LAST TIME OUT

The Baysox fell in 12 innings on Thursday night in a 10-8 loss to Altoona. Bowie held a 5-1 lead through five innings and a 5-4 lead through seven innings but Altoona scored six of its 10 runs in the final five innings to defeat Bowie for a second night in a row. A three-run 12th broke it open for the visitors, highlighted by Kervin Pichardo's 4-for-5, 3 RBI night, including the go-ahead RBI infield single in the 12th. With the loss, Bowie is officially eliminated from first half playoff contention.

BASALLO BITS

C/1B **Samuel Basallo** has reached base safely in 23 of his last 25 games dating back to May 21. His 19-game on-base streak from May 21 to June 12 is the longest Baysox on-base streak this season and is tied for the fifth-longest in the Eastern League. Since May 21, the 19-year-old is slashing .323/.387/.939 with five homers and 17 RBI. He is currently tied for the fourth-most hits (67) in the Eastern League and the ninth-most in all of Double-A.

RHODES IS ROLLING

In the month of June, OF/1B **John Rhodes** is batting a team-high .354 with a team-leading 15 RBI after going 2-for-4 with a two RBI last night, including the game-tying hit in the 10th to send the game to the 11th. The Orioles No. 23 prospect has 11 hits and nine RBI over his last five games.

WELCOME MR. ETZEL

OF/1B **Matthew Etzel** has made quite a first impression since being promoted from High-A Aberdeen on June 11. Etzel has collected a hit in seven of eight games played for the Baysox thus far and has five stolen bases. His 36 steals on the season between High-A Aberdeen and Double-A Bowie is third most in all of MiLB. He is the first Orioles '23 draft pick to be promoted to Double-A after being selected in the 10th round out of Southern Miss.

THE FANTASTIC FABIAN

OF **Jud Fabian** is second among active Eastern League players in home runs (12). Fabian hit a league-high six homers in the month of May and has four thus far in June - including three last week in Harrisburg. Last night, Fabian reached base five times and drove in four RBI, his seventh career 4+ RBI game. He's hitting .249 through 56 games after hitting just .176 in 64 AA games last season.

SETH IS SHOVIN'

RHP **Seth Johnson** has been on a roll for the Baysox in his last handful of starts. The O's No. 10 prospect has allowed just three earned runs across his last six starts (24.2 IP), good for a 1.09 ERA during that span (2nd in EL amongst starters). In his last two home starts against Binghamton, Johnson did not allow a run over 7.2 innings pitched, including a season-high eight strikeouts on June 4. Johnson last faced Altoona on April 17 and spun four shutout innings with three strikeouts in a no decision in his 2024 home debut.

ASSESSING ALTOONA

Entering this week, the Altoona Curve sit in last place in the Southwest Division at 24-39 on the season. However, the Double-A affiliate of the Pittsburgh Pirates has won their last four in a row and eight of their last 10, including back-to-back series victories over Richmond and Erie. Altoona's roster includes six of the Pirates' top 30 prospects (per MLB Pipeline) - RHP Bubba Chandler (No. 3), LHP Anthony Solometo (No. 4), RHP Thomas Harrington (No. 5), SS Tsung-Che Cheng (No. 8), OF Jase Bowen (No. 19), OF Tres Gonzalez (No. 26)

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

RHP Bubba Chandler takes the hill for the 13th time this year for Altoona. The Pirates No. 3 overall prospect most recently struck out a season-high seven but gave up five runs on six hits over 3.2 innings against Erie last Saturday in a no decision. Chandler faced the Baysox back on April 18 and struck out five over five innings and gave up just two runs on six hits over two walks to pick up the win. A former two-way standout from North Oconee HS (GA), Chandler has become a pitcher only since turning pro. He is the second best pitching prospect in the Pirates system behind Paul Skenes.

 Enters season fully healthy for first time since '22 after rehabbing from TJ surgery in '23
 Traded from TB to BAL on 8/1/22 in three-team deal that sent Trey Mancini to HOU
 Arsenal: Fastball (94-96), Curveball (75-79), Slider (Mid-High 80s), Changeup (86-89)

2024: Threw 4.0 IP and allowed 1 R on 2 H across 5 K and 3 BB in a no decision in most recent start on Sat. 6/15 @ HBG. Has allowed just 3 ER over last six starts spanning 24.2 IP (1.09 ERA). Still looking for first Double-A win. Baysox are 6-6 when he starts but have won four of last six. Owns a 1.96 ERA in six home starts. On Tue. 6/4 vs BNG, struck out season-high 8 batters over 4.0 scoreless innings. First game with 8+ K since 5/20/22 with High-A Bowling Green. Finished month of May with a 2.79 ERA in five starts after recording a 4.38 ERA in four April starts. On the BAL 40-man roster. Named to 40-man back in Nov. '22. Named to Bowie Opening Day roster.

2023: Placed on 60-day injured list to begin season by Triple-A Norfolk. Sent on rehab assignment to FCL Orioles on August 19. Made one start before being sent to Single-A Delmarva on August 22. Made one start with Shorebirds, then assigned to High-A Aberdeen on August 29. Made two starts with IronBirds. Struck out five in three shutout innings on Sept. 6 vs Greenville. Assigned to Double-A Bowie on Sept. 13. Struck out four in three innings, allowing two runs (one earned) on three hits and two walks in lone start of season against Harrisburg.

