**Tonight:** The Lugnuts play the opener in a six-game series against the Dayton Dragons stretching through Sunday, July 4, with LAFU Fireworks following the contests on July 2, July 3 and, naturally, Independence Day. Left-hander **David Leal** makes his third Lugnuts appearance and his second start, opposed by talented Dayton right-hander **Noah Davis**. Lansing is 3-3 against Dayton this year, splitting a six-game set at Day Air Ballpark in mid May.

**On Deck:** Tomorrow is a **Dog Days of Summer**, with dogs welcome to the ballpark!

**On the Air:** Today's game is on MiLB.TV and streaming online at <http://milb.streamguys1.com/lansing>, with **Jesse Goldberg-Strassler** and **Adam Jaksa** on the call.

**Sunday: Cedar Rapids 6, Lugnuts 0.** Spot-starter **Bryce Nightengale** departed due to injury seven pitches into the 1st inning, the Kernels welcomed new reliever **Brandon Withers** with a five-run rally (including a three-run inside-the-park home run by DeShawn Keirse, Jr.), and five Cedar Rapids pitchers held the Nuts to three hits to take four of six games from Lansing.

**What's New in 2021:** Entering this season, the Lugnuts' stadium name changed from Cooley Law School Stadium to Jackson® Field™, Lansing moved up to the High-A Central and the ball club accepted an invitation to affiliate with the Oakland A's, the Nuts' fourth MLB partner, following the Kansas City Royals (1996-98), Chicago Cubs (1999-2004) and Blue Jays (2005-2020).

### LUG•NOTES: HEADLINES AND POINTS OF INTEREST

**Meet the Boss:** **Scott Steinmann** is the 16th manager in Lugnuts team history. Born in Dayton, Steinmann joins the Lugnuts after three straight seasons assigned to manage Double-A Midland (though the 2020 season was canceled). Steinmann previously managed against the Lugnuts with Wisconsin (2005), Clinton (2009, 2014-15) and Beloit (2017). More info about the skipper can be found on the next page of these notes.

**Recent Roster Moves:** Today, pitcher **Stevie Emanuels** was placed on the Injured List retroactive to June 26 and the Lugnuts received a pair of right-handed pitchers in **Sam Romero**, who comes from Extended Spring Training and joins the bullpen, and **Jack Cushing**, who joins from Low-A Stockton and will start on Friday night.

**Alumni Report:** 2017 Lugnut **Vladimir Guerrero, Jr.**, leads the Majors in OBP (.443), OPS (1.127), total bases (185) and RBIs (66); is tied for 1st in home runs (26); and ranks 2nd in slugging percentage (.684) and runs scored (62), and 3rd in batting average (.342). Fellow 2017 Lugnut **Bo Bichette** leads the Majors in runs scored (64).

**Man of Steal:** Infielder **Max Schuemann** (Portage Northern H.S. / Eastern Michigan University) is tied for second in Minor League Baseball with 30 stolen bases, nine more than the Major League leader, Kansas City's Whit Merrifield. Schuemann is tied for second in the Minors with 13 HBPs and is third in the High-A Central with 38 runs scored.

**Hail to Arms:** The Lugnuts' pitching staff ranks second in the High-A Central with a 3.73 earned run average, trailing Cedar Rapids, which has lowered its team ERA to 3.61 by limiting the Nuts to five earned runs allowed in 52 innings. Lansing has issued the second fewest walks in the league (153) and has the second best GO/AO ratio in the league at 1.19, trailing Cedar Rapids' ratio of 1.34.

**In Search of Pop:** The Lugnuts had 29 base hits in the series at Cedar Rapids, but only two - **Max Schuemann's** leadoff home run Friday and **Drew Millas's** double Saturday night - went for extra bases.

**Gorilla Ball:** Of the 16 runs Cedar Rapids has scored in this series, 10 have been scored on five swings - a series-opening grand slam from Gabriel Maciel, two home runs from Trey Cabbage and one apiece from Seth Gray and Jair Camargo.

**Situational Spotlight:** Lansing went 0-for-4 with runners in scoring position on Sunday and went 3-for-51 in the six games at Cedar Rapids.

## TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

**2010:** Lugnuts starter Ryan Shopshire brought a 4-0 lead over Dayton to the 9th at Cooley Law School Stadium, looking for a CG. Two HBPs and a single loaded the bases with one out. Shopshire struck out Josh Garton... and then gave up a two-out game-tying grand slam to Cameron Satterwhite. In the bottom of the 11th, though, Mike Konstanty walked Chris Hopkins with the bases loaded to force in the winning run, giving the Lugnuts a 5-4 victory.

