**LAST TIME OUT:** The Cyclones suffered a heartbreaking defeat to the Renegades on Sunday, 8-7, in 10 innings...The Renegades scored two in the bottom of the 10th to walk off with a victory thanks to a SS **Brenny Escanio** RBI double and a CF **Jace Avina** sacrifice fly...Brooklyn had taken the lead in the 10th on a wild pitch after C **Christian Pregent** tied it with a run-scoring double in the eighth...Pregent went 2-for-5 with a double and an RBI...LF **Stanley Consuegra** tied a career-best with four hits, adding a double and two RBI...DH **Wilfredo Lara** and SS **William Lugo** each accrued multi-hit games, with the latter reaching base three times...1B **Nick Lorusso** brought in a pair of runs without the benefit of a base hit...RHP **Ben Simon** tossed a scoreless inning and faced the minimum in his first appearance after being reinstated from the injured list...The 3-hour and 36-minute contest was Brooklyn's longest this year...It was the longest for the Cyclones since an 8-7 win in 3 hours and 47 minutes at Hudson Valley on July 21, 2023.

**SUPER STANLEY:** OF **Stanley Consuegra** is in the midst of his best offensive stretch of the season...The 23-year-old tallied a career-high-tying four hits in Sunday's loss at Hudson Valley...Consuegra has accomplished the feat four times, most recently on April 13, 2023, at Winston-Salem...He is also the second Cyclone to reach that mark in 2024, joining CF **Nick Morabito** (5/28 @ JS)...Since May 17 at Bowling Green, he's hitting .315/.418/.598 with a 1.016 OPS...The Santo Domingo, D.R. native has scored 14 runs and added eight doubles, six home runs, and 20 RBI...Consuegra has raised his batting average by 68 points (.171 to .239) and his OPS by 233 points (.519 to .752) during the stretch...Since that date, the right-handed slugger is tied for third in the South Atlantic League in extra-base hits (14), fourth in total bases (55), and tied for fourth in doubles (8)...Consuegra set the Cyclones' all-time doubles record (40) on June 8 vs. Aberdeen and the all-time hits mark (184) on May 29 at Jersey Shore...He is also the franchise's all-time leader in extra-base hits (81), home runs (35), RBI (121), and outfield assists (19)...Consuegra also holds the single-season mark for home runs (23), and extra-base hits (42), and is tied with INF **Ronny Mauricio** (63) for single-season RBI.

**LARRUPIN' LORUSSO:** INF **Nick Lorusso** has been one of the best hitters in the South Atlantic League throughout 2024...The 23-year-old is tied for seventh in the circuit in extra-base hits (23) and 10th in total bases (95)...Lorusso sits third among New York Mets' full-season minor leaguers in slugging (.480) and extra-base hits (23)...He is also tied for third in triples (3), fourth in home runs (9) and OPS (.843), and sixth in RBI (34).

**MARVELOUS MORABITO:** OF **Nick Morabito** has been as good as any offensive player in Minor League Baseball in 2024...Morabito is sixth in Minor League Baseball in stolen bases (32), tied for seventh in on-base percentage (.452), and tied for 12th in batting average (.337)...Since making his South Atlantic League debut on May 7, the former second-round pick leads the league in steals (21), is tied for second in runs scored (29), and eighth in on-base percentage (.401).

**JUNIOR MINTS:** INF **Junior Tilién** enters play with the longest active on-base streak in the South Atlantic League, reaching in 23 consecutive games since Game 1 of a doubleheader on May 16 at Bowling Green...During the streak, the 21-year-old has accumulated a .279/.369/.407 slash line with a .776 OPS adding three doubles, a triple, two home runs, 11 RBI, and 13 walks...The infielder is the first Cyclone to record an on-base streak of 20 or more games since INF **José Peroza** reached in 31-consecutive games from July 29 until September 2, 2022...Tilién also posted a 10-game hitting streak from May 26 until June 9...He slashed .375/.409/.550 with a .959 OPS in that time.

**SUERO SUAVE:** C **Chris Suero** has started to find his rhythm offensively in the South Atlantic League...The 20-year-old capped last week's series vs. Aberdeen with his first career multi-home run game, blasting two-run shots in the fourth and sixth innings...In five games against the IronBirds, Suero was 7-for-16 (.438) at the dish with seven runs scored, a double, three home runs, and an eye-popping 11 RBI...Since May 17 at Bowling Green, Suero has reached safely in 20 of 21 games, hitting .288/.429/.466 with a .895 OPS...The Bronx native has scored a whopping 19 runs with a double, four home runs, 18 RBI, and 17 walks...Since that date, Suero is tied for seventh in the SAL in walks (17), tied for eighth in on-base percentage (.429), and tied for ninth in runs scored (19).

