THIS DAY IN NATURALS HISTORY

On August 23, 2015, the Northwest Arkansas Naturals fell to the Corpus Christi Hooks, 9-7 but brought the game close in the ninth inning. With two outs in the ninth, Frank Schwindel pinch-hit for Jorge Bonifacio and connected on a three-run home run on the second pitch he saw, just the fourth (and most recent) pinch-hit home run in Naturals history. Alex Liddi proceeded to double and bring the tying run to the plate, but Northwest Arkansas could not score any more runs. Outfielder Lane Adams came a triple shy of the cycle, with an RBI double in the first, a single in the fourth and solo home run in the sixth.

Saturday Night Special... The Naturals took down the Missions on Saturday night thanks to some tremendous damage avoidance on the bump. Drew Beam got the start and let up 11 hits with a walk, but managed to hold San Antonio to just two runs over his 6.0 innings on the hill. Colton Becker got the Nats on the board in the opening frame with a solo homer, his fifth of the year. The Missions scored in the bottom of the frame to tie the game, and took the lead in the third. The Naturals tied it in the fourth when Spencer Nivens led off with a double and went to third when Omar Hernandez flied out to left. Connor Scott singled to center, plating Nivens to tie the game. NWA got some help in the seventh to take the lead. Justin Johnson doubled to right and went to third on a ground out. With two outs Angel Acosta was hit by a pitch and Igor Gil came out of the bullpen for San Antonio, but the first pitch he threw was wild and Johnson scored to make it a 3-2 game. Brandon Johnson entered for the Naturals on the bump and threw 2.0 shutout innings for a hold, and Dennis Collieran Jr. struck out two in the ninth, holding San Antonio without a hit or a run to secure his fifth save of the year.

Beam Me Up... KC's #20 prospect, Drew Beam, took the hill in last night's 3-2 win over the Missions with the righty looking to stack wins after earning a victory last week in Springfield. He did just that, holding San Antonio to two runs over 6.0 innings of work. Beam tossed another quality start, navigating San Antonio's 11 hits while letting up just one walk. Beam has gone 6.0 innings or more eight times this year, with all qualifying as quality starts.

Vazquez's Dozen... Naturals shortstop Daniel Vazquez has a 12-game on-base streak that he extended on Friday night, going 1-for-5. Vazquez has reached 17 times over the streak, slashing .234/.321/.255. Daniel also has a five-game hit streak dating back to August 16 and has six hits over that stretch. The short-stop has just one extra-base hit over that time, a double from Thursday's contest against the Missions. "Vazqy's" on-base streak is the 10th longest of the season for a Naturals hitter this season, seven behind Luke Pelzer's 19-game streak that came to an end August 14.

Sunday Power... The Naturals haven't had a power shortage on Sundays in 2026, blasting 33 home runs, 13 more than the next closest day. Justin Johnson, Sam Kulasingam, and Connor Scott all lead the team with four Sunday homers this season while Spencer Nivens has clipped three. Carson Roccaforte hit the most this season, the recently promoted outfield left the Nats with five. Eighteen of those long balls came in Sunday games on the road where the Naturals are hitting .291 and have scored 63 runs, one more than their opponents. NWA is 3-5 in Sunday road contests this year.

There's No Place Like Home... Sunday marks the final day of the Naturals two-week road trip, the final long stretch away from Arvest Ballpark this season. The Naturals earned a series split in Springfield and go for the same result Sunday night against the Missions. The Naturals return to Arvest Ballpark on Tuesday for their second and final meeting with the Frisco RoughRiders (AA, Texas Rangers). The two teams haven't met since May 5-10 in a rain-shortened series where the Naturals took three of five games against Frisco at Riders Field.

Monke's Inner Peace... Left-handed reliever Caden Monke has been an elite reliever since August 9 for the Naturals. The southpaw hasn't allowed a run over his four appearances totaling 5.0 innings with just one hit against him. He's struck out six and walked three while throwing 58% strikes. He's also earned two holds in that stretch and left the only runner he's inherited during that time on the bases.