**2015:** TTim Locastro hit his second inside-the-park home run of the season, a solo shot down the third-base line in the third inning (aided by LF Ross Kivett slipping), and Shane Dawson struck out nine West Michigan Whitecaps in 7 2/3 innings in a 5-1 win on Saturday night.

**Major League Lugnuts:** Three former Nuts have made their Major League debuts this season, bringing the total to 157 all-time - pitcher **Ty Tice** '18, outfielder **Josh Palacios** '16-'17, and pitcher **Taylor Saucedo** '16-'17. Tice and Palacios made their first MLB appearance in the same game for the Toronto Blue Jays on April 9th. It was the seventh time in team history that two Lugnuts made their MLB debut in the same game, with the first occurring on September 14, 1998: **Carlos Febles** and **Carlos Beltrán** for the Kansas City Royals. Saucedo most recently debuted, tossing a scoreless inning for the Blue Jays on June 17.

**Record-Setting, for Better or Worse:** On June 15, **Max Schuemann** broke **Samad Taylor**'s franchise single-game record of four steals in a game (set July 1, 2018) with five stolen bases against the Great Lakes Loons. On June 20, **Stevie Emanuels** broke the franchise single game record, tied many times before, of three homers served up in a game, giving up four HRs to the Loons - two apiece by Deacon Liput and Andy Pages.

**So Many Starters:** The Lugnuts have used 13 different starting pitchers this season, namely **Brady Basso**, **Reid Birlingmair**, **Jeff Criswell**, **David Leal**, **Stevie Emanuels**, **Richard Guasch**, **Rafael Kelly**, **Bryce Nightengale**, **Colin Peluse**, **Leudeny Pineda**, **Seth Shuman**, **Shohei Tomioka** and **Brock Whittlesey**.

**Familiar Settings:** 10 of the 28 Lugnuts active players came through the Midwest League in Beloit on their way up the Athletics' ladder, and coaching staff members **Scott Steinmann**, **Don Schulze** and **Anthony Phillips** all have experience in the league.

**A Pleasant Peninsula Surrounds You:** **Max Schuemann** (Portage Northern H.S.) is the first Lugnut to hail from Eastern Michigan University in Ypsilanti. Earlier this season, the Nuts featured two Michigan Wolverines in **Jeff Criswell** (injured) and **Jack Weisenburger** (promoted).

**Finally:** Pitchers **Jeff Criswell**, **Stevie Emanuels** and **Shohei Tomioka**, catchers **Jared McDonald**, **Drew Millas** and **William Simoneit**, first baseman **Patrick McColl**, and outfielder **Michael Guldberg** have all made their pro debut this season with the Lugnuts.

**Front Office Connections:** Lugnuts pitching coach **Don Schulze** was drafted 11th overall by the Chicago Cubs in 1980, 12 picks before Oakland Executive Vice President of Baseball Operations **Billy Beane** was drafted by the New York Mets. Lugnuts first baseman **Patrick McColl** set a new Harvard baseball single season record with 70 hits in 2019, breaking the previous record held by Athletics General Manager David Forst.

**Clubhouse of Higher Learning:** The Ivy League is well represented on the Lansing roster. First baseman **Patrick McColl** played for Harvard, reliever **Michael Danielak** was drafted from Dartmouth and catcher **William Simoneit** spent four years at Cornell before grad-transferring to Wake Forest.

**Power Five Baseball:** The Lugnuts also represent the ACC (**Michael Guldberg**, Georgia Tech); Big 12 (**Brady Basso**, Oklahoma State); Big Ten (**Dalton Sawyer**, Minnesota); and the SEC (**Cobie Vance**, Alabama, and **Ryan Gridley**, Mississippi State); and the Pac-12 (**Stevie Emanuels**, Washington).

**International Appeal:** In addition to 17 different states (Arizona, California, Delaware, Florida, Georgia, Illinois, Louisiana, Maryland, Massachusetts, Michigan, Minnesota, Nevada, North Carolina, Ohio, Texas, Virginia, Washington) represented by Lugnuts players and coaching staff, seven nations are represented: USA, Colombia, Cuba, Dominican Republic, Japan, South Africa and Venezuela.

**Representing His Country:** 1B/3B **Jordan Diaz** played for Colombia in Olympic Baseball Qualifying play, blasting a game-tying home run in the 9th against Venezuela, but Colombia lost all three games in opening pool play and was eliminated. Team USA won the tournament, punching a ticket to Japan.

