LAST TIME OUT: The Cyclones secured their 3rd-straight win with an 8-3 trium at Jersey Shore on Friday night...Brooklyn scored 6 of its 8 runs in the top of the 3rd...CF Carson Benge powered an opposite-field grand slam to left and 18 Estarling Mercado later followed with a two-run home run to left-center..Benge reached base 3 times with 2 hits and a walk, while Mercado collected a game-high 3 hits...C Chris Suero was ejected after he was plunked by BlueClaws RHP Aaron Combs in between the 3rd inning home runs.....Combs and Jersey Shore manager Greg Brodzinski were also tossed after the benches cleared..PR-C Ronald Hernández entered for Suero as a pinch runner and corralled 2 hits...RHP R.J. Gordon earned his 2nd-straight victory, throwing a career-high 5.0 innings of 1-run ball, striking out a career-high Saúl García, Anthony Nunez, and Brian Metoyer combined to toss 3.0 innings of hitless and shutout relief from the 7th inning on to seal the win.

RAIN, RAIN GO AWAY: The Cyclones endured their 2nd rainout of the 2025 season when Saturday's matchup at Jersey Shore was washed out...The contest will be made up with a pair of 7-inning contests when Brooklyn returns to ShoreTown Ballpark from May 20-25...Brooklyn's first rain out of the season came on April 11 vs. Hudson Valley...The Cyclones split the ensuing doubleheader, dropping the opener, 2-0, and winning the nightcap, 2-1...In 2024, Brooklyn went 7-5 in 12 twinbill games and 2-1-3 in doubleheaders overall.

ELI'S ELITE NIGHT: OF Eli Serrano III put together his best game as a professional in Thursday night's win at Jersey Shore...The 21-year-old went 5-for-6 at the plate, scored 3 runs, doubled twice, blasted a solo home run in the 8th, and drove in 3...Since 2005, Serrano is the 1st Cyclone to record 5+ hits, 3 runs, 3+ extra-base hits, a home run, and 3+ RBI in a single game...He is only the 2nd Brooklyn player to record 5-or-more hits, hit a home run, and drive in 3-or-more runs in a single game since 2005...2B Luke Ritter also accomplished the feat with 5 hits, a home run, and 3 RBI in a 5-4 win vs. Lowelli in 11 innings on June 28, 2019...Ritter's home run was a game-tying blast in the 9th...Serrano is also the 2nd Cyclone to tally a 5-hit game at the High-A level and 9th overall since 2005...LF Alex Ramírez was the last player to accomplish the feat with a franchise-record 6 hits on July 21, 2023, at Hudson Valley....Entering Saturday, Serrano is tied for 7th in the South Atlantic League in walks (15).

BORN TO RUNS: The Cyclones tallied 12 runs and 17 hits en route to a 12-5 win at Jersey Shore on Thursday...It marked the 2nd time this season in which Brooklyn collected 12 or more runs and 17 or more hits in a single game...The Cyclones accrued 15 runs and 20 hits in a 15-1 win s. Wilmington on April 5...Thursday marked the 6th time Brooklyn had tallied 12-plus runs and 17-plus hits in a single game since moving to the High-A level before the 2021 season...It is also the first time since 2021 that the Cyclones have had multiple games with 12+ runs and 17+ hits in the same season.

HANG ESTAR ON THAT BABY: INF Estarling Mercado has been red hot with the bat to start 2025...The 22-year-old tallied his 3rd 3-hit game of the season on Friday night, clubbing a 2-run home run in the 3rd inning...Entering play on Saturday, Mercado is hitting .410 (16-39) with 6 runs scored, 5 extra-base hits, a home run, and 7 RBI...Since April 10, the left-handed swinger has reached base safely in 7 of 8 games, posting a .464 average (13-28) with 4 runs scored, 3 extra-base knocks, a home run, and 6 batted in...Among South Atlantic League players with 45 or more plate appearances, Mercado ranks 2nd in batting average (.410) and OPS (1.093),, 3rd in on-base percentage (.478), and 6th in slugging percentage (.615).

CALIFORNIA LOVE: UTL D'Andre Smith is off to a marvelous start in 2025...The Diamond Bar, Calif. native is currently riding a 6-game on-base streak, going 8-for-19 (.421) at the plate with 5 runs scored, 3 doubles, a home run, 3 RBI, 3 walks, and a stolen base...Smith enters play on Sunday ranked 7th in the South Atlantic League in batting average (.302) and 10th in OPS (.880).

