NEWS & NOTES

HERE COME THE HOT RODS: The Hudson Valley Renegades and Bowling Green Hot Rods battle for the first time in franchise history this weekend. The Hot Rods were members of the South Atlantic League in 2009 before joining the Low-A Midwest League in 2010 and were members of that league until 2020. After this series, the Asheville Tourists will be the lone club in the SAL that the Renegades will have never faced.

WELCOME BACK, RAYS: The Bowling Green Hot Rods come to Heritage Financial Park, marking the first time ever that a Tampa Bay Rays has played as the visiting team at the facility. From 1996-2020, the Renegades were the New York-Penn League affiliate of the Rays, winning three NYPL Championships (99, 12, 17) and compiling a 927-876 (.514) overall record. Notable Renegades players from the Rays affiliation include 2010 AL MVP Josh Hamilton, 2008 AL Rookie of the Year Evan Longoria and 2011 AL Rookie of the Year Jeremy Hellickson.

LAST TIME OUT: In the first ever matchup, the Hudson Valley Renegades fell 7-4 to the Bowling Green Hot Rods on Friday night. Bowling Green scored four runs in the second, three in the third to take a 7-0 lead. Only four of the seven runs allowed by **Zach Messinger** were earned runs. **Agustin Ramirez** drove in a pair of runs on separate RBI doubles in the third and fifth innings. **Grant Richardson** clubbed a two-run home run in the sixth to cut the deficit to 7-4 before the game went into a rain delay in the top half of the seventh inning.

INTO THE TOP 100: *Baseball America* released its in-season Top 100 Prospects list update on Friday, and the Yankees claimed six players on the list. 2023 Renegades **Chase Hampton** (#60) and **Spencer Jones** (#98) entered the list for the first time. They were joined by former Renegades **Oswald Peraza** (#56), **Jasson Dominguez** (#71), **Austin Wells** (#86) and **Everson Pereira** (#96).

SUNDAY'S BEST: **RHP Drew Thorpe** has been the Renegades' Sunday starter for most of the season. The former 2nd round pick currently ranks first in wins (8) & IP (84.1), second in strikeouts (101) & ERA (2.13), third in WHIP (1.06), and sixth in AVG (.206) in the South Atlantic League. Among Yankees' Minor Leaguers, Thorpe leads all qualified pitchers in ERA and wins, while only trailing Chase Hampton (SOM-AA) in strikeouts.

PAVING THE WAY: Since June 1st, the Hudson Valley Renegades pitching staff leads all of MiLB with 2.40 ERA in this span. Hudson Valley pitching has also punched out 398 batters in 303.1 innings, the top of the list as well.

NEW KID ON THE BLOCK: Since his promotion from Single-A Tampa on June 29th, **Agustin Ramirez** is 14-for-38 (.368) with five doubles,

two home runs, seven RBIs, two walks, and six runs in nine games. He recorded a hit and reached base safely in his first six games before being held hitless on Thursday night by Jersey Shore.

STARTERS AIN'T TOO SHABBY: Since May 31st against Aberdeen, the rotation for Hudson Valley has seen some outstanding pitching. In this span, Renegades starters own a 2.04 ERA (185.2 IP, 107 H, 54 R, 42 ER, 86 BB, 233 K), the best in Minor League Baseball in that span. The rotation leads also leads MiLB in strikeouts (229) and WHIP (1.04), while the 185.2 innings are good for third place.

CLOSE BUT NO CIGAR: The Renegades have played in 23 one-run games this season and they own a 10-13 record (.434) in those contests. In June, nine of the 13 Renegades' losses were decided by two runs or less.

WALK THIS WAY: **Spencer Jones** became the ninth Renegade this season to work three or more walks in a single game on Friday night against Bowling Green. He's the first player to accomplish this feat since Ben Cowles on May 17 vs Brooklyn. Since the second half began on June 20th, Jones is tied for the team lead with 11 walks in 65 plate appearances.

