game road trip with game three of a six-game series vs. the Norfolk Tides (Baltimore Orioles) at Harbor Park. It is the 15th of 18 meetings between the two clubs this year, and the ninth of 12 games Gwinnett will play in Norfolk. With a win today, the Stripers would avoid losing six straight games for the second time this year (4/16-4/22).

AT NORFOLK: The Stripers are 63-68 (.481) in 131 games all-time at Norfolk's Harbor Park, including 3-5 (.375) in eight games this season. Gwinnett is 6-6-0 in 12 season road series vs. the Tides all-time (2009-current), including 4-2-0 over the last six years (2015-current).

SHEW-MAKING IT HAPPEN: Braden Shewmake tallied a season-high three RBI last night, producing his third multihit effort in his last five games. He has hit safely in nine of 10 games since 6/7, batting .350 (14-for-40, 2 2B, 1 HR, 4 R, 7 RBI, 2 SB, .847 OPS) in that span. In 53 games overall on his Triple-A debut, he's batting .276 (55-for-199, 10 2B, 1 3B, 4 HR, 27 R, 15 RBI, 6 SB, .724 OPS).

KINGS OF THE "K": Stripers pitchers lead Triple-A in strikeouts with 758 in 74 games (10.24 SO per game). That's 13 more than Round Rock of the Pacific Coast League (2nd, 745 SO in 74G). Gwinnett last led Triple-A in strikeouts for a full season in 2011 (team-record 1,223 SO). Kyle Muller (1st, 99), Tucker Davidson (6th, 69), Bryce Elder (T-15th, 59), and Huascar Ynoa (T-15th, 59) all rank among the International League's top 15 in strikeouts.

POSTSEASON HEROES ON REHAB: Two key players from the Atlanta Braves' 2021 World Series championship are currently on injury rehab assignments with Gwinnett: OF Eddie Rosario and LHP Tyler Matzek.

- Rosario: Batting .278 (5-for-18, 22B, 2R, 4RBI) in four games since joining the Stripers on 6/25. He is on the 10-day IL following a procedure to correct blurred vision and swelling in his right retina. Rosario, the 2021 NLCS Most Valuable Player, is rehabbing with Gwinnett for the second time in his career (13G from 8/11-26, 2011).
- Matzek: Has posted a 0.00 ERA (0 ER in 1.0 IP) in one relief appearance since joining the Stripers on 6/29. He is on the 15-day IL with left shoulder inflammation after going 0-1 with a 5.06 ERA and .167 BAA in 13 games with Atlanta this season. It is his second career stint with Gwinnett (0-0, 9.00 ERA in 5G in 2019).

IACKSON ALSO REHABBING: The Braves also assigned RHP Jay Jackson to rehab with Gwinnett on 6/28 (has vet to appear). He has been on the 60-day IL since 3/19 (right lat strain) and has not pitched for Atlanta since being acquired via trade with San Francisco on 11/22/21. In 57 career MLB games (with SD, MIL, SF), he is 3-1 with a 4.31 ERA. .216 BAA, and seven holds.

RISING WATERS: Over his last nine games, Drew Waters is batting .306 (11-for-36, 2 3B, 1 HR, 5 R, 4 RBI, 2 SB, .905 OPS). In 39 games overall, he's batting .258 (39-for-151, 6 2B, 3 3B, 4 HR, 21 R, 14 RBI, 3 SB, .730 OPS).

- Start it With a Bang: Waters has three XBH on the first pitch of the game this year (leadoff homers on 5/3 vs. CLT and 5/11 at DUR, leadoff triple on 6/11 at JAX).
- **GWN Career:** Since making his Triple-A debut in 2019, Waters is batting .249 (165-for-662, 33 2B, 4 3B, 17 HR, 108 R, 62 RBI, 34 SB, .715 OPS) in 168 games.

TODAY: The Stripers continue the second leg of a 12- DESHIELDS KEEPS REACHING: Delino DeShields Jr. has reached base safely in 13 of 15 games with at least one plate appearance in June, batting .333 (13-for-39, 2 2B, 1 HR, 11 R, 6 RBI, 5 SB, .953 OPS). Overall with the Stripers this season, he has reached base safely in 43 of 51 games (84.3%) with a plate appearance, batting .271 (39-for-144, 6 2B, 1 HR, 24 R, 16 RBI, .759 OPS).

• IL Leaderboard: DeShields ranks among the IL top 15 in steals (T-11th, 15) and walks (T-11th, 37).

CAN'T TOUCH TONKIN: Michael Tonkin (0.2 IP. 1 H. 0 R. 1 SO last night) enters play riding a 9.0-inning scoreless streak over his last eight outings. In that stretch, he's posting a 0.56 WHIP (4 H, 1 BB), .129 BAA, 16.00 SO/9.0 IP ratio (16 SO), and two saves (2-for-2). It's the second longest scoreless innings streak by a Stripers pitcher this season, trailing only Nolan Kingham's 9.1-inning, fivegame stretch from 4/5-4/20. In 23 games overall, Tonkin is 3-0 with a 2.35 ERA (6 ER in 23.0 IP), .186 BAA, 15.26 SO/9.0 IP ratio (39 SO), and five saves (5-for-6).

