NOTES AND NUGGETS

SEASON 57

2026 marks the 57th season (58th year) in franchise history and the 15th season (16th year) in the Storm Chasers era.

Omaha is coming off a 2025 campaign in which they went 62-86 (.419 winning %) to finish tied 17th in the 20-team International League ... the 2025 Chasers tied for the MiLB lead with 199 home runs, the 4th-most in a season in franchise history.

LONG TIME, NO SEE

This week, the Storm Chasers welcome the Bisons to Werner Park for the first time, with the series marking the Bisons' first trip to Omaha since 1997.

Omaha and Buffalo played in the Triple-A American Association together from 1985 until 1997 ... in 1998, Omaha moved to the Pacific Coast League and Buffalo joined the International League, with Omaha joining the IL in 2021.

In 1997, the Omaha Royals and Buffalo Bisons played 18 games against each other, including 9 at Rosenblatt Stadium ... the most recent trip for Buffalo to Omaha was July 18 to 20, 1997.

SEARCHING FOR NUMBER ONE

The Storm Chasers are still looking for their first win of the 2026 season, after being swept over the weekend in Louisville and dropping yesterday's home opener to Buffalo.

Offensively, infielders **Josh Rojas** and **Abraham Toro** have both recorded hits in all 4 games of the season, while **Peyton Wilson** had a hit in each game of the series in Louisville ... Rojas leads the team with 4 RBI and connected for Omaha's first home run of the year, a 2-run shot in the 3rd inning Sunday.

While it hasn't led to a win, Omaha's 35 hits and 9 doubles both rank tied for the 3rd-most in the International League.

A strong suit for the team so far is the team's bullpen ... 8 of 15 relief appearances through the first four games have been scoreless, including perfect outings in Louisville from **Mason Black** (1.2 IP on March 27) and **Eli Morgan** (1.1 IP on March 28), while **Jose Cuas** has worked 3 scoreless appearances (3.2 IP).

OS-BORN FOR THE JOB

Patrick Osborn begins his 2nd season in Omaha and 1st as manager of the Storm Chasers in 2026, bringing a championship resume to Werner Park.

Osborn served as Omaha's bench coach in 2025, before being named the 20th manager in Triple-A Omaha franchise history in January 2026 ... he is the 4th manager in the 15-season Storm Chasers era of the club (2011-present).

2026 marks his 7th season as a Minor League manager, owning a 375-309 (.548) career record with 5 postseason trips in 6 Yankees-system seasons (2014-19).

He led Double-A Trenton to the 2019 Eastern League championship and was named 2016 Florida State League Manager of the Year with High-A Tampa.

Is a former 2nd-round pick by Cleveland and professional infielder ... recently served as a Marlins pro scout (2020-21) and Miami's Field Coordinator (2021-24).

ROSTER RUNDOWN

The Storm Chasers active roster is made up of 28 players, 13 position players and 15 pitchers.

Outfielder **Gavin Cross** made his Triple-A debut Friday night, the only player on the Breaking Roster who had not yet done so ... the 9th overall pick by the Royals in the 2022 MLB Draft out of Virginia Tech, he has appeared in 217 games with Double-A Northwest Arkansas over the past three seasons.

Only 12 players from last year are represented on the active roster ... 13 of the 28 players are newcomers to the Royals, including 3 acquired by Kansas City via trade and 10 Minor League free agents signed by the Royals in the offseason.

17 of 28 players on Omaha's roster have reached the Majors, combining for over 57 years of MLB service ... 7 members of the roster have 4+ years of MLB service.

STORM CHASERS IN THE WBC

A trio of 2026 Storm Chasers players participated in the recent World Baseball Classic.

Pitcher **Eric Cerantola** and infielder **Abraham Toro** both suited up for Canada ... Cerantola tossed 1.1 scoreless innings over 2 appearances, while Toro hit a team-leading .421 (8-for-19) with 5 extra-base hits and 5 RBI.

Pitcher **Luinder Avila** did not allow an earned run over 4.1 innings and 2 appearances for WBC champion Venezuela, striking out 3.

THE BERGERT BREAKDOWN

- ROTATION ROULETTE:** After making 8 starts with the Royals to end last season, Bergert was in competition for a rotation spot with Kansas City this Spring Training ... he was one of four pitchers vying for the 5th spot in the Royals rotation, along with **Noah Cameron**, **Stephen Kolek** and **Luinder Avila** ... Cameron cracked the Royals' rotation, while Kolek is on KC's IL and Avila starts for Omaha tomorrow.
- BULLSEYE BERGERT:** In his first start of the season last Friday, Bergert did not issue a walk over 4.1 innings ... he went walk-free in just 2 of 26 starts last season between the Major and Minor Leagues ... this marked the 9th time in his career he's tossed 4.0+ innings without a walk (50 such starts).

LAST OUTING: FRIDAY, MARCH 27 @ LOUISVILLE

- Started Opening Night for the Storm Chasers ... worked into the 5th inning, Omaha's longest start of the season to this point ... allowed an RBI double in the 1st to **Héctor Rodríguez** and an RBI single in the 3rd to **Rece Hinds** ... worked around baserunners in the 2nd and 4th innings ...

2026 HIGHLIGHTS

- Made 5 Cactus League starts for the Royals ... went 0-3 with a 7.24 ERA (11 ER in 13.2 IP) and 9 strikeouts.
