#### FROM THE CROW'S NEST

LAST TIME OUT: The Marauders were unable to hold either of two one-run leads, falling 4-2 in the series opener... Bradenton has now lost six straight series openers... Aaron Shortridge (MiLB rehab) pitched three scoreless innings, striking out one... A **Rodolfo Nolasco** RBI-triple produced the game's first run in the bottom of the third before Clearwater tied the score with a Leandro Pineda RBI-double... **Jase Bowen** beat out an RBI-infield single in the fifth to put Bradenton back in the lead, 2-1, but Jack Hartman struggled on the mound in the eighth inning, allowing a game-tying solo homer to Jadiel Sanchez, and after a walk, gave up a go-ahead RBI-single to Arturo de Freitas... Valentin Linarez served in a bulk role out of the bullpen for the Marauders, striking out five over four innings and allowing just one run... Bowen's single in the fifth extended his on-base streak to 10 games, the team's longest active on-base streak

THE OPPONENT: The Threshers are coming off a series split with Dunedin... Their last series win came against Daytona, May 10-15 (since then: 2 series losses, 1 split)... Clearwater is in second place in the FSL West Division, 4.5 games ahead of the Marauders... The team's roster currently features two players in *Baseball America*'s latest top 30 prospect rankings for the Phillies organization: INF Hao Yu Lee (#19) and OF Jadiel Sanchez (#21).

RODOLFO, EL REY: Rodolfo Nolasco has posted a .400 on-base percentage in six June games, driving in seven runs. His 35 hits 24 RBI, and 7 doubles all rank second on the team... Defensively, he has committed just three errors in 79 chances and is tied for second on the team with two outfield assists.

MAKE IT CLEAR: The Marauders went 17-7 against Clearwater in 2021, winning all four series matchups... The West Division foes will meet just 15 times this season, and the current six-game series is the Threshers' only visit to LECOM Park

TROUBLED TIMES: The Marauders' current record at six games under .500 marks their season-low... The club has not won back-to-back games since May 21-22 at Palm Beach, and have not won three or more games consecutively since a three-game win streak April 26-28 vs Dunedin... Bradenton also owns the second-worst run differential in the league at -31

**TOP PIRATES PROSPECTS:** The Marauders roster currently includes two prospects in *Baseball America*'s Top 30 ranking for the Pirates organization: LHP Anthony Solometo (#11) and OF Rodolfo Nolasco (#28)... Baseball America lists the Pirates' farm system as the third-best in baseball.

FIELD STAFF: Manager Jonathan Johnston, 2021 Low-A Southeast Manager of the Year, is in his second season at the helm for the Marauders... Former major leaguer Yorman Bazardo is the club's new pitching coach after spending 2021 as a pitching coach for the FCL Pirates... Former Pirate Mendy López joins as hitting coach after serving as the Pirates' Latin American Field Coordinator in 2021... Casey Harms is the Marauders' Integrated Baseball Performance Coach after a collegiate coaching career in the Northwoods League (Waterloo Bucks, 2019-20) and at UC Santa Barbara (2013-2018)... Gustavo Omaña is the Marauders' Development Coach after serving on staff at Triple-A Indianapolis in 2021

HITTING TRIPLE DIGITS: The 2022 season marks the 100th year of operation for LECOM Park, known as City Park upon opening in 1923. It has served as a spring training home for six different MLB franchises, including the Pirates since 1969. Baseball hall-of-famers who once called the historic park their spring home include Hank Aaron, Roberto Clemente, Dizzy Dean, Rogers Hornsby, Reggie Jackson, and more.

2022: In season debut April 10 at Dunedin, pitched behind rehabbing RHP Luis Oviedo: two singles and a HBP led to a sac fly in the second inning; after a scoreless third, allowed a double, two-run homer, and another double, was lifted after a strikeout... April 17 vs Lakeland, allowed a walk in the first inning that led to two RBI-doubles, allowed a solo homer in the second, retired the next seven straight batters but was lifted after allowing another solo home run in the fourth... April 24 at Daytona, held Tortugas scoreless over first three innings (worked around four baserunners) before allowing an RBI-single in the fourth, exiting with two out and bases loaded (all runners stranded by Cristian Charle)... Has gone 5 IP in each of last 4 GS... May 22 at Palm Beach: allowed just two unearned runs (2 errors) and all 6 hits allowed were singles... Last Wednesday at Lakeland: fanned 7 in career-high 6 scoreless IP... Last 5 GS: 1.04 ERA, 0.96 WHIP, 5 BB, 26 K in 26 IP...


