Sept. 11: Senators 5, RubberDucks 3: Joe Lampe, Alex Mooney and Jake Fox all hit solo home runs while Steven Pérez struck out five in two innings of relief, but Akron fell in game three of the series.

Today's starting pitcher: Khal Stephen makes his 22 appearance of the season and fourth start with Akron on Friday night. The right-hander is coming off a no-decision against Binghamton last week after allowing just one run over four innings while striking out six. His six strikeouts, four innings pitched and 60 pitchers were all the most Stephen has recorded since being traded to the Guardians organization and activated off the IL. He is one of just two pitchers in full season MiLB to strike out 100+ and walk less than 20 batters this season (Marcus Johnson with Bowling Green has 138SO and 16BB).

Year of speed: Akron's 157 stolen bases and 40 triples are the most by an Akron team since the 2006 Aeros stole 176 bases (a franchise record) and the 2015 RubberDucks hit 43 triples. Akron's franchise record for triples in a season is 46 set in 1996 and 2004.

Mooney magic: Alex Mooney has been coming up big with men on base as of late. The RubberDucks infielder has an RBI in each of his last five games including back-to-back games (Sunday and Tuesday) with go-ahead base hits. Mooney is fifth on the active team with 37 RBI on the season. After homering just once through his first 92 games played this season, Mooney's homer on Thursday night marked his third home run in his last 20 games played.

Antunez amps up: Wuilfredo Antunez has been red hot since coming off the injured list. The outfielder is batting .333 with three home runs, two triples, six doubles and 17 RBI in 19 games played including recording a hit in 11 of his last 13 games. His 18 home runs on the season between Akron and Lake County are fourth most in the Guardians organization. Antunez leads the RubberDucks with a .417 average with RISP and two outs.

New Heights: The RubberDucks outfield is taking their defense to new heights this season. Akron is fourth in the Eastern League in outfield assists with 27. Only Portland (39), Hartford (34) and Binghamton (33) have more. The RubberDucks have two outfielders ranked in the top seven of outfield assists entering Friday. Hartford's Cole Carrigg (17) leads the EL followed by Joe Lampe (13), Portland's Allan Castro (10), Binghamton's D'Andre Smith and Nick Morabito as well as Harrisburg's Philip Glasser (8), and Guy Lipscomb. Portland's Caden Rose and Hartford's Juan Guerrero (7). Lampe's 13 assists are the most by Akron outfielder since Carlos Moncreif's 16 assists in 2013. Outfielder Jake Fox has a 77-game errorless streak, which is tied second longest in the EL this season.

RubberDucks travel to Senators: Akron and Harrisburg will face off in the final series of the regular season. It will be the third meeting of the two clubs this season and second meeting at FNB Field. The two teams split the first two series 6-6 with Akron going 4-2 at Canal Park and Harrisburg going 2-4 at FNB Field. Akron leads the all-time series between the two franchises 304-284. Top prospects in this series include:

Getting comfortable in Akron: Ralphy Velazquez and Jacob Cozart have not skipped a beat since being promoted to Double-A. Velazquez is batting .343/.425/.616 in 25 games with Akron with 14 extra-base hits, 19 RBI and 18 runs scored. Cozart is batting .267/.341/.413 in 19 games with the RubberDucks with six extra-base hits, 10 RBI and 12 runs scored. Cozart has reached base in 10 of his last 13 games played and has picked up a hit in eight of his last 11 games. Velazquez has a hit in 21 of the 25 games he has played with Akron. Velazquez leads the team with a .417 average with RISP since joining the RubberDucks.

Power bats: Ralphy Velazquez has launched five home runs with Akron. Those five Double-A homers give him 22 on the season, which leads the Guardians organization. Alfonsin Rosario is second in the organization with 21 homers between Akron and Lake County.

Wuilfredo Antunez's 18 homers and Jorge Burgos' 14 homers give Akron four of the top five home run hitters in the Guardians organization. The RubberDucks homered in five straight games from Aug. 14-19 with 10 home runs in that span. This was the second time this season Akron as a team homered in five consecutive games (April 4-9).

Good eye: The RubberDucks have walked 575 times this season, which is most in the Eastern League and third most in Double-A. The RubberDucks have worked eight or more walks in a game 13 times this year including 10 walks against the Baysox on May 17 and Richmond on July 11. 18 Akron batters have worked double digit walks so far this season, and six have worked 40 or more walks.

Can't start a fire without a spark: The RubberDucks are outscoring opponents 80-57 in the first inning and 158-120 over the first two innings this season. Akron is 59-18 when scoring first (second most wins in the Eastern League when scoring first). The RubberDucks batters have 227 hits the first time through the order this year.

Acquired by Cleveland in a trade on July 31 for Shane Bieber.... Rehabbed after trade at the Guardians Arizona Complex and made a start in a bridge game on Aug. 20.

Made Double-A debut with New Hampshire on July 20 tossing four innings (5R, 4ER, 2SO)...Placed on IL on July 24 due to right shoulder impingement.