**Teammates Then, Teammates Now:** Several of the Nuts are more than a little familiar with one another. **Reid Birlingmair** and **Charlie Cerny** pitched together at the University of Illinois at Chicago. The Lugnuts also have a pair of Wake Forest Demon Deacons; though **William Simoneit** played only one year at Wake, 2020, thus missing **Colin Peluse** by a year, Peluse hosted Simoneit on his visit and convinced him to attend Wake. Coincidentally, Peluse was hosted on his own Wake Forest college visit by 2019 Lugnuts infielder **Johnny Aiello**.

**Last Outing:** Originally slated to start the series opener on June 22 at Cedar Rapids, but game was postponed due to rain... moved into piggybacking on opener Bryce Nightengale's start in Game 1 of June 23 doubleheader... held the Kernels to only one hit (Trey Cabbage double) and no walks in first four innings of relief... in bottom of the 7th inning with the game tied 0-0, allowed a second double to Cabbage, who moved to third on a Jair Camargo flyout to right... issued a pair of intentional walks to load the bases, then struck out Michael Helman for the second out... got in front of No. 9 batter Gabriel Maciel 1-and-2, but served up walk-off grand slam in 4-0 Lugnuts loss... struck out seven batters in 4 2/3 innings in defeat.

## 2021:

- Began the season with Stockton, appearing in relief on Opening Day, May 4 at Modesto, and tossing three scoreless innings.
- First three appearances with the Ports were all in relief, totaling 7 IP, 4 H, 2 R, 1 BB, 12 K.
- Received first start in series opener at Visalia, May 18: 4 IP, 4 H, 3 R (2 ER), 0 BB, 4 K.
- Worked six innings apiece in final two starts with Stockton, June 1 vs. Lake Elsinore (3 H, 0 R, 1 HBP, 0 BB, 5 K) and June 8 vs. San Jose (8 H, 3 R, 2 HR, 0 BB, 3 K).
- In all, walked just 1 batter of 106 total batters faced in the High-A West, spanning 26 2/3 innings
- Joined the Lugnuts on June 15 with relief ace Jack Weisenburger's promotion to Double-A Midland.
- Made Lugnuts debut on June 15, starting the series opener vs. Great Lakes... gave up a second-inning two-run double to Justin Yurchak but that was it: 4 1/3 IP, 7 H, 2 R, 1 BB, 5 K... removed after walking James Outman, yielding to Brady Basso with runners at 1st and 2nd and one out... Basso stranded the runners... Lugnuts went on to win, 9-7, with two runs in the bottom of the 7th.

**School Days:** Attended MacArthur High School, where he was named 2015 Pitcher of the Year... attended Wharton County Junior College (the Pioneers; Wharton, TX) in 2016-2017... as a freshman: 71 1/3 IP, 60 K, 18 BB, 5.17 ERA... as a sophomore: 76 1/3 IP, 75 K, 5.07 ERA... as a junior, transferred to Louisiana Tech and was named 2018 Second Team All-Louisiana honors and ABCA/Rawlings Second Team All-Region, leading Bulldogs in innings (87 1/3) and ranking second in Conference USA in WHIP (0.90), 14th in the nation... scheduled to be Tech's Saturday starter as a senior, but underwent foot surgery a week before the season was scheduled to start... finished as No. 2 in Division 1 among active players in lowest walks per nine innings (1.20)... posted career K/BB ratio of 135 K / 19 BB in 142 2/3 innings.

**Draft Day:** Taken 1154th overall in the 38th round, 2019, and signed for \$1,000... scout: Kelcey Mucker... after David was drafted by Oakland, Bulldogs head coach Lane Burroughs said, "He is the epitome of what hard work and dedication to one's craft looks like. This young man came into our program and changed his body, overcame a significant foot injury and absolutely attacked the game with a relentless work ethic. He found a way to get better every day, and is one of the best I've ever seen at commanding the baseball. He is what our program is all about. Tremendous character and makeup, great student, selfless and just a wonderful teammate. He is the ultimate competitor and undoubtedly will go down as one of the best to ever step foot on the mound for the Bulldogs."

**Pro Debut 2019:** Debut in A's system on June 27 in AZL... did not walk his first batter until 10th appearance, 20 innings in... promoted to Stockton for final appearance of the year, August 31 at San Jose... base stealers went just 2-for-4 in attempts against him... left-handed batters hit 3-for-44 (.068) with 0 walks and 19 K's... right-handers batted 22-for-102 (.216) with 4 walks and 32 K.
