-10 with five walks and one hit-by-pitch. All four hits have been singles with half of them as bunt singles. Hobson has also swiped 13 bases, picking up two of them in five of those leadoff games (18 stolen bases on the season).

TENA IS ON A TEAR: Grizzlies' OF Felix Tena has reached base safely in 18 straight games from May 18-June 12 and has at least one hit in 17 of those 18 contests. Tena is 19-for-71 (268) with one homer, one triple, four doubles, 11 RBI, six runs, three walks, three hit-by-pitches and one stolen base in that span.

A+ FROM ANDY PEREZ: Grizzlies' INF Andy Perez hit safely in his first 18 games and 23 of his first 24 contests to start the season, his longest hit streak while in a Fresno uniform (two seasons). It was the second longest hit streak in the Grizzlies/Rockies affiliation since Drew Romo in 2021 (21 games, July 6-August 15) and it was the longest active streak in Minor League Baseball at the time. Perez went 26-for-76 (.342 AVG/.383 OBP/.579 SLG/.962 OPS) with three homers (one grand slam), three triples, three doubles, 18 RBI, 12 runs, five walks and two stolen bases in that hit streak stretch. Perez's triple on May 31 at San Jose was his 11th in a Grizzlies uniform, putting him two triples shy of joining the Grizzlies Top 10 Career Records. Juan Melo and Roger Kieschnick are tied for ninth all-time with 13 triples.

MAYBE WE DON'T WANT THE PITCH CLOCK: This season, the Grizzlies are 9-2 overall with a 7-0 record on the road when a game lasts exactly or over 2 hours and 40 minutes. Last year, Fresno went 24-11 in such games (33-13 in two seasons).