Promoted to High-A Vancouver on May 20...Made nine starts going 6-1 with a 1.49 ERA and 49 strikeouts over 48.1 innings...Earned Northwest League Pitcher of the Month honors in June after going 3-1 with a 0.95 ERA with 33 strikeouts in five starts.

#26 Manager Greg DiCenzo enters his fifth season with the Guardians organization. The 2024 season will be DiCenzo's second as RubberDucks manager, and fourth as a manager in the Guardians organization. He guided the RubberDucks to an 80-58 record and an Eastern League playoff appearance in 2024.

Prior to becoming Triple-A Columbus' bench coach in 2023, DiCenzo spent the 2021 and 2022 seasons as the manager in High-A Lake County. He guided the Captains to a 141-108 record in his two seasons including a Midwest League finals appearance in 2022.

A native of Duxbury, MA, DiCenzo was the head baseball coach at Holy Cross for 12 seasons prior to joining the Cleveland organization. The Crusaders went 137-109 in Patriot League play during his tenure, including a 2017 Patriot League Championship, and posted 20-win seasons in 10 of those 12 years.

#55 Hitting Coach Jordan Becker enters his sixth season with the Guardians organization and second with the RubberDucks. In 2023, Becker served as the hitting coach for Lake County.

Becker joined the Cleveland organization in 2019 after a collegiate coaching career that saw stops at Riverside Community College and New Mexico State University.

#29 Hitting Coach Ian Forster enters his sixth season in the Guardians organization and second season in Akron. Forster will also be a hitting coach for RubberDucks and returns to Akron after serving as the RubberDucks assistant hitting coach in 2023. He was the Arizona Complex Guardians hitting coach in 2024.

A graduate of North Olmsted High School, Forster played four years at Baldwin Wallace University in Berea.

#12 Pitching Coach Kevin Erminio enters his sixth season in the Guardians organization and first season with the RubberDucks. Prior to coming to Akron, Erminio was the pitching coach for the Lake County Captains for the 2023 and 2024 seasons.

Erminio joined the Guardians organization after a collegiate coaching career that included stops as a pitching coach in Oxford at Miami University and 13 seasons at Kennesaw State.

#54 Pitching Coach Michael Poole enters his third season in the Guardians organization and second season with the RubberDucks. He will be a pitching coach in 2025 after spending 2024 as Akron's assistant pitching coach. Prior to joining the RubberDucks, Poole was the pitching development coach on the Arizona Complex Academy staff.

A native of [Akron](#), Poole played at Cuyahoga Community College and Lake Erie College before starting his coaching career at Inspiration Academy (FL) in 2019. Poole was an assistant coach at LSU-Eunice for the Bengals D2 JUCO World Series Championship season in 2021.

#49 Bench Coach Marc Mumper enters his third season in the Guardians organization and first season in Akron. He will also serve as the Guardians organization's assistant infield coordinator. Prior to coming to Akron, Mumper spent 2024 as the bench coach for Lake County.

A native of Highlands Ranch, CO, Mumper played 157 games from 2016-19 for Grand Canyon University. He then went on to coach at the college level in several different roles from 2019-22 before joining the Guardians organization.

#41 Development Coach Seth Caddell enters his second season as a coach in the Guardians organization and second season with the RubberDucks. Before joining the RubberDucks coaching staff in 2024, Caddell played in the Guardians organization for three seasons as a catcher.

Athletic Trainer Derrik Diaz enters his eighth season in the Guardians organization and second season with the RubberDucks. He also serves as the Guardians organization's assistant coordinator for Dominican Republic Medical Services. Diaz was the Eastern League Athletic Trainer of the Year in 2024. Prior to coming to Akron, Diaz served as the head athletic trainer for the Dominican Republic Complex in 2023.

Assistant Athletic Trainer Karina Gonzalez enters her third season in the Guardians organization and second season in Akron. Prior to coming to Akron, Gonzalez spent the 2023 season at the Guardians complex in Goodyear.

Strength and Conditioning Coach Mo Cuevas enters his 10th season with the Guardians organization and third season in Akron. He was the Eastern League Strength Coach of the Year in 2024. Prior to joining the RubberDucks, Cuevas served as the Guardians rehab strength and conditioning coach in 2022.

Baseball Technology Fellow Kade Enders enters his first season in Akron. A native of Medina, Enders previously worked as an intern for USA baseball, video associate for the Los Angeles Dodgers and baseball performance science video intern for the Tampa Bay Rays before joining the Guardians organization.

We Are the RubberDucks

On October 29, 2013, team owner **Ken Babby** and general manager **Jim Pfander** stood before a capacity audience at the Akron Civic Theater and announced that the team would be known henceforth as the **Akron RubberDucks**. In addition to being symbolic of the fun, family-friendly brand of entertainment offered by minor league baseball, the name also honors Akron's long history as the "**Rubber Capital of the World**." Brandiose Marketing of San Diego, California designed the team logo, colors, and various marks and insignias. Please note that for print coverage, *RubberDucks* is spelled as one word with a capital "D." In broadcast coverage, referring to the team as "*the 'Ducks*" is an acceptable variation of the team's nickname.
