Tonight: The Lugnuts play the third game in a six-game series against the Great Lakes Loons, sending right-hander **Shohei Tomioka** against debuting Loons right-hander **Gavin Stone**, the Dodgers' fifth-round selection in 2020 from Central Arkansas. Lansing responded to a series-opening defeat with a victory last night.

Last Night: Lugnuts 8, Camels 5. The Lugs scored six runs in the fourth inning to knock out Great Lakes starter Jesús Vargas and Lansing starter Colin Peluse notched his team-leading fourth quality start (6 IP, 3 H, 2 R, 1 BB, 7 K) to become the second High-A Central pitcher to reach seven wins, giving the Nuts their fourth Wednesday win in 16 games.

On Deck: The Lugnuts play the Loons through Sunday before returning to Jackson Field to host West Michigan from August 24-29. Both of the Nuts' remaining homestands are against the Whitecaps.

What's New in 2021: Entering this season, the Lugnuts' stadium name changed from Cooley Law School Stadium to Jackson® Field™, Lansing moved up to the High-A Central and the ballclub accepted an invitation to affiliate with the A's, the Nuts' fourth MLB partner, following the Royals (1996-98), Cubs (1999-2004) and Blue Jays (2005-2020).

Lug. Notes: Headlines and Points of Interest

Major League Debut: Last night, 2018 Lugnuts infielder Kevin Smith became the 161st former Lugnut to reach the Majors and the seventh this year alone, pinch-hitting and striking out for the Toronto Blue Jays in a loss in Washington. Smith is also the 44th different former Lugnut to see time in the Majors this season.

Trouble With the Longball: With **Eddys Leonard's** two-run homer in the second inning last night, Lugnuts pitchers have now allowed 17 home runs in their last nine games.

Stealing Success: The Lugnuts swiped three more bases yesterday and now are 7-for-8 in steals in the first two games of this series and 20-for-21 in stealing bases in August. As a team, Lansing has been caught only 21 times, second fewest in the league, while stealing 126 bases, third most in the league, an 86% success rate.

Jordan Rules: 21-year-old **Jordan Díaz**, the youngest player on Lansing's roster, is tied for second in the High-A Central with 23 doubles and ranks fifth with 35 extra-base hits, fifth with 85 base hits and fifth with 143 total bases.

Alumni Report: 2019 Lugnuts outfielder **Griffin Conine** is tied for the MiLB lead with 31 home runs this year, currently playing with Double-A Pensacola in the Miami system. 2021 infielder **Max Schuemann**, currently with Double-A Midland, is tied for fourth in MiLB with 44 stolen bases.

Welcome Aboard: Outfielder Jonny "Barrels" Butler made his Lugnuts debut yesterday after getting called up from the Arizona Complex League Athletics, becoming the 52nd Nut to suit up this season and the 856th Lugnuts player all-time. Butler was drafted in the 14th round in July from North Carolina State University, where he led the ACC in batting with a .376 average and was named the 2021 Atlantic Coast Conference Baseball Scholar-Athlete of the Year.

New Talent Infusion: Butler is the fifth 2021 A's draftee/signee to join Lansing, adding to infielders **Brett Harris** (7th round, Gonzaga) and **Drew Swift** (8th round, Arizona State) and pitchers **Kyle Virbitsky** (17th round, Penn State) and **Jack Owen** (undrafted free agent, Auburn).

All You Need is Glove: Brett Harris was named the 2021 West Coast Conference Defensive Player (in addition to being honored as First Team All-Conference, leading the Bulldogs with a .355 average, 1.027 OPS, 52 runs, 70 hits and 18 extra-base hits in 52 games, committing only two errors) and **Drew Swift** was named the Pac-12 Defensive Player of the Year, the first Sun Devil so honored, and received the 2021 ABCA/Rawlings Gold Glove as the nation's top defensive shortstop.

TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2011: LF Marcus Knecht hit the Lugnuts' first grand slam of the year in a 6-2 win at Bowling Green. He would follow up with another grand slam the next day back in Lansing, the Nuts' only grand slams of the season.

2016: Manager John Schneider mandated that the Lugnuts show up only two hours before Saturday's series opener against South Bend at Cooley Law School Stadium. The offense showed up late during the game – but scored five runs in the bottom of the 8th for a 5-2 victory, ending a four-game losing streak, before a roaring crowd of 8,404. The rally included two run-scoring wild pitches from Cubs reliever Jared Cheek and a two-run tie-breaking triple from Justin Atkinson.

Root, Root for the Home Team: July 4th's Lugnuts/Dragons series finale drew a season-high attendance of 10,109. That's higher than the average attendance in MLB for the Baltimore Orioles, Pittsburgh Pirates, Tampa Bay Rays, Miami Marlins and Oakland Athletics. Only nine of the 119 other Minor League teams have drawn a larger crowd to a game this season: Albuquerque, Nashville, Salt Lake, Charlotte, Fresno, Indianapolis, Round Rook, Durham and Las Vegas.

Pitching is an Art... and So is Sculpting: Blake McFarland, who pitched for the 2012 Lansing Lugnuts, is now a professional sculptor who competed on NBC's reality show "Making It," hosted by Nick Offerman and Amy Poehler, but was eliminated in the fifth episode.

