On Deck: Tomorrow is the first Capital City Market Kids Day of the season, with Kids Run the Bases and postgame free ice cream and music at Capital City Market, across Michigan Ave., with Big Lug. Then the Nuts head on the road for a six game series at Lake County next week.

Transaction: On Thursday, Lansing placed infielder **Joshwan Wright** on the 7-day Injured List; Wright had departed Tuesday's series opener following a bunt single.

EMU to The Show: 2021 Lansing super utilityman **Max Schuemann** made his Major League debut yesterday as a pinch-runner for the Oakland A's, scoring the game-winning run in the bottom of the 10th on an RBI single from **Lawrence Butler** (2021-22 Lugnut), as the A's walked off the Nationals, 2-1. Schuemann is the 185th all-time Lugnut to reach the Majors and the first this year.

A'round the A's System

- **Triple-A Las Vegas:** Former Fort Wayne TinCap **Esteury Ruiz** stayed hot with a 2-for-4 showing yesterday, knocking in two runs and raising his batting average to .361 in a 4-3 win over Salt Lake.

- **Double-A Midland:** Infielder **Brennan Milone** (2023 in Lansing) went 3-for-5 with two doubles and a home run, lifting his batting average to .400, and **Colby Thomas** (2023 Lugnut) went 2-for-4 with a stolen base, raising his batting average to .414, in a 7-6 loss to Amarillo. Shortstop **Jacob Wilson** (2023) doubled in his first at-bat, but was removed due to injury precaution; Wilson is hitting .435.

- **Single-A Stockton:** 2023 draftee **Will Johnston** tossed three perfect innings, striking out seven, in the Ports' 4-3 loss to Rancho Cucamonga. Johnston has now worked seven hitless innings this year and has struck out 15 of the 22 batters he has faced.

Walk This Way: The Lugnuts have drawn 37 walks in their first six games, leading the Midwest League. **Will Simpson** is tied for 1st with 10 walks, while **Brayan Buelvas** is tied or 4th with seven walks. Meanwhile, Lansing pitchers have walked only 21 batters, third fewest in the league.

Louisville Slugger: Outfielder **Cameron Masterman**, an undrafted free agent from the University of Louisville, is tied for 1st in the Midwest League in extra-base hits (5), tied for 1st in triples (1) and 2nd in doubles (4).

Prospecting: The Nuts' Opening Day roster includes two MLB Pipeline Top 30 A's prospects in outfielder **Henry Bolte** (No. 12) and first baseman **Will Simpson** (No. 30). Bolte, the A's No. 2 outfield prospect, was selected 56th overall in 2022 from Palo Alto High School, where he led all California high schoolers with 13 home runs. He spent the 2023 season with Single-A Stockton, where he slashed .257/.356/.421 in 112 games, collecting 17 doubles, five triples, 14 home runs and 32 stolen bases. Simpson, the A's No. 2 first base prospect, impressed with a .319/.367/.543 line in his professional debut after he was drafted in the 15th round from Washington last year.

Familiar Faces: Lansing returns 17 players from the 2023 ballclub, not including second-year manager **Craig Conklin** and fourth-year pitching coach **Don Schulze**. Returners include **James González**, **Euribiel Angeles**, **Brayan Buelvas**, **Jonny Butler** and **Joshwan Wright**, who each appeared in both 2022 and 2023, as well as **Jack Owen**, who has pitched effectively during each of the last three seasons.

Come Together: The Lugnuts' Opening Day roster includes players representing 10 states, Puerto Rico, and six countries: Canada, Colombia, Cuba, Dominican Republic, Panama and Venezuela.

Home Cooking: Also from Tucson: Alex Verdugo, four-time All-Star Ian Kinsler, two-time All-Star J.J. Hardy, Cardinals All-Star catcher Tom Pagnozzi and Ron Hassey... in all, Tucson ranks second behind Phoenix in producing Major Leaguers from the Grand Canyon State.

