Lansing won the series opener, but Dayton has won each of the last three contests, leading Lansing 11-8 in the 21-game season series. This is the 404th all-time Lansing/Dayton matchup.

Last Night: Dragons 7, Lugnuts 2. Debuting Lansing right-hander **Kade Morris** fired seven quality innings, but Dayton broke a 2-2 tie in the seventh on a **Carter Graham** sacrifice fly, added a **Logan Tanner** grand slam in the eighth inning, and beat the Lugnuts for a third straight game. In defeat, right fielder **Jared Dickey** went 4-for-5, but the Nuts stranded 14 runners on base.

Look at the New Guys! In his debut last night, **Kade Morris** tossed seven innings – the longest outing for a Lugnuts starter all season. Morris had been acquired by the A's at the trade deadline on Tuesday from the New York Mets for Paul Blackburn. Meanwhile, outfielder **Jared Dickey** – acquired in a three-player package for Lucas Erceg from Kansas City – has opened his Lugnuts career with eight hits in his first 14 at-bats, going 4-for-5 last night with an RBI single.

Team Effort: The Nuts' offense is 1st in the Midwest League in batting average (.251), at-bats (3,337), base hits (839), total bases (1,281) and triples (35); 2nd in runs (502), doubles (165) and slugging percentage (.384); tied for 2nd in OPS (.723); and 3rd in on-base percentage (.339).

Heart & Hustle: 2021 Lugnuts utilityman **Max Schuemann** was named the A's nominee for the 2024 MLB Heart & Hustle Award on Thursday. From the Heart & Hustle website: "Created by the Major League Baseball Players Alumni Association in 2005, the Heart & Hustle Award is voted on by Alumni and active Major League players and is presented annually to an active player who demonstrates a passion for the game of baseball and best embodies the values, spirit and traditions of the game."

To the Show: 2017 & 2019 Lugnuts infielder **Luis De Los Santos** made his Major League debut for the Blue Jays on Wednesday, becoming the 6th Lugnut to debut this season and the 190th all-time Nut to go from Lansing to the Majors.

Prospecting: The Nuts have six MLB Pipeline Top 30 A's prospects: pitcher **Luis Morales** (No. 2), outfielder **Ryan Lasko** (No. 16), pitcher **Kade Morris** (No. 20), infielder **Will Simpson** (No. 26), pitcher **Will Johnston** (No. 27) and outfielder **Jared Dickey** (No. 28).

The Future is Here: Lugs right-hander **Luis Morales**, tomorrow's starting pitcher, tossed 2/3 of an inning in the 2024 All-Star Futures Game at Globe Life Field in Arlington, Texas, striking out Jeral Pérez and Deyvison De Los Santos alongside an HBP and BB. Morales was the A's sole representative in the prospect showcase, and the fifth all-time current Lugnut to play in the game.

TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2011: Casey Lawrence pitched a nine-inning complete game, and the host Lugnuts beat South Bend, 6-1. Lawrence allowed four hits, one run, no walks and three strikeouts. The game took two hours and 13 minutes. Groundout:flyout ratio for Casey: a ridiculous 20 groundouts and one flyout.

2022: For the second straight game, Denzel Clarke hit an inside-the-park home run, blasting an RJ Petit pitch off the right-center fence at Jackson Field and scoring standing up when the ball bounced past center field Ben Malgeri. In the process, he became the first Lugnut since Tim Locastro in 2015 with two inside-the-park home runs in the same year and the second MiLB player ever, joining Everett's Fred Bello (July 2-3, 2010), to have inside-the-park homers in two straight games. The feat has never occurred in the Majors. The Lugnuts went on to win the game, 8-1.

In a Nutshell: Excelled in his Lugnuts debut on May 2 vs. South Bend, becoming the club's 11th different starting pitcher this year and the 939th all-time player to put on the Lansing uniform... replaced the demoted Eduardo Rivera and tossed five scoreless two-hit innings, striking out six Cubs... followed up with eight strikeouts in three hitless innings with his mother in attendance at Great Lakes, May 8... grew up idolizing Max Scherzer... enjoys the great outdoors... notable splits:

Prospecting: Rated the A's No. 27 prospect and No. 12 pitching prospect by MLB Pipeline... grades: fastball 50, slider 45, change-up 55, control 50, overall 40... they write, "With low expectations, Johnston began his first full season of pro ball at age 23 with Single-A Stockton, but he threw so well out of the gate he earned a quick promotion up to High-A Lansing at the end of April... Johnston has shown a better feel for his three-pitch arsenal than some expected given his college numbers. He adds and subtracts from his fastball, throwing it typically in the 89-94 mph range, though he's shown in the past the ability to reach back for a 95 or 96-mph heater on occasion. The pitch has played up a bit because he can pitch north and south with it. His best pitch is now his split-changeup, which flashes plus and can be a true out pitch at times. His low-80s breaking ball can be on the slurve side, but it can be effective."

Stockton Sensation: Opened 2024 with the Class A Ports... made two relief appearances and two starts, facing 46 batters and whiffing 26 of them ... debuted with 4 2/3 hitless innings with eight strikeouts on April 6... followed up with three perfect innings with 7 K on 4/12.

Gig 'Em: Majored in finance at Texas A&M... pitched primarily out of Aggies' bullpen; career stats: 6-4, 5.77 ERA, 66 G, 8 GS, 8 SV, 98 1/3 IP, 57 BB, 132 K... finest year at College Station was in 2022: 3.25 ERA, 23 G, 2 GS, 4 SV, 36 IP, 2 HR, 18 BB, 49 K... struggled in 2023 to 5.89 ERA due to 9 HR and 31 BB in 47 1/3 IP, though he struck out 70 batters... drafted following his fourth season at A&M... joined fellow Aggies Micah Dallas (8th round, 2022) and Nathan Dettmer (5th round, 2023) as Aggies drafted by the A's, and one of seven Aggies drafted overall in 2023... signed for \$150,000... notable Aggies in the pros include Chuck Knoblauch, Davey Johnson, Wally Moon, Michael Wacha, Ross Stripling and A.J. Minter.

Back Home: Batted .413 with seven homers during senior year at Keller High School; ascended from closer as a sophomore (posting 11-0 record with 11 saves) to ace as senior; compiled three-year record of 21-2... Keller High School also produced Shea Langeliers and Max Muncy 1.0.