**FETTUCINE WILFREDO:** INF **Wilfredo Lara** has been scorching hot for the Cyclones since May 19...The 20-year-old has appeared in 24 games and tallied a .298/.406/.440 line with a .846 OPS...Lara has scored 19 runs and added two

**vs. JERSEY SHORE:** Brooklyn returns home for a six-game series, including the final three games of the season's first half, against the Phillies' High-A affiliate...Jersey Shore boasts seven of Philadelphia's top 30 prospects per MLB Pipeline: INF **Aidan Miller** (2), OF **Justin Crawford** (4), INF **William Bergolla** (11), OF **Emarion Boyd** (16), OF **Hendry Mendez** (22), LHP **Sam Aldegheri** (23), RHP **George Klassen** (28)...The Cyclones split both series played in 2024 at ShoreTown Ballpark, going 6-6 in 12 contests...Brooklyn does not return to Jersey Shore in the 2024 regular season, hosting the final 15 meetings...In 2023, Brooklyn dropped the season series to the Jersey Shore, 15-11...The Cyclones were 11-6 in Lakewood and 4-5 on Coney Island...Dating back to 2021, Brooklyn leads the all-time series, 52-43 (.547).

doubles, two triples, two home runs, 11 RBI, 13 walks, and five stolen bases...Lara also had a 13-game on-base streak since May 26 vs. Hudson Valley snapped last Wednesday...He hit .372/.509/.535 with a 1.044 OPS during the stretch.

**OH, HENRY!** The Cyclones added RHP **Henry Henry** from Single-A St. Lucie on Tuesday...The 25-year-old made his New York Mets' organizational debut in Game 2 of a doubleheader on June 14 at Jupiter...Henry retired all three batters he faced, striking out one, on 10 pitches...Signed by New York as a minor league free agent on May 16, the San Cristóbal, D.R. native spent the first eight seasons of his professional career in the San Diego Padres...Between High-A Fort Wayne and Double-A San Antonio, Henry was 3-4 with a 5.19 ERA (29 ER in 50.1 IP) with 35 walks and 37 strikeouts in 34 appearances (three starts) in 2023...Henry Henry is not to be confused with former Pittsburgh Pirates infield prospect **Henry Henry** or the Cyclones' legendary on-field emcee **King Henry**.

**WALK THIS WAY:** INF **William Lugo** has had a keen eye at the plate in 2024, drawing 45 walks...That number ranks second in the South Atlantic League, while his 19.7% walk rate is first...Among minor leaguers with 200 or more plate appearances, Lugo sits fifth in walk rate...Major League Baseball's top prospect and Triple-A Norfolk's (Baltimore) SS **Jackson Holiday**, as well as Lugo's former Cyclone teammate and Double-A Binghamton's IF/OF **Ryan Clifford** are tied for the MiLB lead (22.0%).

**YOU'LL GET NOTHING AND LIKE IT:** RHPs **Dakota Hawkins** (5.0 IP), **Joey Lancellotti** (1.0), and **Joshua Cornielli** (3.0) combined on the first nine-inning no-hitter in Brooklyn Cyclones history June 4's 3-0 win vs. Aberdeen...The only previous no-hitter came on August 23, 2009, when RHP **Brandon Moore** tossed a seven-inning no-no in a 5-0 win during Game 1 of a doubleheader at Aberdeen...It is one of four no-hitters in Minor League Baseball in 2024...Last Tuesday's effort was the first no-hitter by a Mets minor league affiliate since RHP **Joander Suárez** hurled a seven-inning one on September 7 at Hartford...It was also the first nine-inning no-hitter thrown in the borough of Brooklyn since RHP **Sal Maglie** tossed a no-no for the Dodgers against the Philadelphia Phillies on September 25, 1956, at Ebbets Field.

**CALM, COLÓN, COLLECTED:** RHP **Jeffrey Colón** was sublime out of the bullpen for the Cyclones last Wednesday night...The 24-year-old stranded the bases loaded with one out in the second inning, hurling 6.2 innings of shutout ball...Colón scattered four hits and struck out a season-best six...The 6.2 innings on the hill was the longest effort by the Las Matas de Farfán, D.R. native since he threw 6.2 innings in a start, taking a no-decision, on May 26, 2023, vs. Winston-Salem...The 6.2 innings of the bump also matched the longest outing by a Cyclone pitcher this year...RHP **Jonah Tong** tossed 6.2 innings of one-run ball to earn the win in a start vs. Hudson Valley on May 21...Colón is the first Brooklyn relief pitcher to toss 6.2+ innings since RHP **Jordan Geber** posted 7.0 scoreless innings to earn the win vs. Aberdeen on May 7, 2023...Colón and Geber are the only South Atlantic League pitchers to throw 6.2+ innings in a single game since the start of the 2023 season.