Major League Lugnuts: Six former Nuts have made their Major League debuts this season - pitcher Ty Tice '18 (Tronto, now with Arizona), outfielder Josh Palacios '16-'17 (Toronto), pitcher Tayler Saucedo '16-'17 (Toronto), pitcher Conner Greene '15 (Baltimore), pitcher Kirby Snead '16-'17 (Toronto) and infielder Otto Lopez '19 (Toronto). Tice and Palacios made their first MLB appearance in the same game for the Toronto Blue Jays on April 9th. It was the seventh time in team history that two Lugnuts made their MLB debut in the same game, with the first occurring on September 14, 1998: Carlos Febles and Carlos Beltrán for the Kansas City Royals. Snead most recently debuted, appearing in relief for the Blue Jays on July 28.

Star of Stars: The 2021 MLB All-Star Game MVP Award was won by 2017 Lugnut **Vladimir Guerrero, Jr.,** who went 1-for-3 with two RBIs, including a 468-foot home run, in the American League's 5-2 victory. Fellow 2017 Lugnut **Bo Bichette** came off the bench for the A.L. as reserve shortstop.

Record-Setting, Single Game, Stolen Bases: On June 15, Max Schuemann broke Samad Taylor's franchise single-game record of four steals in a game (set July 1, 2018) with five stolen bases against the Great Lakes Loons.

Record-Setting, Single Game, Home Runs Allowed: On June 20, Stevie Emanuels broke the franchise single game record, tied many times before, of three homers served up in a game, giving up four HRs to the Loons - two apiece by Deacon Liput and Andy Pages.

Record-Setting, Single Game, HBPs: On July 14, Lansing Lugnuts pitchers hit seven Lake County Captains, breaking the franchise single game record, and the second-highest single game HBP total for a team plunked by one pitching staff behind the 1993 Gulf Coast League Braves, who were hit eight times on June 18, 1993.

Representing His Country: 1B/3B Jordan Díaz played for Colombia in Olympic Baseball Qualifying play, blasting a game-tying home run in the 9th against Venezuela, but Colombia lost all three games in opening pool play and was eliminated. Team USA won the tournament, punching a ticket to Japan.

Front Office Connections: Lugnuts pitching coach Don Schulze was drafted 11th overall by the Chicago Cubs in 1980, 12 picks before Oakland Executive Vice President of Baseball Operations Billy Beane was drafted by the New York Mets. Lugnuts first baseman Patrick McColl set a new Harvard baseball single season record with 70 hits in 2019, breaking the previous record held by Athletics General Manager David Forst.

International Appeal: Seven nations are represented on the Lugnuts' roster: USA, Colombia, Cuba, Dominican Republic, Japan, South Africa (Anthony Phillips) and Venezuela (Javier Godard).

Welcome to the Pros: Pitchers Jeff Criswell, Stevie Emanuels, Jack Owen, Kyle Virbitsky and Shohei Tomioka, catchers Jared McDonald, Drew Millas and William Simoneit, infielder Patrick McColl, and outfielder Michael Guldberg have all made their pro debut this season with the Lugnuts.

So Many Starters: The Lugnuts have used 17 different starting pitchers this season, namely Brady Basso, Reid Birlingmair, Charlie Cerny, Jeff Criswell, Jack Cushing, David Leal, Stevie Emanuels, Richard Guasch, Jorge Juan, Rafael Kelly, Bryce Nightengale, Jack Owen, Colin Peluse, Leudeny Pineda, Seth Shuman, Shohei Tomioka and Brock Whittlesey.

Three Nuts Go to Washington: On July 30, catcher Drew Millas and pitchers Richard Guasch and Seth Shuman were traded by the Athletics to the Washington Nationals in exchange for catcher Yan Gomes and utilityman Josh Harrison.

Talented Staff: Shohei pitched on a talented Toyo University staff, evidenced by how the 2018 Nippon Professional Baseball Draft was loaded with his teammates, with Hiroshi Kaino selected 1st overall by Fukuoka, Taiga Kamichatani going later in the 1st round to Yokohama, and Chunichi drafting Kodai Umetsu in the 2nd round.

The Road to MLB: After not being drafted, Tomioka pitched for VITAL-NET in the amateur Industrial League, a level in which Hideo Nomo, Jun Tazawa and Kosuke Fukudome all first made their names before joining the higher ranks... tried out for the Athletics with 27 other pitchers in Autumn 2019, hit 95 mph with his fastball, and was signed in February... scout: Toshiyuki Tomitsuka...2021 marks his pro debut.

Starting Strong: After a successful pair of scoreless innings in his pro debut on Opening Night, May 4, following Seth Shuman, Tomioka was even sharper against Lake County in three scoreless innings on Saturday, May 8, after relieving top prospect Jeff Criswell... entered in the 3rd inning, working around a two-out double by Will Brennan... struck out two batters in a 1-2-3 4th... gave up a leadoff single in the 5th to Daniel Schneeman but erased him with a double-play ball and faced the minimum... of 10 batters faced, only Brennan and Schneeman hit the ball out of the infield... Lugnuts won, 2-0... in each of his first two outings as a professional, Tomioka received the victory from the official scorer.

Last Outing, August 13: Started vs. Dayton, allowing three runs in four innings (two in 2nd, one in 3rd)... served up two-run homer to Quin Cotton... struck out four... 61 pitches, 39 strikes... Lugnuts rallied to walk off with a 7-6 win over the Dragons on a Yerdel Vargas RBI single with one out in the bottom of the ninth.
