WATER LOGGED Daylona's contest against Dunedin on Friday was delayed for 10 minutes at the start due to rain...It was also halted in the bottom of the eighth with one out and an 0-1 count on SS Braylin Minier due to rain and lightning...After another 30-minute break, the game was called...Friday's contest was the first impacted by weather for the Tortugas over 37 games in 2022....In 2021. Bytona had 18-of-120 games delayed by weather and 12-of-those-18 resulted in postponements or suspended games...During the 2019 campaign, the Tugas had 12 games delayed, 4 postponed, and 3 canceled due to Hurricane Dorian at the end of the season...The 36 games without a delay in Daytona's longest stretch to start a season since 2017 when the Tortugas' went 41-straight games to start the year without a halt in play or postponement.

PICK ME UP A 10-PIECE
The fortugas matched their strongest offensive performance of the year with 10 runs in a win over Dunedin on Thursday. Daytona also matched their highest run total in a single frame this season with seven runs against the Blue Jays' bullpen in the bottom of the eighth... The Tortugas posted 10 runs in May 3's 10-6 win over Juniter and again in a 10-0 victory against the Hammerheads on May 5... Daytona picked up season-high in hits (14) on May 3 and also matched a season-best with 3 home runs in that game... The 10 runs and 14 hits were the most for the franchise since they put up 12 and 14, respectively, at Jupiter on September 11 of last year...The 10 runs also registered 7 extra-base hits on May 3, their most since they collected 8 on May 12, 2021, vs. St. Lucie.

WALK THIS WAY
The Daytona Tortugas earned a season-high-tying 10 walks in Wednesday's 7-5 victory over Dunedin...The 10 free passes matched the high-water mark set against St. Lucie in a 9-2 win on April 10...Daytona was limited to just two hits in the win...1B Ruben barra launched a two-run ground-rule double to center in the first and SS Braylin Minier added a solo home run in the eighth...the two accumulated hits are tied for the lowest in a single game for the fortugas over the last two seasons...The pair of knocks are the lewest for the franchise in a victory since the rebrand to the Tortugas before the 2015 season...The previous low for hits in a win was three in a 2-0 win at the Charlotte Stone Crabs in the opener of a doubleheader on August 30, 2018...The victory was the franchise's first with two-or-fewer hits since the then-Daytona Cubs walked-off the Bradenton Marauders, 2-1, with just a pair of hits on August 2, 2010...PR Smally Borges scored the winning run on a wild pitch...Daytona's hits that night came on a bunt knock by C Mark Reed in the third and a single by 3B D.J. LeMahieu in the sixth.

TIME TO MAKE THE DONUTS

Tuesday's 2-0 shutour of Dunedin was Daytona's fourth of the season and third in May...RHP

Hunter Parks (5.0 IP, 4 H, 2 SD) posted a career-high 5.0 innings to start...RHP Luis Mey (2.0 IP,
3 SO) and RHP Ryan Cardona (2.0 IP, BB, 3 SD) entered in relief and completed the four-hit shutout...It was the Tortugas first blanking of the Blue Jays since a 5-0 win on April 22, 2019...LHP

Packy Naughton (6.0 IP). RHP Aneurys Zabala (2.0) and RHP Ryan Nutof (1.0) tossed a six-hitter that evening...RHPs Sam Benschoter (5.0 IP, 3 BB, 6 SD). José Franco (3.0 IP, 2 H, 2 BB,
50), and Ryan Cardona (1.0 IP, H) combined on a 5-0 three-filter of the Jupiter Hammerheads
on May 7...RHPs Hunter Parks (4.0 IP, 2 H, 2 BB, 4 SD). Luis Mey (1.0 IP, BB, 3 SD), Alex Johnson
(2.2 IP, 2 H, BB, 5 SD), and Brett Lockwood (1.1 IP, H, BB, 3 SD) united on a five-hit, 10-0 blanking

SS GUS Steiger, set a new career-best with four hits in May 10's 6-1 win over Clearwater...He also reached base five times...The 23-year-old has collected a hit in 20 of his last 24 games dating back to April 20...In that stretch, Steiger is slashing, 344,410/, 422 with an 832 OPS...He is 31-f0r-90 (.344) with 16 runs scored, 5 doubles, a triple, 8 RBI, 10 walks, and 10 steals in those 24 affairs...Since that date, the Spring Park, Minn, native leads the Florida State League in batting average (.344)...Steiger is also tied for second in hits (31), and tied for third in stolen bases (10)...He is also tied for eighth in runs scored (16)...Against teams with Pennsylvania-based parent affiliates (Bradenton and Clearwater), Steiger has posted a. 487 average (19-39) with 7 runs scored, 4 doubles, 3 RBI, 7 walks, and 8 steals in 11 games played.

JAY JAY JETTING ALONG
19-year-old OF Jay Allen II reached base five times and tied a career-high with three stolen bases in Wednesday's 8-4 loss to Clearwater...the Fort Pierce, Fla. native swiped three bags with the Arizona Complex League Reds on September 13, 2021, at the ACI Rangers...Allen is the first Tortuga to Steal three bages in a single game since LF Leo Seminati dul it in a 5-2 win over Fort Wyers on September 3, 2021...the outfielder is the first Daytona player to accomplish the feat in a visiting ballpark since CF Daniel Sweet on April 7, 2017, in a 5-4 defeat at Florida...Allen comes into Saturday on a season-high 12-game on-base streak since May 5...He has a .451 on-base percentage in that span...Allen is hird in the Florida State League in stolen bases (16), tied for fifth in walks (25), and is eighth in OBP (.418).

HOME COOKING

Through the first 37 games of the 2022 season, the Tortugas have had eye-popping offensive splits between games at Jackie Robinson Ballpark and opposing stadiums...In 19 home games, Daytona holds an impressive 12-7 record and have scored 4-or-more runs in 12 of those 19 contests (10-2)...On the road, the fortugas are, a meager 4-14 and have scored 4-plus tallies in just 6 of those games (2-4)...At The Jack, the 'Tugas have a team slashline of .231/, 340/, 350 with a .690 0PS, 45 extra-base hits, 102 runs scored (5, 37/game), and 137 hits (7.21/game)...In road ballparks, Daytona has slashed .186/, 280/.269, adding a .549 0PS, 27 extra-base hits, 58 runs scored (3, 22/game), and 110 hits (6.11/game)...Through the first 5-plus weeks of the season, home teams are 116-65 (.641) in Florida State League play.

RETURNING TO THE NEST
14 of the 30 active players on the Tortugas' Opening Day roster played at least one game with the franchise during the 2021 season...15 of the 32 players currently on the roster had previous experience with the club before 2022...Among the coaching staff, manager Gookie Dawkins returns for a second-straight season alongside hitting coach Darryl Brinkley...2019 bench coach Lenny Harris is back in Daytona after spending the 2021 season in the same role with Chattanooga.