NEW HIT KING: With a pair of hits last Friday against Jersey Shore, **Eduardo Torrealba** became the all-time Renegades hit leader, passing Angel Perez. Torrealba also appeared in his 151st contest as a Renegade on July 2nd against Wilmington, passing Matt Spring for the most in franchise history.

THE K-ZONE: The Hudson Valley Renegades pitching staff has been dominant all season long at getting swings-and-misses and they have been rewarded for it. The 'Gades currently own the second-highest strikeout total in all of Minor League Baseball. The Chattanooga Lookouts (CIN-AA) have struck out 933 batters compared to 922 for Hudson Valley this year. The Renegades tied their season-high with 19 strikeouts against the Wilmington Blue Rocks on July 2nd. The mark also tied their franchise record, which they recorded earlier this season on April 23rd versus the Rome Braves.

SPONGEBOB SANCHEZ: In the second half of the season, Renegades **OF Aldenis Sanchez** has started to pick things up offensively. Since the second half began on June 20, Sanchez is hitting .313/.353/.438 with four doubles, one triple, eight RBIs, and three stolen bases. His nine-game hitting streak is the second-longest active streak in the South Atlantic League, only trailing Dylan Beavers (Aberdeen). Sanchez also reached base safely in 11 of the first 13 games in the second half.

CABRERA: Set a new career high with 5 RBIs on 6/6 @ Jersey Shore --> 2-for-4, R, 2 2B, 5 RBI, BB, 2 K.
CRISP: Was hitting .400/.625/.400 in three games (2-for-5) with Double-A Somerset to start the season.
COWLES: Both three-hit games this season have come against Jersey Shore on 6/6 and 7/6...Walk off RBI 1B on 6/16 vs ROM.
FAMILA: Promoted to Hudson Valley on 6/29...named FSL Player of the Week 6/19-6/25 and FSL Player of the Month in June.
FLORES: Carried a season-long 18-game on-base streak from June 9 - July 3, snapped in a rain shortened five-inning contest vs WIL.
GARCIA: After only playing in only two games (2 AB) from 5/3 - 6/3, appeared in 19 games in June and hit .233/.300/.329
GOMEZ: Hit .151/.200/.233 in May after batting .271/.358/.339 in April. Ranked second in High-A in the month of June with a .344 batting average.
HENSON: Back-to-back-to-back multi-hit games on 5/24, 5/25, and 5/26 at Wilmington -- 9-for-16, 2 2B, HR, 3 RBI
JONES: Season-long seven-game hitting streak from 6/10 - 6/18... hit .464/.531/.857 with two 2B, three HRs and 6 RBIs during this span.
RAMIREZ: Promoted to Hudson Valley from Tampa on 6/29, named a *Baseball America* prospect to watch beyond the Top 30 for the Yankees.
RICHARDSON: Batted .417/.517/.583 during seven-game hitting streak from May 18-27.
SANCHEZ: Finished 2nd on the team, 5th in the SAL in SB (32) last year...tied franchise record with two triples vs WIL (5/3).
TORREALBA: Has appeared in 155 games as a Hudson Valley Renegade, the most all-time appearances in franchise history.
VARGAS: For the 2018 international signing period, was ranked by MLB.com as the No. 8 prospect.

LAST TIME OUT: In the final game before the All-Star Break, Drew Thorpe took the mound for the Renegades at Jersey Shore and tossed 7.0 shutout innings, striking out seven and walking three while scattering three hits to pick up his eighth win of the season. In the process, Thorpe became the fifth pitcher in Renegades history to rack up 100 strikeouts in a single season, and continued an impressive run where he has allowed just one run in his last 44.0 innings.

THOU SHALL NOT PASS: Thorpe is in the midst of one of the most dominant runs among all pitchers in Minor League Baseball. **Since allowing a home run Wilmington's Trey Lipscomb in the third inning on May 28, Thorpe has allowed just one run in 44.0 innings, good for a 0.20 ERA.** Since the start of June, the right-hander has thrown scoreless starts in five of his six outings, and has a stellar 49:10 K:BB. From June 1 through the end of his last start on July 9, Thorpe leads MiLB in ERA (0.22) among pitchers who have thrown at least 22.0 innings.

