### TODAY'S GAME

The Round Rock Express and Salt Lake Bees (Los Angeles Angels affiliate) are set for the final meeting of their six-game series on Sunday afternoon at Dell Diamond. Round Rock grabbed a 3-2 series lead with a 7-4 win on Saturday night. In the first inning, Express CF Cam Cauley scored on a 1B Blaine Crim groundout and RHP Alek Manoah balked in a run for a 2-0 Round Rock advantage. Crim belted a two-run homer in the third, doubling the Express lead. In the fifth, Bees 2B Yolmer Sánchez grounded into a forceout, plating a run and C Austin Wynns followed with an RBI single, cutting the Salt Lake deficit to two. 3B Cody Freeman hit a home run in the bottom of the fifth. The two-run shot brought the score to 6-2. In the seventh, Wynns recorded a two-run homer. Freeman added an RBI ground-rule double in the bottom of the seventh to make it 7-4, which stood final.

### CRIM DAWG

INF Blaine Crim tallied his 7th, 8th and 9th RBI in his 4th game back with the Express on Saturday...slashing .375/.421/.938/1.359 in those 4 G...8 of 13 balls in play have been over 95 mph EV (avg. 98.5 mph)...is 4th in the PCL with 44 RBI (35 with ABQ) and T-9th in home runs (9) this season...5th in Express history with 62 home runs, 2 shy of 4th place INF Mark Saccomanno (64)...3rd in Round Rock history with 256 RBI.

### FLAME-THROWING TEODO

Round Rock RHP Emiliano Teodo threw 0.2 IP in the 9th inning on Saturday...posted his 6th consecutive scoreless outing (6.1 IP)...in his 1st 12 G (13.1 IP) this season, owned a 7.43 ERA with 21 SO and 14 BB...in his last 10 G (11.2 IP), owns a 1.54 ERA with 15 SO and 5 BB...leads all Pacific Coast League pitchers (min. 100 PA) with a 36.4% whiff rate...ranks 2nd among PCL relievers with 36 strikeouts (1st, LHP S. Natera Jr., 39).

### C-FREE FLYING

INF Cody Freeman recorded his 1st home run of the season with a 2-run shot in the 5th inning of Saturday's win...also tallied an RBI double in the 7th...has 5 hits in last 10 plate appearances...slashing .313/.421/.563/.984 in 4 G with Round Rock.

### GO, DIEGO, GO

INF Diego Castillo has recorded an RBI in 6 straight games, totaling 11...tied for the longest-active streak in Triple-A, dating back to 5/23...leads all Triple-A batters with 14 hits in that span...also has a hit in each of his past 6...33 hits since joining the Express on May 1 are T-6th in Triple-A.

### THIS DAY IN NOLAN RYAN HISTORY - SUNDAY, JUNE 1, 1975

28-year-old Nolan Ryan tossed the fourth no-hitter of his career as the California Angels beat the Baltimore Orioles, 1-0, at Anaheim Stadium. Ryan walked four and struck out nine along the way while collecting the 100th victory of his major league career. The lone run for the Angels came in the third inning when Dave Chalk singled home Mickey Rivers. With the no-hitter, Ryan tied Sandy Koufax for the most in baseball history. "I wanted to do this at home," Ryan told reporters postgame. "That's what it's all about, fan appreciation." The closest call in the game came when Tommy Davis entered as a pinch-hitter in the seventh inning. Second baseman Jerry Remy got to a high chopper behind second base and threw Davis out on a close play at first as the Orioles' bench began barking about the call. As the no-hitter started to become more of a reality, Ryan's teammates began feeling the nerves of the moment. "I was shaking more than he was," Remy said after the game. Bill Smith had a similar sentiment: "I was trembling. Every time somebody made an out I got a chill up my spine." Remy and Smith, 21- and 22-year-old rookies, were the middle infielders that day. Before the game began, Ryan handed catcher Ellie Rodriguez a marble-sized ball and said, "This is what I'm going to throw today." It was Rodriguez's first outing after spending almost a month on the disabled list. 38-year-old Brooks Robinson went 0-for-3 in the game. Bobby Grich finished 0-for-2 with two walks and struck out to end the game. Grich and Ryan became teammates two years later and spent three seasons together with the Angels.

- Opened 2026 on the Injured List with thoracic outlet syndrome... finished 2025 making his Triple-A debut appearing in three starts before making his MLB debut in Rangers regular season finale on September 28 at Cleveland (1.2 IP, 3 H, 4 R, 3 ER, BB, K)
- Did not see official action in 2024 after undergoing 'Tommy John' ligament replacement surgery in June 2024. Returned to the mound on July 3, 2025 in the Arizona Complex League before appearing in 6 starts with Double-A Frisco before his promotion to Round Rock.... It was the first time he had seen official game action since March 9, 2024 during Cactus League play.
- Owned a 3.65 ERA (5 ER/12.1 IP) in three starts for Round Rock to end 2025.... Went a combined 9.1 IP in final two starts and allowed just 1 ER.
- In 2023, set career highs in wins, innings, strikeouts and games as he claimed the Nolan Ryan Pitcher of the Year award at season's end... paced all Texas minor leaguers (min. 100.0 IP) in strikeouts per 9.0 (10.53), while also ranking highly among organization pitchers in strikeouts (2nd) and wins (T-3rd).
- Originally acquired by Texas from the Seattle Mariners, along with a player to be named later (SS Andres Mesa), in exchange for RHP Rafael Montero on December 15, 2020. Corniell was traded before he ever threw a pitch in the Mariners organization.
- Originally signed by Seattle as an international free agent out of Santo Domingo, Dominican Republic on July 2, 2019. His signing bonus was the fifth-largest of the 2019-2020 international free agent class (\$630,000).