MULLDOZING: Kyle Muller produced his fifth consecutive quality start on 6/25 in a loss at Nashville (7.0 IP, 3 H, 2 ER, 2 BB, 7 SO, 1 HR, season-high 105 pitches). Over that five-start span, he is 2-1 with a 1.87 ERA (7 ER in 33.2 IP), 0.77 WHIP. .171 BAA. and 11.49 SO/9.0 IP ratio (43 SO).

- IL Leaderboard: Muller leads the league in strikeouts (99) and is among the top 10 in ERA (2nd, 2.96), WHIP (2nd, 1.08), BAA (2nd, .215), and innings (3rd, 76.0).
- GWN Career: Since making his Triple-A debut in 2021, he is 9-8 with a 3.18 ERA (55 ER in 155.2 IP), .219 BAA, and 192 strikeouts (11.10 SO/9.0 IP ratio) in 30 starts.

DEMERITTE RETURNS: Travis Demeritte is batting .167 (7for-42, 4 R, 1 RBI, 2 SB) in 11 games with Gwinnett since being optioned by Atlanta on 5/28. He hit .213 (19-for-89, 2 2B, 3 HR, 9 R, 6 RBI) in 26 games during his first career stint with the Braves from 4/22-5/27.

• GWN Career: Demeritte has reached base safely in 170 of 200 games (85.0%) with the Stripers since 2019, batting .277 (192-for-693, 49 2B, 4 3B, 43 HR, 130 R, 138 RBI, 15 SB, .914 OPS). He is one of three players in Gwinnett history with two 20-homer seasons, joining Stefan Gartrell and Ernesto Mejia.

CASTEEL IN THE CLUTCH: Ryan Casteel lifted an oppositefield two-run homer (#6) to right off RHP Alec Bettinger on Thursday at Nashville, leading the Stripers to a 4-1 win. Of Casteel's 15 hits this season, 10 have gone for extra bases (3 doubles, 1 triple, 6 homers). For his Gwinnett career, 48.0% of his hits have been for extra bases (24 of 50), including nine doubles, one triple, and 14 homers.

PROSPECTING: Gwinnett's active roster features six listed on the MLB.com Atlanta Braves Top 30 Prospects list: OF Drew Waters (2), LHP Kyle Muller (3), RHP Bryce Elder (4), SS Braden Shewmake (5), LHP Tucker Davidson (No. 7), and RHP Victor Vodnik (12).

MANAGER MATT TUIASOSOPO

Matt Tuiasosopo is in his second season as the manager of the Stripers in 2022 ... He was named the seventh manager in Gwinnett history on 3/30/21, making him the first former Gwinnett player to manage the club (played OF/1B from 2016-17) . In 2021, he guided the Stripers to a 71-58 record (3rd in Triple-A East Southeast Division) ... On 5/4/21 at Charlotte, he became the youngest manager in Gwinnett history (34 years, 11 months, 25 days) ... On 6/9/22 at Jacksonville, he became the fourth manager in Gwinnett history to reach 100 career wins ... Began his managerial career with Class-A Rome in 2019, earning Atlanta's Bobby Cox Award for MiLB Manager of the Year ... Coached at the Braves' Alternate Training Site in 2020.

TODAY'S START: Huascar Ynoa makes his 12th start for Gwinnett and 14th start of the season overall in game three of a six-game series at Norfolk.

- <u>GWN Career:</u> Makes his 31st career appearance (28th start) with Gwinnett dating back to his Triple-A debut in 2019 (6-9, 5.17 ERA, .255 BAA, 149 SO in 134.0 IP).
- <u>Triple-A Splits:</u> In 27 career starts, is 5-9 with a 5.30 ERA and .259 BAA ... In 15 career Triple-A road appearances (13 starts), is 3-4 with a 5.64 ERA and .276 BAA.

2022 WITH GWINNETT: Since joining the Stripers on 4/19, has pitched at least 5.0 innings in seven of his nine starts ... **4/24-5/26:** Over his first six starts, went 1-2 with a 5.64 ERA (19 ER in 30.1 IP) and .228 BAA ... **Since 6/1:** In four starts in June, is 2-1 with a 2.86 ERA (4 ER in 16.0 IP) (ranks 8th in the IL) and .192 BAA ... **6/7 at JAX:** Fired 7.0 no-hit innings (3 BB, 6 SO) for the win, combining with **Brandyn Sittinger** (1.0 IP, 1 H) and **Brad Brach** (1.0 IP, 0 H) on a one-hit shutout in a 7-0 victory.
