GAME INFORMATION

LAST TIME OUT: The Binghamton Rumble Ponies defeated the New Hampshire Fisher Cats, 3-1, on Opening Night on Friday at Delta Dental Stadium. **RHP Jack Wenninger** earned his first Double-A win with seven strikeouts over five scoreless innings in his Double-A debut. Relievers **Daniel Juarez**, **Trey McLoughlin**, and **TJ Shook** did not allow an earned run either & Shook earned his first save of the season, stranding the potential-tying runs on base in the 9th inning. **INF Nick Lorusso** drilled a two-run double in the 4th inning and **OF Alex Ramírez** hit an RBI double in the 6th inning. **INF Jett Williams** doubled for his first hit of the season. Binghamton recorded three stolen bases in the game (**INF Ryan Clifford**, **OF Omar De Los Santos**, & Ramírez).

RUMBLE PONIES ROSTER: The Rumble Ponies' 2025 Opening Day roster features four of the top six and seven of the New York Mets top 30 prospects (MLB Pipeline): **SS/CF Jett Williams** (#2 NYM, #56 OVR), **1B/OF Ryan Clifford** (#4 NYM), **RHP Nolan McLean** (#5 NYM), **RHP Jonah Tong** (#6 NYM), **OF Nick Morabito** (#18 NYM), **RHP Jonathan Pintaro** (#24 NYM), and **RHP Jack Wenninger** (#29 NYM). Binghamton has 20 players returning from last season, including Alex Ramírez who led the Eastern League with 40 stolen bases last year.

RUMBLE PONIES STAFF: Manager **Reid Brignac** returns for his fourth season as the helm of the Ponies. Brignac is now the second-longest tenured manager in Binghamton history, behind five-year manager Pedro Lopez (2012-16). Brignac oversaw Eastern League Pitcher of the Year Brandon Sproat's dominant stint in Double-A last year. In 2023, he led the Ponies to their first postseason series victory since 2014. Brignac is joined by **pitching coach Dan McKinney** (1st season), **hitting coach Nate Irving** (1st season), **assistant hitting coach Aaron Bray** (1st season), and **bench coach Mariano Duncan** (4th season). The support staff is head athletic trainer Vanessa Weisbach (3rd season), athletic training associate Meghan Haas, performance coach Trent McMaster, baseball analytics analyst Will Moscato, and baseball technology and video associate Jaron Richman.

2024 SEASON RECAP: Binghamton finished the 2024 season with an overall record of 69-67, including a 41-26 record on the road. Binghamton won 10-straight games from July 4-19, which marked the third-longest winning streak in franchise history and the longest since the team won 12-straight games in 2006. **RHP Brandon Sproat** was named the Eastern League Pitcher of the Year and the Mets Minor League Pitcher of the Year. **INF Wyatt Young** finished 2nd in EL with a .393 OBP and 5th with a .288 AVG. **INF Jeremiah Jackson** ranked 2nd in the EL with 19 HR.

2024 AWARDS: Mets No. 1 prospect **Brandon Sproat** was named the 2024 Eastern League Pitcher of the Year and the 2024 Mets Minor League Pitcher of the Year. Sproat is just the fifth Binghamton pitcher to win EL Pitcher of the Year, and the first since Corey Oswalt in 2017. Sproat made 11 starts for Binghamton and went 4-1 with a 2.45 ERA and 77 strikeouts to just 15 walks in 62.1 innings, while holding a 0.87 WHIP. The 2023 second-round pick began his first professional season with High-A Brooklyn and finished with Triple-A Syracuse in 2024. He also represented the Mets in the 2024 All-Star Futures Game, while he was a member of the Rumble Ponies. Mets No. 18 prospect **Nick Morabito** was named the 2024 Mets Minor League Player of the Year, after hitting .312 in 119 games across Class-A St. Lucie and High-A Brooklyn and recording 59 SB. Morabito starts the 2025 season with Double-A Binghamton, his first at the level.

2025 SEASON: Began the season with Double-A Binghamton.

LAST SEASON: Held a 3.00 ERA in final 12 starts of the season for Double-A Binghamton...Spun six scoreless frames and earned the win in his final start of the season on September 12 at Portland...Went 2-8 with a 4.19 ERA and an 80-to-32 strikeout-to-walk ratio in 81.2 innings across 18 starts for Double-A Binghamton, after being promoted on May 20...Played in 26 games as Binghamton's designated hitter and hit three home runs with eight runs batted in...Began the season with High-A Brooklyn and went 2-2 with a 2.57 ERA and 36 strikeouts in 28 innings across seven starts.

CAREER NOTES: Currently ranks as the Mets No. 5 overall prospect and No. 1 pitching prospect, per MLB Pipeline...Was originally a two-way prospect, but began to primarily focus on pitching in June 2024...Earned the win on the mound for the Mets in the 2024 Spring Breakout game at Spring Training against the Washington Nationals prospects (1 IP, 1 H, 0 R, 0 BB, 1 K, 10 pitches)...All-Big 12 Second Team (UT) selection and honorable mention (RP) in 2023 at Oklahoma State.

BACKGROUND: Drafted by the Mets in the third round (91st overall pick) of the 2023 MLB Draft out of Oklahoma State University...Originally drafted by the Baltimore Orioles in the third round of the 2022 MLB Draft, but did not sign and returned to Oklahoma State for one more season...Played for three seasons as a two-way player (3B/OF/RHP) at Oklahoma State and played quarterback on the Cowboys football team in 2020...Two-time All-Big 12 selection as a utility player and relief pitcher...Semifinalist for the John Olerud Two-Way Player of the Year Award in 2022...Originally from Willow Spring, North Carolina, and was a standout baseball player and quarterback at Garner High School...Threw for 6,809 yards and 72 touchdowns in his high school football career.

2025 SEASON: Began the season with Double-A Binghamton.