DONUTS FOR DÍAZ: RHP Joel Díaz has put nothing but donuts on the scoreboard to start the 2025 season...The 21-year-old has not allowed a run on 9 hits with 2 walks and 18 strikeouts in 15.2 innings over 4 appearances (2 starts)...Diaz is 1 of only 2 pitchers at the High-A level to throw 15.0 or more innings and not allow an earned run (Aberdeen's RHP Braxton Bragg)...He is the only one not to allow a run at all...Diaz is 1 of 3 arms across Minor League Baseall to not allow a run over 15.0 or more innings on the hill...Double-A Altoona's LHP Hunter Barco (17.2 IP) and Double-A Somerset's RHP Brendan Beck (15.0) are the others...The right-hander enters Sunday tied for the South Atlantic League lead in ERA (0.00)...The San Cristóbal, D.R. native is also 4th in the circuit in WHIP (0.70) and 8th in batting average against (161)...Diaz is also 2nd in the SAL in FIP (2.20) and swinging strike percentage (16.8%), 4th in walk rate (3.4%), and 8th in strikeout-to-walk rate (27.1%).

A THORN-TON IN THEIR SIDE: LHP Zach Thornton has been utterly dominant to start 2025...The southpaw's 20.0-inning scoreless streak to start the season was snapped when a run scored on a passed ball in the 5th inning on Thursday at Jersey Shore...Entering play on Friday, the 23-year-old is 7th in all of Minor League Baseball in ERA (0.44) and WHIP (0.68)...Among South Atlantic League arms, Thornton is tied for the league lead in wins (3)...He is also 3rd in ERA (0.44) and WHIP (0.68), tied for 5th in innings pitched (20.2), tied for 6th in strikeouts (25), and 9th in batting average against (162)...Thornton is also 2nd in the SAL in walk rate (2.6%), 3rd in strikeout-to-walk rate (29.5%), 4th in xFIP (2.86), 7th in ground ball rate (51.1%), and 8th in strikeout rate (32.1%) and FIP (2.71)...The Lawrence, Kan, native posted a career-high-tying 6.0 innings of 1-hit shutout ball, striking out a career-high-matching 8, while facing the minimum on April 18 at Aberdeen, earning New York Mets' Minor League Pitcher of the Week on Monday.

START ME UP: Brooklyn's starters have been exquisite over the season's first 17 games...Cyclones starting pitchers possess a 2.17 ERA (19 ER in 78.2 IP)...Under the leadership of first-year pitching coach Jordan Kraus, the starters hold an impressive 97-to-26 strikeout-to-walk ratio...The 2.17 ERA is the lowest among starting pitching staffs in the South Atlantic League. Aberdeen is 2nd (2.54)...It is also 2nd among all High-A franchises...Kansas City's Quad Cities (1.72) has the lowest mark at the level...Overall, Brooklyn's pitching staff has a 2.69 ERA (49 ER in 164.0 IP), which is good for the 2nd-lowest at High-A and lowest in the SAL behind only Quad Cities (2.41)...The 2.69 ERA ranks 2nd in all of Minor League Baseball...Quad Cities (2.33) holds the top spot.

WHAT A RELIEF!: Brooklyn's bullpen has been dominant in the 2025 season...Entering play on Sunday, Cyclones relievers have a 8-2 record with a 3.16 ERA (30 ER in 85.1 IP), 4 saves, 51 walks, and an eye-popping 119 strikeouts...Brooklyn's 1.10 WHIP from relief arms is tied for the lowest at the High-A level with Hudson Valley and tied for 5th-lowest in Minor League Baseball...Detroit's Double-A Erie (0.94) is 1st...Additionally, the Cyclones have accrued a 12.55 strikeouts-per-9-innings ratio, which is the best at High-A and 5th-best in MiLB...Chicago-NL's Triple-A low (14.06) holds the best mark in the minors...For the season, Brooklyn's bullpen has posted a .152 batting average against, which is the 2nd-lowest mark in MiLB...Cleveland's Triple-A Columbus (.152) is 1st...The Cyclones also maintain an impressive 34.49% strikeout rate.

**REIM TIME:** INF **Jacob Reimer** remains scorching hot to start the 2025 season...Reimer registered 5-straight multi-hit games from last Sunday vs. Hudson Valley until Friday at Aberdeen, earning

vs. JERSEY SHORE: Brooklyn continues their 2-week road trip with 6 games against the BlueClaws...Jersey Shore enters the series after dropping 4-of-6 on the road against Greensboro...In 2024, Brooklyn went 10-17 against the BlueClaws and 6-6 at ShoreTown Ballpark...Jersey Shore boasts 11 of the Orioles' Top 30 prospects: INF Devin Saltiban (9), INF Bryan Rincón (14), INF Carson DeMartini (15), OF John Spikerman (16), LHP Mavis Graves (17), RHP Alex McFarlane (18), RHP Micah Ottenbreit (28), and OF Dylan Campbell (30)...Spikerman is currently on the injured list...In 114 all-time meetings since 2021, the Cyclones lead the all-time series, 59-55 (.518).