2022: Started season in High-A Bowling Green. Made seven starts and struck out 41 batters over 27 innings to an ERA of 3.00. Placed on injured list in late May with right forearm inflammation before discovering that he suffered a torn UCL and needed Tommy John surgery. Traded from TB to BAL in a three team deal on August 1 that sent Trey Mancini to Houston - just days before his operation in Texas.

2021: Entered first full season in minors with Single-A Charleston. Made 23 appearances (16 starts), pitched 93.2 innings and struck out 115 batters, good for fourth in the TB system. Posted an ERA of just 2.88 and allowed 33 walks.

2019: Debuted professionally with TB rookie ball affiliates in Princeton and GCL Rays.

College/Personal: Drafted by the Rays out of Campbell with the 40th overall selection in the 2019 Draft. At the time, was the highest-drafted player in Campbell history. A former two-way player at Louisburg (N.C.) junior college as a shortstop before committing to pitching full time at Campbell. Was his first time pitching since age 12. Convinced his junior college coaches to let him pitch in games after clocking 92 mph on a teammate's Pocket Radar during an off day.

During select games during the 2024 season, the Baysox will take the field as the Cangrejos Fantasmas De Chesapeake, as the Baysox look to continue to embrace the culture of local U.S. Hispanic communities.

Boasting a desire to better represent the Chesapeake Bay area, Bowie's "Cangrejos Fantasmas de Chesapeake" identity came to light after research presented the existence of the small, yet active Atlantic Ghost Crab species in the bay.



CHESAPEAKE BAYSOX

On Sunday, May 26, the Bowie Baysox will take the field as the "Chesapeake Baysox." This alternate identity was created to celebrate and learn about the conservation of the nearby Chesapeake Bay. The uniform tops are detailed with stenciled outlines of local wildlife, design, and architecture around the Chesapeake Bay.

In addition to activities around Prince George's Stadium promoting the conservation of the Chesapeake Bay, the jerseys will be auctioned off following the May 26 contest, with proceeds benefitting the Chesapeake Bay Foundation.



BOWIE PIT BEEF

The "Bowie Pit Beef" is an alternate identity of the Bowie Baysox that pays tribute to the culinary culture of Maryland. The Baysox will take the field as the Bowie Pit Beef on both June 23 and August 4.

Pit Beef consists of top round cuts of beef, thinly sliced and prepared over a charcoal fire. The meat is cooked quickly at high temperatures and has a slight smoked flavor. The sandwich got its name on Baltimore's east side in the 1970s, before being popularized by the 1980s.



COACHING STAFF

ROBERTO MERCADO

Manager

The 17th manager in Baysox franchise history, Mercado spent each of the past two seasons as the manager of the High-A Aberdeen IronBirds. He was honored with the Orioles organization's Cal Ripken, Sr. Player Development Award following his first season with Aberdeen in 2022. Prior to the start of his professional career, Mercado spent 17 years on the coaching staff at New Britain High School in Connecticut. He began as an assistant coach in 2004 before being promoted to head varsity coach in 2011. In addition to coaching the New Britain baseball team, Mercado served as the Dean of Students for over 18 years. He also spent time as an assistant coach of the Yarmouth Dennis Red Sox in the Cape Cod Baseball League from 2014-2022 and was a coach in the Goodwill Series, where high school baseball players from the United States competed overseas in both Australia and New Zealand in 2017 and 2018.

AUSTIN MEINE

Pitching Coach

Meine joins Mercado in the move from High-A Aberdeen. Meine served as the IronBirds pitching coach in 2023, where he helped Aberdeen post the third-lowest ERA (3.81) and second-most strikeouts (1,363) across the South Atlantic League. He previously spent two seasons on staff at the University of North Carolina at Charlotte, where he guided the 49ers to the two highest single-season strikeout totals in program history. Meine has also worked on staff at the Premier Pitching and Performance facility in Missouri. He pitched collegiately at Lindenwood University.

JOSH BUNSELMEYER

Hitting Coach

Bunselmeyer served as the hitting coach for the Orioles' Single-A affiliate, the Delmarva Shorebirds, last season. 2024 is Bunselmeyer's fifth season in the Orioles' system after also spending the previous three campaigns as a hitting coach in both the Florida Complex League and Dominican Summer League. He played three seasons in the Independent Frontier League following a collegiate playing career at Saint Louis University.

CHASE SEBBY

Fundamentals Coach

Sebbly joins the Baysox staff as the Fundamentals Coach in 2024. Sebbly was the fundamentals coach in Aberdeen last season and was a development coach within the Orioles' organization in 2022. Sebbly played collegiately as a catcher at Cypress College and Ball State.

Development Coach

A familiar face in Bowie, Facticeau rejoins the Baysox staff in 2024. Facticeau was the development coach in Aberdeen last season, but began his professional coaching career as a development coach on the Baysox staff in 2022. Prior to his first stint with Bowie, Facticeau first served in the Orioles' organization as a technology intern.
