### ONCE UPON A TIME ...

Round Rock fell 6-5 on Saturday in a 12-inning game with Salt Lake. In the second inning with 1B Willie Calhoun on third base, CF Bryce Teodosio collected an RBI thanks to an infield hit and Salt Lake led 1-0. In the third, Bees 3B Jack Lopez hit a solo homer to left field and increased the lead to 2-0. In the home-half of the third inning, 1B Dustin Harris doubled and CF Derek Hill sprinted around from first base to score which cut the Bees lead at 2-1. Salt Lake scratched a run across in the fourth. This time, Calhoun doubled and advanced to second on an error. SS Cole Tucker smacked a sacrifice fly to extend the lead to 3-1. In the eighth inning, Express CF Derek Hill tied the game at three. After SS Jax Biggers walked, Hill went deep over the left field fence to tie the game. As the game went to extra innings, neither team scored in the 10th. In the 11th, Salt Lake tacked a run on when Calhoun singled to score the automatic runner from second base, 3B Jack Lopez. In the home-half, C Sam Huff singled home 1B Blaine Crim and tied the game at four. In the 12th, C Zack Humphrevs belted a two-run home run and Salt Lake led 6-4. The E-Train answered with a run in the home-half but that was all as they fell 6-5.

### KING OF THE CASTLE

Round Rock CF Derek Hill posted back-to-back three-hit games as he went 3-for-6 with a double, a home run, two RBI, two runs scored and two strikeouts. In his first 20 games this year, Hill is slashing .365/.402/.605 with eight doubles, a triple, three home runs, seven RBI, 17 runs scored, five walks and 22 strikeouts. He has posted a multi-hit game in five of his last six games that he has played.

#### PRINCES OF THE BULLPEN

Express LHP Danny Duffy, LHP Chasen Shreve and RHP Grant Anderson combined to throw 6.2 innings of scoreless baseball out of the Round Rock bullpen. Duffy went 2.2 innings without a hit with two walks and four strikeouts. Shreve went 2.0 innings with one hit and three strikeouts. Anderson tossed 2.0 innings of one-hit ball with two strikeouts.

#### EXPRESS MANAGER DOUG DAVIS

The 2024 season marks Round Rock Express Manager Doug Davis's second season with the E-Train. In his first season with the Express in 2023, he guided Round Rock to a PCL Second Half title and the club's first playoff appearance since 2019. The team's 89 total wins were the most regular-season wins in franchise history and just the seventh 80-win

campaign in club history. Davis oversaw the longest winning streak in franchise history when the Express won 14 consecutive games last year from August 8-23.

Prior to Round Rock, Davis spent two seasons as the manager for the Scranton Wilkes-Barre RailRiders, the New York Yankees Triple-A affiliate. Davis brings over 25 years of coaching experience to the Express dugout. Since he began coaching in 1995, he has led a minor league team for 10 total seasons and has accumulated a career 673-588 record. He spent the 2003-2004 seasons as the bench coach for the Florida Marlins, where he won the 2003 World Series.



In two seasons as the manager for Scranton Wilkes-Barre, Davis led the RailRiders to a combined record of 158-119. Last season, he helped

the RailRiders to a combined record of 158-119. Last season, he helped oversee a pitching staff that led all Triple-A teams with a 3.89 ERA. Prior to his time as skipper, Davis spent three years in three different roles with Scranton Wilkes-Barre from 2017-2019. In 2017, he was the defensive coach before moving over to bullpen coach in 2018. In 2019, Davis was named the bench coach.

Before joining the New York Yankees organization, Davis spent 11 years in the Toronto Blue Jays system in a variety of roles. Before he was named manager of the RailRiders in 2021, Davis hadn't held a manager title since 2008. He has also been a minor league field coordinator for the Montreal Expos (2001) and Florida Marlins (2002, 2005). His coaching career began in the Yankees system in 1995.

A catcher and infielder in his playing days, Davis was a ninth-round selection by the California Angels in the 1984 MLB Draft. He played professionally for 11 seasons between the Angels, Rangers and Kansas City Royals organizations. He appeared in seven games in the big leagues and tallied six games in 1988 with the Angels, while appearing in one game for the Rangers in 1992. He is a native of Bloomsburg, Pennsylvania.