New York Mets Minor League Player of the Week on Monday...The 21-year-old was also named to Mil.B.com's "Prospect Team of the Week" after hitting .421 (8-19) with 5 runs scored, 2 doubles, 2 triples, 2 home runs, and 4 RBI in 5 games...Reimer recorded more RBI (8) in the first 2 games of 2025 than he had in 25 outings (7) in an injury-plagued 2024...Reimer is tied for 6th in all of Minor League Baseball in triples (3)...He leads the South Atlantic League in triples (3)...Reimer is also tied for league lead in doubles (7) and extra-base hits (12), 4th in total bases (41), tied for 4th in RBI (16) and hits (22), 6th in OPS (.904), 7th in slugging percentage (.554), and tied for 9th in runs scored (13).

SUPER SUERO: C Chris Suero has been one of the best hitters in Minor League Baseball to start 2025...On April 17, he delivered the go-ahead 2-run double in the 9th, in a 7-3 comeback win at Aberdeen...Last Tuesday, the 21-year-old recorded the 2nd multi-home run game of his career in an 8-7 victory...Suero powered a 2-run blast in the 2nd and added another 2-run shot in the 3rd...The Bronx native homered in 3-straight at-bats dating back to his solo shot in the 6th inning on Sunday, Suero leads the South Atlantic League in slugging percentage (.654), is tied for 2nd in home runs (5), 3rd in OPS (1.035), tied for 3rd in extra-base hits (11) and doubles (6), tied for 4th in RBI (16), and tied for 7th in total bases (34)...Suero was recognized on MiLBs "Prospect Team of the Week" on Monday after going 10-for-29 (.345) with 5 doubles, 3 home runs, and 9 RBI over his first 8 games.

HALL OF A START: After an injury-shortened 2024, RHP Noah Hall has returned to form in 2025... Despite taking the loss on Tuesday, over his first 4 starts, the Charlotte, N.C. native is 1-2 with a 1.45 ERA (3 ER in 18.2 IP), 22 strikeouts and only 13 hits allowed...Entering Sunday, Hall is 8th in the South Atlantic League in ERA (1.45)...His 54.5% ground ball rate is also good for 3rd-best in the circuit... The University of South Carolina product became not only the 1st player in franchise history to start on consecutive Opening Days, but the 1st player in franchise history to start multiple Opening Days

REMEMBER ME?: Jersey Shore and Brooklyn each have players who participate in contests for the other team in 2024...OF Troy Schreffler Jr. spent parts of the 2023 and the entire 2024 season with the BlueClaws...In 101 games for Jersey Shore over 2 seasons, the Harrisburg, Pa. native hit 2211,310/3721.682 with 8 home runs, 45 RBI, and 32 stolen bases...Schreffler Jr. is currently on the Cyclones' Development List...RHP Josh Hejka was a member of Brooklyn in 4 different campaigns (2019; 2021-22; 2024)...The 28-year-old holds the record for most pitching appearances (63) in Cyclones history...In those contests, Hejka went 6-3 with a 2.41 ERA (28 ER in 104.2 IP). 8 saves, 25 walks, and 95 strikeouts...In his first outing against Brooklyn on Thursday, he allowed 1 run on 2 hits in an inning of work...Both Schreffler Jr. and Hejka were acquired by the New York Mets and Philladelphia Phillies, respectively, via trade during Spring Training.

YOU'LL GET NOTHING AND LIKE IT: Despite the loss last Wednesday, Cyclones' pitching dominated...After 4-straight runners reached base in the bottom of the 1st, Brooklyn pitching combined to retire 23 of the final 24 batters in order, allowing just one infield hit in the 3rd inning...14 of those 24 outs were recorded via strikeouts...RHP Noah Hall sat down 14 of the last 15 batters he faced, striking out 7 over 5.0 innings in the 2-1 defeat...The 23-year-old created a team-high 11 swings-and-misses...LHP Ryan Ammons, RHP Ryan Lambert, and RHP Alfred Vega united to sit down the last 9 hitters of the game in a row, 7 of which struck out...Lambert whiffed 4 of the 5 batters he faced, inducing 8 whiffs.

YOU GET A HIT, YOU GET A HIT. YOU GET A HIT...YOU GET THE POINT: In a lopsided victory over Wilmington on April 5, Brooklyn put up some gaudy numbers that haven't been seen on the boardwalk in quite some time...The 15 runs scored are the most scored in a single game by the Cyclones since Brooklyn scored 18 times in an 18-1 victory at Jersey Shore on August 28, 2022... The Cyclones' offensive output was their best at Maimonides Park since June 24, 2010, vs. Hudson Yalley, in a 16-5 wim... Additionally. Brooklyn's 20 hits collected on Saturday were the most hits the 'Clones in any game since a 20-hit effort in a 13-0 triumph vs. Aberdeen on July 21, 2011...The contest was just the second game since 2005 where Brooklyn accumulated 15+ runs and 20+ hits in the same contest...The Cyclones first accomplished the feat with 16 runs and 22 hits in a 16-7 win at Tri-City on July 13, 2007.

