**TODAY'S GAME / OPPOSING STARTER:** The Curve hook up for another series with the Akron RubberDucks, who took 4-of-6 games from the Curve in the first full week of the season. Akron is loaded with returners like RHP Aaron Davenport and Tommy Mace in the rotation. INF Travis Bazzana, the No. 1 overall pick in 2024 out of Oregon State, highlights their prospect group. Bazzana was born in Australia and made history with Chase Burns (Italy, selected No.2 overall by Cincinnati) as the first pair to be born overseas and selected at the top of the draft.

On the mound, Rorik Maltrud takes the ball again for the 'Ducks. Maltrud has pitched twice against Altoona this season, striking out 8 batters in 3.2 innings and in both of his starts matched up against Po-Yu Chen; as he is today. A 25-year-old from Austin, TX, Maltrud joined the Guardians in January of 2024 after his well-traveled collegiate career at Oklahoma (Fall only, 2018), Grayson CC (19-20), New Mexico State (21-22) and Missouri (2023). He turned in a fine pro debut at Lake County and Lynchburg, recording a 3.44 ERA in 24 games, 19 starts.

**JEBBING:** Utilityman **Mitch Jebb** has reached in 8 straight games, during which he's batted .414 (12-for-29) with 5 BB and 4-4 SB. His .402 on-base percentage this season is 7th in the Eastern League.

**SAMMY SLAMS:** Outfielder **Sammy Siani** has reached in 12 straight games, the longest stretch of his Double-A career. Since April 16, he's batting .319/.407/.511 with a .918 OPS, 2 2B, 2 3B, 1 HR, 12 RBI and 6-6 SB.

**SCAN THIS BARCODE FOR OUTS:** Lefty **Hunter Barco** has tossed 20.2 consecutive scoreless innings to begin the season, the longest stretch to begin a season since Roansy Contreras tossed 18.2 scoreless to begin the 2021 season. The longest scoreless streak in franchise history belongs to lefty **Jared Lakind** who threw 25.1 scoreless innings during the 2016 season.

Barco was named the Eastern League Pitcher of the Week for the week of April 21-27 after striking out 16 batters in 7.2 innings across two outings against the Baysox.

**ENTER SANDMAN:** Righty **Cam Sanders** leads all minor league relievers with 7 saves entering play on Thursday, May 1. Sanders is the first Curve reliever to pick up 7 saves in a calendar month since **Matt Eckelman** saved 8 games in June of 2019. **Justin Kaye** (June, 2005) and **Matt Peterson** (June, 2007) hold the record for saves in a month by a Curve pitcher with 9.

**ON THE MEND:** Infielder **Spencer Horwitz** made his organizational debut with the Pirates Sunday at Chesapeake, he is 1-for-4 with 2 walks in 6 plate appearances during his rehab.

Horwitz was acquired from the Cleveland Guardians in exchange for RHP **Luis Ortiz**, LHP **Michael Kennedy** and LHP **Josh Hartle** this past off-season and is rehabbing an injured wrist. Horwitz, like **Isiah Kiner-Falefa** last year, will play for the Curve before he plays for the Pirates. Horwitz made his major league debut in 2023 for Toronto and last season led all qualified MLB rookies with a .357 on-base percentage last season. He recorded a .790 OPS in 97 games for the Blue Jays.

**A YOUNG MAN'S GAME:** Infielder **Termarr Johnson** opens as the youngest position player in the Eastern League at 20 years old, just two days younger than Reading's **Aidan Miller**. Among Double-A players, he is the 7th-youngest player at the level; the youngest is San Antonio's **Ethan Salas** (SD, 18.8 years old). Johnson has reached base safely in 26-of-34 games with the Curve and has a hit in 15-of-20 games to begin the season. **Johnson was 10-for-31 (.323) with a double and pair of solo home runs during his seven-game hitting streak that ended on Tuesday, July 29.**

**OUT FOR A WALK:** Altoona hitters are 4th among all Double-A clubs with 109 walks in 23 games this season.

**IT'S ABOUT HOW YOU START:** Curve starters tossed 15 scoreless innings to begin the season (Barco, Dotel, Solometo, Chen). Overall, Curve starters held a 1.05 WHIP, 2nd among Double-A staffs and 3.23 ERA, 6th among Double-A clubs through play on April 29.

**THE PIRATES ARE THIEVES:** Altoona enters play on Thursday, May 1, 4th among Double-A clubs with 40 stolen bases in 47 tries. **Mitch Jebb** leads the club with 9 steals, 1st in the Eastern League, 4th among Double-A players.

**WE'LL SEE THEM ALL:** For the first time since the 2019 season and the creation of the six-game series, the Curve will face every team in the Eastern League this season. Altoona will face New Hampshire and Binghamton on the road only, while Hartford and Reading will only play the Curve at PNG Field.

## TODAY IN CURVE HISTORY PRESENTED BY

2024 - Altoona's losing streak matches the franchise record (set in 2000) at 11 straight games with a 5-4 loss at Harrisburg. After taking a 4-1 lead in the 7th, the Curve bullpen surrendered 4 runs over the final 3 innings, capped off by a walk-off solo homer from Brady House in the 9th.

Changed number from #35 to #45 on 4/25... Completed 5.0 IP for the first time on 5/3 at HBG... Faced fellow Taiwanese prospect Hao-Yu Lee on 5/21 @ Erie (Lee lined into DP in 1st and homered in 3rd), did so again on 5/26 (struck him out looking and walked)... Pitched opposite fellow Taiwanese pitching prospect CJ Liu on 6/1 vs. Portland... Pittsburgh was able to secure his services after trading for International Bonus Pool money in deals that sent Domingo Robles to St. Louis and Jarrod Dyson to the Chicago White Sox... Would be just the 12th pitcher from Taiwan to reach the major leagues... His father Ping-Nan Chen played professionally in the Chinese Professional Baseball League... Attended the National Taiwan Sport University, same preparatory school that former Curve C Jin-De Jhang, former Richmond Flying Squirrel RHP Kai-Wei Teng and Orioles/Marlins LHP Wei-Yin Chen attended...
