TONIGHT'S GAME: The Quakes continue their six-game road trip with game three of a six-game series at Banner Island Ballpark, taking on the Stockton Ports (ATH). The Quakes will return to LoanMart Field on Tuesday, April 15th, taking on the San Jose Giants in a six-game set.

VS THE PORTS: Today's game is the third of 18 games (all in the first half) against the Ports and the third of 12 here in Stockton. Last season, the Quakes went 8-2 against the Ports, 5-1 here in Stockton.

LAST GAME: The Ports exploded on Wednesday night and won their second straight game in the series with a 12-5 win over the Quakes at Banner Island Ballpark. Stockton centerfielder Cameron Leary homered twice and drove in a career-best seven runs, as the Ports won their third straight game overall. Rancho reliever Sterling Patick (0-1) was tagged for seven runs in one-plus inning and suffered the loss. Stockton reliever Donny Troconis (1-0) fired three scoreless innings for the win. Rancho had three players with multi-hit games, as Kellon Lindsey (3), Joendry Vargas (2) and Elijah Hainline (2) combined for seven of their nine hits.

ROSTER MOVES: The Quakes made their first roster move of the year, placing INF Nico Perez on the IL, retroactive to April 8. Taking his place on the roster will be INF Raynerd Ortega, who joins the team from Extended Spring.

NO RUNNING IN THE HALLS: The Quakes have not stolen a base in this series and in fact, are 0-for-2 on the bases through the first two games of the Stockton set. The Quakes stole a total of nine bases in Saturday night's game, with Kellon Lindsey, Jose Meza and Joendry Vargas all stealing two each. They followed that up on Sunday with three on Sunday, giving them 14 steals through just three games, this after they swiped just 128 bases in 130 games in 2024.

EARLY STREAKS: Eduardo Quintero is off to a great start with a .444 batting average (8-for-18), while Joendry Vargas is hitting .400 (8-for-20). Both have hit safely in all five games they've played in. Elijah Hainline has hit safely in all four games he's played in and is hitting a team-high .462 (6-for-13).

STILL WEARING THE SAME SHOE: The Quakes are excited to welcome back Manager John Shoemaker, who returns to Rancho to guide the Quakes for a fifth straight year, a franchise record. The club is 271-243 in four seasons under "Shoe", having made the playoffs twice, including one appearance in the Championship Series (2023). The Quakes have only one returning coach to this year's club, as pitching coach Ramon Troncoso returns to Rancho, joining Shoemaker for his fifth year as well. New members of the coaching staff include hitting coach Johermyn Chavez, pitching coach Brandon Bailey, Bench Coach Dunior Zerpa, Bullpen Coach and former Quake Marco Hernandez, Athletic Trainer Alfredo Casillas, Performance Coach Jake Taylor and Video Associate Max Delorme.

HYUN-SEOK JANG: Right-hander Hyun-Seok Jang makes his second start of the year and his first against Stockton. In his only outing this year, he allowed just one run on two hits over four innings in a no-decision against Lake Elsinore on April 4. Jang went 1-2 with an 8.14 ERA over 13 games (10 starts) and 24.1 innings pitched in the ACL last year, before finishing the year with five starts in Rancho, where he went 0-1 with a 2.19 ERA over 12 innings pitched. Jang, who signed with the Dodgers in August of 2023 out of South Korea, was regarded as the top pitching prospect coming out of Korea in 2023 and is rated by MLB Pipeline as the Dodgers' 17th best prospect.

NATHAN DETTMER: Right-hander Nathan Dettmer makes his second start of the year and his first against the Quakes. Dettmer got the opening night start in Fresno on April 4 and allowed just one run on three hits over five innings in a no-decision. Dettmer was drafted by the A's in the fifth round of the 2023 draft out of Texas A&M.