BROOKLYN TO THE BIGS: After 4 former Cyclones made their Major League debuts in 2024, 3 alumni had already accomplished the feat before the end of March in 2025...C Hayden Senger (18, '21) came off the bench and became the 103rd former Cyclone to play in the Majors and the 68th to debut with the New York Mets on Opening Day, March 27 at Houston...Three days later, on March 30, OF Jake Mangum (19, '21) batted second and played right field for the Tampa Bay Rays and went 0-for-3 with a walk...RHP Mike Vasil debuted for the Chicago White Sox a day later, tossing 2.0 innings of two-hit shutout relief, whiffing 18 Ty France for his first Major League strikeout...The franchise record for debuts in a single season is nine in 2015 and 2017.

AMAZIN' STARTS HERE: Brooklyn's roster features no shortage of talent...According to MLB Pipeline, the Cyclones boast 8 of the Mets' Top 30 prospects...Those include OF Carson Benge (3), INF Jesús Báez (8), LHP Jonathan Santucci (13), INF Boston Baro (14), INF Jacob Reimer (21), C Chris Suero (22), OF Eli Serrano III (23) and C Ronald Hernández (27)...Of those 8, 5 have previous experience playing in Brooklyn...The Cyclones also possess 6 of the Mets' Top 30 farmhands per Baseball America...The list features Báez (3), Benge (7), Baro (15), Santucci (16), Suero (20), and Reimer (21).

REPERTOIRE: 4-Seam Fastball, Slider, Curveball, Changeup

LAST TIME OUT: Took his second loss of the season on Sunday in Aberdeen...Surrendered 4 runs on 7 hits over 3.0+ innings of work...Walked 2 batters and struck out 3...Did allow a pair of solo home runs to 2B Griff O'Ferrall and DH Jake Cunningham in the 1st and 2nd, respectively....The 7 hits and 4 runs allowed were both high watermarks on the season for the southpaw...Was relieved by RHP Brian Metoyer, who made his first appearance in 1,085 days....The Brooklyn bullpen combined for 5.0 innings of 1-run ball, but the offense mustered only 2 hits from SS Jesús Báez, including a home run, in a 5-2 Cyclones defeat...2021 American League All-Star RHP Kyle Gibson threw 5.0 innings of 2-run, 1-hit ball to earn the win for Aberdeen.

**PROSPECT RADAR:** Entering the 2025 season, Santucci was ranked as the New York Mets' No. 13 prospect by MLB Pipeline and No. 16 by *Baseball America*... Deemed to have the "Best Secondary Pitch" in the Mets' 2024 draft class by *Baseball America* for his slider.

**SPRING BREAKOUT:** Santucci was a member of the Mets' 2025 Spring Breakout roster...While still awaiting his official professional debut, the southpaw entered in relief of RHP **Jonathan Pintaro** in the bottom of the 5th inning...Santucci tossed a scoreless inning of work, facing one over the minimum, allowing one hit and one walk, and inducing a double play.

**DEVILISHLY GOOD:** Santucci spent his three-year collegiate career at Duke University...As a junior in 2024, the 22-year-old compiled a 6-1 record with a 3.41 ERA (22 ER in 58.0 IP), 36 walks, and 90 strikeouts in 13 starts for the Blue Devils...Santucci was named to the All-ACC First Team and recognized on the Golden Spikes Award mid-season watch list...Missed three weeks during the 2024 season with a rib injury...Punched out a career-high 14 batters against Akron on 3/1...Was the second of back-to-back 10+ strikeout performances, whiffing 11 against Northwestern on 2/23...Limited to only 7 starts as a sophomore due to elbow surgery to remove bone chips...During his career at Duke, Santucci accrued a 10-6 mark with a 3.86 ERA (55 ER in 128.1 IP), 72 walks, and 198 strikeouts in 40 appearances (27 starts).

**DUAL THREAT:** During his high school career, Santucci was a two-way player at Phillips Academy (Andover, Mass.)...The left-hander registered a .322 batting average in high school, adding six doubles, two triples, three home runs, and 29 RBI...Santucci also received opportunities at the plate during his time at Duke...At the plate in college, the Leominster, Mass. native posted a .217 average (5-23) with two doubles, a home run, and 5 RBI in 24 plate appearances...Santucci played four games in the outfield at Duke, with three in right field and one in center field.

**FAMILY TIES:** Jonathan is not the only athlete in the Santucci family...Dad, **Steven**, played baseball at Assumption University (Worcester, Mass.) from 1991-93...Cousin, **Nick**, also played collegiate baseball at Rollins College (Winter Park, Fla.).