**ATOP THE HEJ-ES:** RHP **Josh Hejka** earned his first save of the season on May 5 vs. Aberdeen, making his Cyclones' franchise-record-setting 48th pitching appearance in the process...The 27-year-old broke a tie with **Hunter Parsons** (47) for the most pitching appearances in Cyclones franchise history...In his 60 career outings for Brooklyn since 2019, Hejka has accumulated a 5-3 record with a 2.37 ERA (26 ER in 98.2 IP) and 6 saves, walking just 24 and striking out 87.

**AMAZIN' STARTS HERE:** The Brooklyn Cyclones have several Top 30 prospects according to *Baseball America* and MLB Pipeline...The Clones have three of the Top 30 per BA: **Kade Morris** (21), **Jonah Tong** (22) and **Calvin Ziegler** (29)...Ziegler is currently on the full-season injured list...Plus four of the Top 30 per MLB: Tong (20), Ziegler (23), **Wilfredo Lara** (24), and OF **Nick Morabito** (26).

**LAST TIME OUT:** Suffered team-high fifth defeat of the season last Wednesday night at Hudson Valley...Surrendered a season-high six runs on seven hits in 1.1 innings...All six runs came in the bottom of the second inning...Walked two, struck out one, and plunked a batter...Tossed a wild pitch...Threw 45 pitches and 29 strikes (64.44%)...Relieved by RHP **Jeffrey Colón** with the bases loaded and one out in the bottom of the second and Brooklyn trailing, 6-0...All three bequeathed runners were stranded...Colón tossed the final 6.2 innings of the game and did not yield a run, but the Cyclones were two-hit by the Renegades, 6-0.

**PROSPECT RADAR:** After a stellar 2023 season, De La Cruz was deemed the New York Mets' No. 39 prospect entering the 2024 campaign by *Baseball America*.

**HOME COOKING:** De La Cruz has been outstanding on Coney Island in 2024...Through his first five starts of the campaign, the southpaw is 1-2 with a 1.61 ERA (4 ER in 22.1 IP), 10 walks, and 31 strikeouts...De La Cruz has not seen the same level of success on the road...The 23-year-old holds a 2-3 mark in visiting parks, but yields a 6.35 ERA (16 ER in 22.2 IP), with 10 walks, and 24 strikeouts...Among South Atlantic League pitchers with at least 20.0 innings pitched at home, De La Cruz ranks sixth in ERA (1.61)...Teammates RHP **Douglas Orellana** (0.44) and RHP **Dakota Hawkins** (1.57) sit first and fifth, respectively.

**FELIP-IN' AMAZIN':** The 23-year-old celebrated his birthday by shutting out Hudson Valley on May 25 over 6.0 innings with a career-high 13 strikeouts...De La Cruz was one shy of the single game Brooklyn franchise record of 14 set by LHP **Mike Cox** (8/25/01 vs. HV) and RHP **Brad Holt** (7/24/08 vs. VER)...He was the first Cyclone to strike out 13+ hitters in a single contest since RHP **Rob Gsellman** accomplished the feat on August 24, 2013, at Vermont...De La Cruz is the sixth Cyclones pitcher ever to hit the 13 punchout threshold and the third to strikeout 13 or more in 6.0 or fewer innings.

**WELCOME TO BROOKLYN:** The 22-year-old joined the Cyclones from Single-A St. Lucie last year on August 22 and thrived over three starts...De La Cruz accumulated a 2-1 record with a 2.45 ERA (5 ER in 17.0 IP) with five walks and 17 strikeouts...The southpaw hurled quality starts in two of his three starts, including going all six innings in the lid-lifter of a doubleheader on August 31 at Greenville...After allowing a leadoff home run, De La Cruz retired 18 of the final 19 batters he faced, including sitting the last 11 down in order...The southpaw was credited with a complete game, the first for a Brooklyn pitcher since RHP **José Butto** accomplished the feat, tossing six innings in a seven-inning loss at Aberdeen in Game 1 of a twinbill on June 30, 2021...After making his SAL debut on August 23 at Asheville, De La Cruz ranked third in the circuit in WHIP (0.94), fifth in batting average against (.183), and sixth in ERA (2.65).

**FLORIDA STATE FELIPE:** De La Cruz was among the best strikeout artists in the Florida State League in 2023...Among FSL pitchers with 90.0 or more innings pitched, the 22-year-old led the circuit in strikeout rate (28.7%)...The southpaw also led the league in strikeouts-per-9 innings (11.36) and swinging strike rate (15.5%), while ranking 2nd in xFIP (3.68)...In 21 appearances (19 starts) with St. Lucie, De La Cruz was 3-6 with a 4.68 ERA (47 ER in 90.1 IP), 41 walks, and 114 strikeouts.
