Road Trip Part Two

The Fightin Phils continue their season-long two week road trip at the Portland Sea Dogs on Thursday morning. It is the fourth-of-18 matchups between the teams this season and fourth-of-12 at Hadlock Field in Portland. The Sea Dogs make the trip to Reading from June 9-14 and then the Fightin Phils return to Portland from Aug. 18-23. Reading dropped the 2025 season-series to Portland 13-8, which included a 3-9 record on the road at Hadlock Field. The Sea Dogs lead the season-series 3-0 after grabbing wins in the first three games of the week.

Morning Game Shutout

The Fightin Phils dropped their third-straight game on Thursday morning in what was a 1-0 shutout loss to Portland. It marked the third shutout loss for the Fightin Phils in their last five games, which comes on the heels of a 20-0 win over New Hampshire last Saturday. It was also the seventh-shutout defeat of the season for the Fightin Phils, which came after they were shutout nine times in 2025. Luke Russo started for Reading and turned in another impressive outing. Russo allowed one run on three hits over five innings, with a season-high eight strikeouts. The bullpen duo of Andrew Baker (1.2 IP) and Alex McFarlane (1.1 IP) combined to not allow a run, and strike out four batters over the final three innings. Offensively, Reading was held to five hits, and struck out 20 times. The 20 strikeouts by the Fightin Phils hitters marked their most in a game since at least the 2005 season.

Wood You Believe It

The Philadelphia Phillies announced on Monday that No. 2 Prospect, and top-pitching prospect, Gage Wood was promoted to Reading from Clearwater (A), skipping Jersey Shore (A+) and he will make his Double-A debut on Friday night. Wood joins the Fightin Phils after just nine-career starts with Clearwater. This season, Wood is 0-2, with a 3.42 ERA (10 ER, 26.1 IP) over eight starts. He has sent down 40 batters on strikes, good for a 13.67 SO/9.0 IP mark, which was 7th in the FSL amongst pitchers with at least 20.0 IP. At the time of his promotion, Wood was seventh in the Florida State League in strikeouts. Wood joins the Fightin Phils less than one year following his selection in the first round (26th overall) by the Phillies out of Arkansas, where he pitched from 2023-25. His college career was highlighted by a no-hitter in the 2025 College World Series against Murray State. Wood is currently scheduled to make his Double-A debut on Friday at Portland.

A Historic Win on Saturday

The Fightin Phils 20-0 win over New Hampshire on Saturday marked the largest run differential in a game for Reading since at least as far back as the 1992 season. It also marked Reading's third 20+ run game since at least 2005 and first since July 8, 2016, a 21-4 win vs Bowie. The other 20+ run instance for the R-Phils was July 2, 2007, a 21-4 win vs New Britain. The game also featured fourth-career four-hit game for Alex Binelas (LAST: 6/11/24, with Portland at Reading) and the third-career four-hit game for Austin Murr (LAST: 6/13/25, with West Michigan at Lansing). Murr also secured his second-career four-run game and the first four-hit/four-run game of his career. Bryan Rincon also had his second-career four-run game, with the other coming on May 1 of this year at Hartford.

Pitching Powers

The Fightin Phils pitching staff continued their recent strong stretch with another good week at New Hampshire and a strong start to the series with Portland on Thursday. Over their last 13 games (since May 8), Reading leads the Eastern League with a 2.67 ERA (30 ER, 101.0 IP). On the season, the R-Phils team 4.33 ERA ranks third in the Eastern League, which comes after finishing last in the league with a 4.58 ERA in 2025. Reading's pitching staff has also showcased some of the best control in the league as well, issuing the fewest walks in the league at 131, which is well ahead of the second fewest, Portland with 155. Strong fielding has helped out the Fightin Phils pitching staff, as Reading enters play on Friday with a .979 fielding percentage, which is tied for the second best in the Eastern League.

Money McFarlane

Alex McFarlane continued his excellent season with a scoreless 1.1-innings of work on Thursday. On the season, the Phillies No. 17 prospect has a 0.57 ERA (1 ER, 15.2 IP). McFarlane has not allowed an earned run in 10-straight outings and has not allowed one in 15-of-16 appearances on the season. Amongst Eastern League pitchers that have fired at least 15.0 IP this season, McFarlane has the lowest ERA at 0.57.

Get a Lead and Hold It

Getting to the seventh inning with a lead has been a strong indicator of success for the Fightin Phils this season. When leading after seven innings this season, Reading is 16-0 and they are 15-0 when holding a lead following the eighth inning this year.

This Day in Baseballtown History

May 22, 2025: At Portland, Chuck King tosses a career-high six innings and allows two runs (one earned), but the Fightin Phils lose to Portland 6-3.

From the Cats to the Dogs

Portland enters play today with a 20-21 record, which is third in the Northeast Division, a half game ahead of Reading, and 3.5 games behind first place New Hampshire. The Sea Dogs most recently split a six-game series at Hartford, and following this week, will be back on the road to face Binghamton. Portland's roster features 10 of the Red Sox top-30 prospects: Franklin Arias (1), Anthony Eyanson (2), John Holobetz (12), Hayden Mullins (14), Miguel Bleis (15), Jedixson Paez (19), Gage Ziehl (20), Nelly Taylor (21), Johanfran Garcia (26) and Yordanny Monegro (28).

Portland Pitcher

Righty, and Red Sox No. 12 prospect, John Holobetz makes the start tonight for Portland. Holobetz is 1-3, with a 4.83 ERA (17 ER, 31.2 IP) over seven appearances and six starts. He last pitched May 15 at Hartford, allowing one run on three hits over five innings, with four strikeouts. Holobetz split his first pro season in 2025 between the Brewers and Red Sox systems, pitching for Carolina (A), Greenville (A+) and Portland, combining to go 8-4, with a 3.03 ERA over 23 games and 19 starts. He was the player to be named later in the Apr. 7, 2025 deal that sent Quinn Priester to the Brewers; being dealt on May 5, 2025. The 23-year old was drafted by Milwaukee in the fifth round of the 2024 draft out of Old Dominion.
