RAKE BURKE

With a pair of home runs on Wednesday, **1B BLAKE BURKE** set the Shuckers new single-season (29) and career (40) home run records.

Burke is **ONE** home run away from joining **3B ANDREW FISCHER** as the second Brewers minor league player since 2001 with a 30-home-run season... Burke would become the 17th player to achieve the feat in Brewers minor league history... Burke would become the 1st Southern League player to achieve the feat since **OF ADAM BRETT WALKER** (CHA) in 2015.

Across 19 games in July, Burke is hitting .347 (25-for-72) with 8 doubles, 11 home runs, 30 RBI, a .449 on-base percentage and a 1.366 OPS.

Burke enters today among the Southern League leaders in home runs (1st, 29), RBI (1st, 84), extra-base hits (1st, 54), OPS (2nd, .981), doubles (T-2nd, 23), hits (T-3rd, 93), average (4th, .278) and on-base percentage (10th, .363).

FROM RAGS TO RICHES

With a multi-home run game on Thursday, **OF JOSIAH RAGSDALE** has recorded 11 home runs in his first 22 Double-A games, including 9 in his last 10 games and at least 1 in 4 straight, tying the Shuckers franchise record... Since his debut on June 30, Ragsdale is tied for the most home runs (11) among Double-A players.

Ragsdale joined teammate **1B BLAKE BURKE** (11) and Blue Wahoos' **OF BRANDON COMPTON** (11) as the 18th Southern League player since 2005 to record 10 home runs in a month... The trio are the first to achieve the feat since **C JOE MACK** (PNS) in June, 2024.

Other notable Southern League players to record 10+ home runs in a month include **3B JUNIOR CAMINERO** (MTG, Aug., 2023), **3B KRIS BRYANT** (TNS, May, 2014) and **OF GIANCARLO STANTON** (JAX, Apr., 2010).

HOMER HAPPY SHUCKERS

With 4 home runs on Thursday night, the Shuckers have hit 23 in their last 6 games and 26 over their last 9... Across 30 games in the second half, the Shuckers have hit 59 home runs, the most in Double-A and the 2nd-most in Minor League Baseball.

The single-season franchise record for home runs is 154, set in 2022... The Shuckers need 29 home runs over the final 39 games of the season to break the record.

GONE FISCH-ING

3B ANDREW FISCHER recorded his 33rd home run of the season on Tuesday, tied with **OF GREG VAUGHN** (1987) for the 6th-most by a Brewers Minor League player in franchise history (since 1970)... His 33 home runs mark the most by a Brewers Minor League hitter since 1987.

Fischer needs 7 home runs over the final 41 games of the season to become the 2nd Brewers Minor League player with a 40 home run season... He would become the first since **CF GORMAN THOMAS** (51) in 1974.

OFFENSE? ALL THE OFFENSE!

Across the 1st 2 games of this week's series between the Shuckers and Biscuits, the teams have combined for 49 runs, 14 doubles, 21 home runs and 36 extra-base hits... This season, Keesler Federal Park is among the most hitter-friendly Double-A ballparks, ranking 2nd in OPS (.824), 3rd in runs per game (11.7), 4th in slugging percentage (.455) and 5th in AB/HR (23.76).

MARK COLEY II REALLY HATES BISCUITS

OF MARK COLEY II recorded his 2nd walk-off hit of the season on Thursday, a 3-run home run to left... In 18 games against the Biscuits, Coley is hitting .304 (14-for-46) with 2 doubles, 3 home runs and 11 RBI... 2 of the 3 home runs have come in extra-innings.

RACING TO A RECORD

The Shuckers enter today with 203 stolen bases, 9 shy of the single-season franchise record (212), set in 2023... 2026 marks the second time in franchise history (since 2015) that a team has recorded at least 200 stolen bases in a season.

BACK IN THE SADDLE

Entering today, **MANAGER MIKE GUERRERO** needs 2 more wins to reach 1,500 in his career... Guerrero's 1,498 career wins are the sixth-most among active managers in Minor League Baseball.

TODAY'S STARTING PITCHER

RHP BRAYLON OWENS (1-1, 6.05) makes his 5th Double-A appearance and 3rd start... Owens has struck out at least 5 batters in all 4 appearances, including 7 in two... Entering today, Owens has limited right-handed batters to a .205 average (9-for-44) with 10 strikeouts.