The Royals Family... The Kansas City Royals played the Detroit Tigers earlier this afternoon in the final game of their series. Daniel Lynch IV got the start for the Royals and Nick Loftin homered. KC is off Monday before hitting the road to take on the Toronto Blue Jays at Rogers Centre beginning Tuesday. AAA Omaha has a 5:05 PM CT first pitch in their series finale with the Rochester Red Wings (WSH). RHP Vince Velasquez (1-0) takes the hill for the Storm Chasers this evening. High-A Quad Cities got an early start in their series finale with the Dayton Dragons (CIN) with a 12:05 PM CT first pitch. David Shield went 5.0 innings while holding the Dragons to two runs while striking out six. Low-A Columbia has a 4:05 PM CT first pitch in their series finale with the Augusta GreenJackets (ATL). LHP Darwin Rodriguez takes the bump for the Fireflies this evening.

THIS WEEK IN NATURALS BASEBALL

STARTING PITCHER

#28 GRANT GAMBRELL RHP
(0-2, 5.92 ERA)

Grant Gambrell makes his second start of the week after a no-decision on Tuesday where the righty tossed 5.0 scoreless frames, holding the Missions to four hits and a walk while striking out four. Gambrell joined the Naturals in mid-July, mostly appearing out of the bullpen. Tonight marks his fourth start of the year and third-straight since joining the rotation on August 12.

Reunion... Gambrell returns to the Royals organization after getting drafted in the 2019 MLB Draft by Kansas City. The righty started the 2021 season with High-A Quad Cities and posted a 4.37 ERA over five starts before getting traded to the Boston Red Sox during the campaign. While pitching for Double-A Portland in the 2023 season, Gambrell went 6-3 with a 3.42 ERA with 84 punch outs in 84.1 innings. Gambrell reached Triple-A in 2024, and spent time in the Mexican League and American Association since. Gambrell has reunited with the Royals system and he entered the starting rotation following the All-Star break.

Before the Naturals... Gambrell joined the Naturals in July of 2026, and he hadn't pitched in Minor League Baseball since the 2024 season. The right-hander's most recent start in MiLB prior to signing with the Royals was on July 25, 2024, for the Triple-A Worcester Red Sox against the Scranton-Wilkes-Barre RailRiders. Gambrell dealt six scoreless innings, issued one walk and struck out four batters. He exited with a 1-0 lead, but took a no-decision. In July of 2024, Gambrell went 1-0 with a 1.20 ERA over 15 frames. The righty punched out nine batters, owned a 1.00 WHIP and held opponents to a .173 batting average in the three-game span.

Reign of the Monarch: This season, Gambrell made three starts for the Kansas City Monarchs of the American Association. In those three starts, he went 3-0 with a 2.12 ERA over 17 innings. Gambrell walked just two batters and fanned 14 for Kansas City. The right-hander also pitched for the Monarchs during the 2025 season, going 2-2 with a 4.50 ERA in seven appearances. Gambrell's contract was purchased by the Royals after his stellar start to the season with the Monarchs in 2026.

Beantown... After getting traded to the Red Sox in 2021, Gambrell underwent five surgeries to remove a benign tumor in his heel bone. He missed the entire 2022 season before making his season debut on April 13, 2023, for High-A Greenville. Gambrell was recognized by SoxProspects.com as the Comeback Player of the Year. With three different teams in Boston's system that season, Gambrell combined to go 9-6 with a 3.63 ERA over 23 starts.

National Champ... In 2018, Gambrell and the Oregon State Beavers won the College World Series. Oregon State became the second team in College World Series history to win a championship after losing its first game of the tournament and the first game of the championship series. As a sophomore, Gambrell went 5-1 with a 4.40 ERA and recorded 57 strikeouts over 57.1 frames during that season. Gambrell posted a 2.83 ERA for the Beavers a season later before getting drafted by the Royals.

PERSONAL: Gambrell sports a 44 Pro custom glove while pitching. He's one of a handful of MLB and MiLB players who use a 44 Pro, and Gambrell has the company's Instagram handle promoted on his own IG bio.