YANKEES DIRECTOR OF PITCHING SAM BRIEND ON THORPE: "The first thing that sticks out in my mind about Thorpe is he's just a competitor. You always want those kinds of guys. New York is a really tough place to play so you want to draft and sign guys that have a makeup that says that this guy is going to be able to handle pitching there and Thorpe hands down has that. He's really impressive out there, nothing rattles him. And then on top of that the secondary pitches are great. The changeup was a weapon to both hands in college, he's a high raw spin guy, the slider is disgusting. He throws two kinds of sliders -- he does throw the sweeper one and he has the shorter, tighter one and he just has such command of the zone with those offspeed pitches. It makes it really tough when you've got three different shapes there that are all going in different directions and he can move them around in the zone. As a hitter you can't really sit on anything and it's been awesome to watch."

2023 HIGHLIGHTS:

- Began the season on the Renegades Break Camp Roster.
- Allowed a leadoff home run to Greensboro's Mike Jarvis on his first pro pitch on April 9, then struck out 4 of the next 5 batters.
- Struck out 10 batters in 4.2 innings on April 23 at Rome, becoming the first Renegades pitcher to strike out 10+ batters in a single game since T.J. Sikkema on July 16, 2022 against the Greenville Drive. HV tied a franchise record (for 9-inn. game) in that game by striking out 19 Rome batters.
- On June 4 vs Aberdeen threw 8.0 IP, 1 H, 0 R, 2 BB, 7 K, becoming the first **Renegades pitcher to throw 8.0 shutout innings in a start since Tyree Hayes threw a 9-inn. complete game shutout against the Lowell Spinners on Aug. 17, 2008.** He was only the third HV starter to complete 8.0 innings in a start in the Portal Era (2005-Present).
- Named South Atlantic League Pitcher of the Week for the week of May 29-June 4 after 8.0 shutout innings vs Aberdeen.
- Struck out 12 batters on June 11 at Jersey Shore, setting a new Renegades franchise record for most strikeouts in a game.
- **Threw a rain-shortened complete game shutout on July 3 vs Wilmington (5.0 IP), the first CG SH thrown by a Hudson Valley pitcher since Jason McEachern on Aug. 23, 2009 (G2) vs Staten Island.**
- Named South Atlantic League Pitcher of the Month for June after posting a 0.31 ERA (1 ER/28.2 IP) in four starts... Was the first Renegade to win a monthly award since Randy Vásquez won High-A East Pitcher of the Month in August 2021.
- Picked up his 100th strikeout of the season on July 9 at Jersey Shore, **becoming just the fifth pitcher in team history to strike out 100 batters in a single season (Joe Kennedy, 101, 1999; Mitch Spence, 118, 2021; Matt Sauer, 100 & Blas Castaño, 101, 2022).**

PERSONAL:

- Full name is Andrew Robert Thorpe.
- As a redshirt sophomore at Cal Poly in 2022, went 10-1 with a 2.32 ERA (104.2 IP, 65 H, 31 R/27 ER, 25 BB, 149 K, 5 HR) in 15 starts... His 149 strikeouts ranked second in the nation, trailing only Oregon State's Cooper Hjerpe (161 K), who was selected by St. Louis with the 22nd overall selection in 2022 First-Year Player Draft.
- Ranked third in the country in H/9.0IP (5.59), sixth in WHIP (0.86), 10th in wins (10), 13th in K/9.0 IP (12.81) and 17th in ERA... Was named to six All-America First Teams, including Collegiate Baseball, ABCA, Perfect Game, Baseball America, D1Baseball.com and the NCBWA, becoming the first six-time All-American in program history.
- Was named one of five finalists for National Pitcher of the Year, as well as a semifinalist for both the Dick Howser Trophy and Golden Spikes Award.
- Was also named the Big West Conference Pitcher of the Year, becoming the first pitcher in school history to earn the accolade.