Glory Days: Boasting a 96 mph fastball, Dicochea was highly regarded coming out of Sahuarita High School, ranked the No. 1 prep prospect in Arizona by Baseball America entering the 2019 draft... twirled a no-hitter in the state semifinals... signed for \$400,000... signing scout: Scott Cousins... signed away from commitment to University of Arizona... senior year stats: 1.30 ERA, 54 IP, 24 H, 10 ER, 11 BB, 86 K... in addition to pitching, also starred at shortstop.

Minor League Path: Dicochea opened his professional career in the 2019 Arizona League after signing, but his 2021 campaign was halted in Single-A Stockton due to injury on June 6 after only six appearances, five starts... returned from Tommy John surgery on August 12, 2022, and made two appearances in the Arizona Complex League before returning to Stockton on August 26, 2022... finished the year with three appearances for the Ports.

Bagels in April: Opened 2023 as the Ports' No. 4 starter, firing four scoreless innings at Fresno on April 11... that was the start of three consecutive scoreless outings to begin the year, finishing April with 13 2/3 scoreless innings... didn't allow first run until May 3 vs. Fresno, entering in relief in the fifth inning and allowing two runs in the fifth and two more in the seventh in a 5-4 Ports win... in total with Stockton, posted a 2.42 ERA with a .132 average against in five road starts (22 1/3 IP) compared to 4.24 ERA, .200 avg. in four home appearances (17 IP)... lefties hit .111/.243/.175 compared to righties' .205/.279/.308... base stealers went 2-for-2.

Rave Reviews: Dicochea was promoted from Single-A Stockton to Lansing on June 13, 2023, to replace Jack Perkins, who was transferred up to Double-A Midland... coincidentally, an article about Dicochea had just been written by MLB.com A's beat writer Martin Gallegos a day earlier, quoting A's GM David Forst in including Dicochea's name among the top pitching prospects in the system (Royber Salinas, Gunnar Hoglund, J.T. Ginn and Joey Estes). Wrote Gallegos about Dicochea, "Dicochea, an eighth-round selection by the A's in the 2019 MLB Draft out of Sahuarita (Ariz.) High School, ranks just outside Oakland's Top 30 Prospects list. But his inclusion in that group from Forst speaks volumes about how highly he is viewed. In nine games (seven starts) for Single-A Stockton this season, Dicochea holds a 3.20 ERA with 47 strikeouts against 17 walks in 39 1/3 innings. He has held opposing batters to a .163 average, which ranks lowest among all California League pitchers with at least 30 innings pitched. Dicochea's development hit a snag early in his pro career after he underwent Tommy John surgery in 2021. Since his return from injury, the 22-year-old right-hander is taking a big step forward this season, showing off a fastball that consistently hits 95 mph along with a solid slider and a changeup he's recently added to his mix. A's assistant general manager and director of player personnel Billy Owens added, "He's off to a promising start. Averaging well over a strikeout per inning. Overall, his command has taken a step forward. He's definitely an interesting arm on the horizon."

In a Nutshell: Watters first appeared for the Lugnuts on August 31, 2022, pitching against Cubs rehabber Wade Miley at South Bend in his second professional appearance... he then spent the full 2023 season for the Nuts.

Entering Draft Day: Rated Keith Law's No. 68 draft prospect for The Athletic, with Law writing, "Watters started the year in the Mountaineers' bullpen, where he hit 99 mph a few times, so the team moved him to the rotation around midseason, where he struggled more with control (37 walks in 50.2 innings) but also showed enough that some scouts think he can start in pro ball. Watters sits 94-97 mph with a power slider in the mid-80s that can miss bats ... when he locates it. WVU to the Pros: First of three Mountaineers selected in the 2022 draft... the 2021 Fort Wayne TinCaps featured two WVU teammates in 2021 draftees Jackson Wolf (4th round) and Ryan Bergert (6th round); pitched against Bergert on May 26, 2023, and tossed 5 2/3 scoreless innings, allowing only one hit... the last WVU player taken in the first round was Alek Manoah by Toronto in 2019, who in 2022 joined John Means as the only Mountaineers to be named MLB All-Stars... the last West Virginia player to suit up for the Lugnuts was Ryan McBroom, who won the 2015 Midwest League Most Valuable Player award.
