## JUBMO SHRIMP COME UP SHORT IN 4-3 LOSS

Marty Costes collected a pair of hits and an RBI on Saturday, but the Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp came up short in a 4-3 loss to the Gwinnett Stripers. Yuli Gurriel broke a 1-1 tie in the fourth inning by homering off Jumbo Shrimp (42-49,
7-9) starter Darren McCaughan (4-3). Luis Liberato followed with a base hit before scoring on Luke Waddell's double to widen the gap to 3-1 in favor of the Stripers (44-48, 9-8). Andrew Velazquez led off the fifth by launching a home run to make it 4-1. Jacksonville made a late charge in the seventh inning, plating two runs but Gwinnett starter Bryce Elder (6-3) was able to avoid further damage from there.

## AND SHE THINKS WE'RE JUST FISHIN'

Over the last 25 meetings between Jacksonville and Gwinnett dating back to 2023, the Stripers hold a narrow 14-11 advantage over the Jumbo Shrimp. Over these 25 contests, Gwinnett has outscored Jacksonville by a thin 104-96 margin. Nineteen of these 25 affairs have been determined by three runs or fewer; the Stripers own an 11-8 advantage in these closely-decided contests. With much else being equal over these 25 games, Gwinnett owns edges in stolen bases (26-13) and strikeouts (202-192).

## GET PITCH OR DIE TRYIN'

Jacksonville has gone 17-14 in their last 31 contests, mainly behind some dominant pitching and defense. During this span, the Jumbo Shrimp have ceded four runs or fewer in 21 of those 31 affairs ( 67.7 percent). Since this run began on June 7, Jacksonville leads all of Triple-A in both fewest runs allowed (120) and ERA (3.53) while ranking fourth in OPS against (.742), second in WHIP (1.35), fourth in fewest hits allowed (251) and tied for fourth in batting average against (.244).

GRIFFIN-DOR, WHERE DWELL THE BRAVE AT HEART Jacksonville outfielder Griffin Conine has been stellar since early May. Over his last 56 games, the Duke product is 59-for-198, slashing .298/.368/.586/.954 with 13 doubles, one triple, 14 home runs, 38 RBls, 22 walks and 35 runs scored. Among the 117 qualified hitters in the IL, Conine ranks eighth in HR/FB ( 27.0 percent). On the season, he ranks tied for eighth in the IL in extra-base hits (36), tied for 11th in home runs (17), 16th in SLG (.517) and tied for 19th in both doubles (18) and hits (78).

## QUIT PLAYING GAMES WITH MY START

Jacksonville starting pitchers have yielded three earned runs or fewer in 26 of the last 30 games, with 20 of those starts resulting in two earned runs or fewer charged to a Jumbo Shrimp lid-lifter, and 10 being without an earned run. During this stretch, Jumbo Shrimp starting pitchers have ceded only 60 runs, 53 earned, on 123 hits ( $8.6 \mathrm{H} / 9$ ) in 129.0 innings for a 3.70 ERA. Jacksonville starters have combined for 123 strikeouts ( $8.6 \mathrm{~K} / 9$ ) against 56 walks ( $3.9 \mathrm{BB} / 9$ ) during this stretch. Rather remarkably, the Jumbo Shrimp have started 15 different pitchers over these 30 contests.

## SOULJA TROY

Heading into play on May 25, Troy Johnston, the reigning Marlins Minor League Player of the Year, was hitting just .240/.294/.316/.610 with only 12 doubles, one home run, 21 RBIs, nine walks and 16 runs scored in 48 games. However, over the last 42 contests, the Puyallup, Wash., native is a sizzling 54 -for-158, slashing .342/.408/.525/.933 with 10 doubles, two triples, five homers, 23 RBIs, 16 walks and 31 runs scored. Johnston has 13 multi-hit games in his last 23 contests and is the season's IL leader in hits (101) while also ranking tied for fourth in doubles (22) and 24th in batting average (.285).

## LITTLE GUY, BIG RESULTS

Over his first 11 games in Triple-A, Javier Sanoja was just 6 -for-39 (.154) at the plate. However, the 5 -foot-7 Venezuelan struck out in only two plate appearances. His contact ability has manifested itself in a huge way of late; Sanoja has reached base safely in 51 of his last 58 games, notching 21 multi-hit contests. During this span, he is $74-$ for-230 (.322/.387/.465/.852) with 18 doubles, three triples, three home runs, 36 RBIs, 26 walks and 28 runs scored. On the season, Sanoja ranks 11th in batting average (.297), tied for 12th in doubles (20) and tied for 15th in hits (80).

## SHRIMP BITES

Jacksonville's starting rotation ERA of 4.41 ranks first in all of Triple-A. The Jumbo Shrimp's lid-lifters have tossed 408.0 innings, which ranks eighth at the level... Jacksonville relievers have combined for a 4.30 ERA (sixth in Triple-A)... The Jumbo Shrimp are 14-9 (.609) in their last 23 road games.

-Selected by the Marlins with the third overall pick of the 2020 draft, Meyer tied Hall of Famer Paul Molitor (No. 3 to the Milwaukee Brewers in 1977) as the highest pick in Minnesota Golden Gophers history. Meyer is one of four Minnesotans to be pick in the top five in the draft, along with Molitor, Joe Mauer and Dave Winfield. Prior to Meyer, the last time the Gophers had a pitcher taken in the first round of the MLB draft was left-hander Glen Perkins, who was selected 22nd overall by the Minnesota Twins in 2004.
-During his junior season at Minnesota in 2020, Meyer was tabbed as a consensus Preseason All-American and made four starts in a shortned season due to the pandemic. He finished fifth in the nation with 46 strikeouts and a team-best 1.95 ERA in 27.2 innings. Meyer has slashed $.185 / .214 / .222$ with one double, two runs scored, four RBIs and a stolen base while playing infield for the Gophers.
-As a sophomore in 2019, Meyer was named an All-Big Ten Second Team Selection. He made 16 appearances on the mound, including 11 starts, and went $5-3$ with a 2.11 ERA and two saves 76.2 innings. He fanned a team-high 87 batters. Meyer also played in 35 games, including 30 starts, on the infield, batting $.256 / .323 / .314$ with four doubles, one home run, 12 RBIs and 15 runs scored.
-A native of Woodbury, Minn., Meyer played hockey at Woodbury High School, lettering for three seasons as a forward. He was selected by the Minnesota Twins in the 34th round of the 2017 draft, but opted to pitch collegiately at the University of Minnesota.
-Both of Max's parents, Kathy and Kent, played collegiately while attending St. Olaf College (Northfield, Minn.). Kent was a member of the Oles' football team while Kathy played on the school's women's soccer team.

## 2021 SEASON

-Meyer was promoted to Jacksonville on September 23 from Double-A Pensacola. With the Blue Wahoos, he led Double-A South in both ERA (2.41) and batting average against (.226) while ranking second in both strikeouts (113) and WHIP (1.23) and fourth in IP (101.0).
-Meyer's 10 strikeouts in his Triple-A debut on September 24 against Memphis were the most for any Jacksonville pitcher in a level debut since at least 2005.
