## Today's Game

The Bulls and Stripers will go head-to-head in game five of the six-game series on Saturday. Gwinnett took the first two games by a score of $8-4$, to get the early 2-0 series advanatge, and Durham has responded in the last two games to even the series score. RHP Kevin Herget $(0-0,0.00)$ is expected to start for Durham and LHP Kyle Muller (2-1, 3.16) is expected to start for Gwinnett.

## Last time Out

After Gwinnett struck first for a 1-0 lead, Durham responded in the bottom of the first with two runs and never looked back. The Bulls led by as many as four, and were able to withstand a 2-0 run in the seventh for the Stripers. The Bulls added one more run to the tally in the eighth and held Gwinnett scoreless in the 9th to sevure the win. Durham got two home-runs LF Josh Lowe, his third of the series and SS Tristan Gray. 2B Miles Mastrobuoni and C Rene Pinto led the way offensively for the Bulls with two hits each. Pitcher Josh Fleming (5.0 IP, 3 H, 1 R, $1 \mathrm{ER}, 1 \mathrm{BB}, 5 \mathrm{SO}$ ) got the win in his Bulls debut and pitcher Huascar Ynoa (3.0 IP, $5 \mathrm{H}, 4 \mathrm{R}, 4 \mathrm{ER}, 3 \mathrm{BB}, 7 \mathrm{SO}$ ) picked up the loss for Gwinnett.

## Bulls vs Stripers

Durham \& Gwinnett face off for the 1st time this year with a 6-game set at Durham Bulls Athletic Park. The Bulls won 12 of 17 matchups with the Stripers last season, including a 10 of 11 tilts at the DBAP, which included a 6 -game sweep over Gwinnett between 9/22-26 last year as part of the Triple-A Final Stretch. The Bulls also outscored the Stripers 77-50 in their 17 matchups last year, with pitchers posting a 3.07 ERA (143.2 IP). Durham enters this series having won each of their last 8 matchups with Gwinnett. OF Vidal Brujan in 16 games versus the Stripers in 2021 compiled a .300 mark ( $15-50$ ) with 10 runs, 4 doubles \& 5 RBI, in addition to 9 walks compared to 8 strikeouts.

## Bull-et Points

- OF Ryan Boldt has posted a .340 average (18-53) in 13 home games this year, adding 9 runs, 2 doubles, 1 triple, 3 homers \& 9 RBI.
- INF Cal Stevenson has reached base via a hit or walk in 19 of the 23 games in which he has recorded a plate appearance with the Bulls this season.
- Stevenson has also hit . 361 (13-36) in 12 home games in 2022, adding 6 runs, 2 doubles, 1 triple \& 3 RBI, reaching base in 10 of 11 games in which he has recorded a plate appearance.
-The Bulls are 13-3 when leading after 6 innings, compared to an 0-17 mark when trailing at that point
- Durham relievers have pitched 188.0 of the squad's 284.1 total innings so far in 2022, equaling $66.1 \%$ of those total frames.
- Bulls pitchers have posted a 6.31 ERA (144.0 IP) at home this year, the highest home ERA of any International League club in 2022.

Power Surge
After blasting 2 more homers last night, the Bulls have homered in all but 1 of their 11 May contests. Durham batters have bashed 14 longballs this month, tied for the 3rd-most of any International League club behind only Gwinnett (17) \& Charlotte (15). OF Josh Lowe has launched 4 longballs this month, which ranks T-5th among IL players. INFs Jonathan Aranda \& Jim Haley, along with C Rene Pinto have each recorded 2 homers this month. Durham has totaled 14 roundtrippers in 11 May matchups after blasting 19 in homers in 23 April contests.

## Lowe Yeah

OF Josh Lowe last night crushed his 3rd homer in a span of 4 games. Going back further, he has gone deep in 4 of his last 7 contests since $5 / 5$. Lowe over his last 4 games has also driven in 2 or more runs in each of his matchups, totaling 11 RBI since $5 / 8$. In that span he ranks T-1st among all International League players in RBI with Gwinnett C Chadwick Tromp, in addition to T-4th among all MiLB players in that period. Lowe has recorded hits in 6 of his last 17 at-bats with Durham after collecting just 1 hit in his 1 st 16 at-bats with the Bulls since being optioned from Tampa Bay at the beginning of this month.

## Hitting Stride

After recording another hit last night, INF Jonathan Aranda ranks 1st among all International League players in hits (46), in addition to 2nd among all MiLB players in that category, trailing only Double-A Midland's Zack Gelof (47). Aranda also enters play today 4th in batting average (.343) \& 7th in total bases (69). He has recorded hits in 8 of his 10 May contests, batting . 409 (18-44) with 9 runs, 2 doubles, 1 triple, 2 homers \& 6 RBI. Going back further, Aranda has hits in 18 of his last 22 games since $4 / 19$, hitting .416 (37-89) with 20 runs, 8 doubles, 1 triple, 4 homers \& 18 RBI along with a 1.122 OPS.

## Miles \& Miles Of $^{\text {F }}$ Hits

INF/OF Miles Mastrobuoni has at least 1 hit in each of his last 6 games dating back to $5 / 6$, batting $.400(8-20)$ with 5 runs, 2 doubles, 1 triple \& 6 RBI along with a 1.138 OPS. Overall this season, he has recorded 1 or more hits in 22 of his 30 games with Durham this season. Mastrobuoni this year when batting with runners in scoring position owns a . 480 average (12-25), the 2nd-best clip in those spots among qualified International League hitters behind only Jacksonville's Charles Leblanc (.484, 15-31). Mastrobuoni has also hit .382 (13-34) when batting with 2 outs, which ranks 7th-best among qualified IL hitters.

## In The Beginning.

The Bulls have allowed 1 or more runs in the 1st inning in 16 of their 34 games this year, and have been outscored 33-20 in the opening frame of their contests in 2022. That includes allowing runs in the 1st inning in 10 of their 16 home tilts, having been outscored 22-7 in those frames. Durham owns an 8-3 record when scoring 1st, compared to a 5-17 clip when allowing their opponent to strike 1st.
