**Today:** It's a special Loco Tuesday as the Lansing Lugnuts, the High-A affiliate of the Oakland Athletics, play as their Copa de la Diversión identity, the Lansing Locos, in opening the second leg of a 12-game, 13-day homestand with the first of a six-game series against the South Bend Cubs, High-A affiliate of the Chicago Cubs. Lansing opened the homestand with a six-game split against Dayton.

**Why the Locos:** The Lugnuts chose their Copa identity in translating the fans' "Let's go Nuts!" rallying cry to "¡Vamos Locos!" The potoo bird, as loco as a bird can be, is the logo.

**On the Air:** Jesse Goldberg-Strassler and Adam Jaksa are on StreamGuys, Bally Live and MiLB TV; the iconic **Brendan "BK" King** handles the Cubs' audio call.

**Last Game, Sunday: Lugnuts 10, Dragons 9 (10 innings).** Lansing built leads of 6-1 and 8-5, watched the Dragons rally to tie the game with three runs in the ninth and take the lead on a **Leo Balcazar** RBI single in the tenth, and promptly walked off on **Jonny Butler's** leadoff two-run homer in the bottom of the tenth. The game included a benches-clearing exchange of opinions in the seventh inning.

**On Deck:** Tomorrow is a **Dog Days of Summer**, with dogs welcome to the ballpark, as well as **Grand Slam School Day** with an 11:05 a.m. start!

### LUG NOTES

**Prospecting:** The Nuts' roster includes three MLB Pipeline Top 30 A's prospects in pitcher **Luis Morales** (No. 2), outfielder **Henry Bolte** (No. 12) and first baseman **Will Simpson** (No. 30). Morales was just activated off the Injured List and makes his 2024 Midwest League debut tonight; he is the top pitching prospect in the organization. Bolte, the A's No. 2 outfield prospect, was selected 56th overall in 2022 from Palo Alto High School, where he led all California high schoolers with 13 home runs. Simpson, the A's No. 2 first base prospect, impressed with a .319/ .367/.543 line in his professional debut after he was drafted in the 15th round from Washington last year.

**Where There's a Will, There's a Way:** 1B **Will Simpson** went 3-for-4 with a triple and an intentional walk on Sunday, his third three-hit game in a five-game span. Simpson has reached base in 18 of 19 games and is tied for 1st in the Midwest League in batting average (.375), tied for 2nd in walks (19), 3rd in OBP (.512), 3rd in OPS (1.106) and tied for 5th in total bases (38).

**League Leaderboard, Will Excluded:** **Colby Halter's** 19 walks tie him for 2nd in the league with teammate Simpson. **Brayan Buevas** is 3rd in runs scored (18); and **Henry Bolte** is tied for 4th in stolen bases (9).

**Streaking:** **Jonny Butler** went 2-for-6 on Sunday and has reached base in 14 consecutive games. The longest streak on the team is 17 games, belonging to **Will Simpson**.

**Lighting Up the Scoreboard:** The Lugnuts scored 47 runs in the first inning and now rank 3rd in the Midwest League in runs scored with 121, trailing only the Great Lakes Loons (123) and Wisconsin Timber Rattlers (122). The Nuts are 1st in the league in walks (107), 2nd in the league in base hits (180) behind Wisconsin (185), and 2nd in total bases (176) to Beloit (279).

**Putting the Home in Home Run:** The Lugnuts entered the weekend with only one home run in their first 10 home games before **Cam Masterman** went deep on Saturday and **Euribiel Angeles** and **Jonny Butler** took the roundtrip tour on Sunday.

**A Grand Start:** On April 3, first baseman **Will Simpson** crushed a grand slam (as well as a solo shot) in an 18-0 victory over Michigan State in the Crosstown Showdown. Ten days later, Simpson launched a grand slam off the Great Lakes Loons in an 8-5 loss.

**EMU to The Show:** The Lugnuts' first debuting Major Leaguer this year is 2021 super utilityman **Max Schuemann**, who made his Major League debut on April 12 as a pinch-runner for the Oakland Athletics, scoring the game-winning run in the bottom of the 10th, and followed up on April 20 with a solo home run for his first MLB hit (in a 6-3 A's loss at Cleveland).

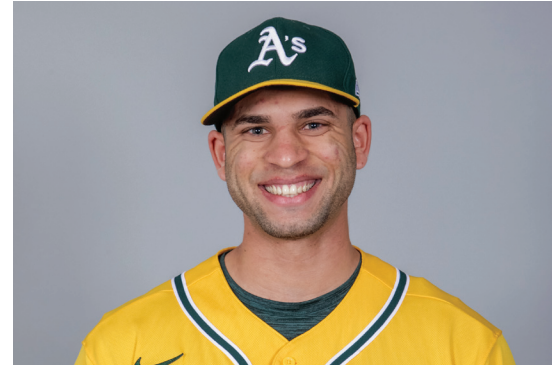
**2022:** Jeff Criswell came three outs from a no-hitter, settling for a one-hitter in a doubleheader split at Lake County's Classic Park.

**2023 Retrospective:** Added to the Lansing roster from Stockton on August 30, 2023, becoming the 922nd Lugnut in franchise history, the 15th different starting pitcher for Lansing this season and the 51st different player used... signing bonus of \$3 million broke the record given to Sandy Gaston by Tampa Bay in 2018 (\$2.61m)... declared a free agent on August 25, 2022... signed on the first day of the international signing period, January 15, 2023.

**Prospecting:** Morales is ranked the A's no. 2 prospect by MLB Pipeline, which grades his fastball at 60, his curve at 50, his slider at 55, his change at 50 and his control at 50.

They write, "Morales was billed as the consensus top pitching prospect of the 2023 international signing period when he signed for \$3 million with the A's in January that year. After setting a U-18 record for strikeouts with 161 across 82 2/3 innings between 2019-20 in Cuba's Serie Nacional, he defected in 2021 to Mexico, where he trained with Maels Rodríguez, a former Cuban National team pitcher and Olympian who regularly threw 100 mph fastballs. Initially expected to pitch solely in the Dominican Summer League for his introduction to pro ball, his excellent performance earned him stops at four different levels. He finished the year at High-A Lansing, combining for a 2.86 ERA with 53 strikeouts in 44 innings.

Morales' whip-like delivery produces an electric fastball that sits around 94-97 mph and can reach up to 99. His four-pitch mix also includes a slider, a changeup and a curveball, all of which appeared to be quality secondary pitches as he rapidly ascended through the Minors in his debut season.

Adding about 10 pounds of muscle to his 6-foot-3 frame in preparation for his first full season as a pro, Morales will see his durability tested as he looks to navigate the rigors of pitching. While his command was solid upon joining the A's, he has struggled with controlling his pitches in the past. If he can keep that control steady, he has a chance to make another significant jump through the system in 2024, with enough potential to evolve into a frontline starter in the future."

**Path to Lansing:** Luis opened the 2023 season in the Dominican Summer League, making his professional debut on June 6 with 1 2/3 hitless innings vs. DSL Astros Blue, striking out three... struck out six batters in three one-hit innings on June 20... struck out five batters in four one-hit innings on June 27... made four appearances in DSL before he was promoted to the Arizona Complex League Athletics on July 2, debuting on July 4 with three innings, allowing one run with three strikeouts vs. D-Backs Black... made three starts in AzCL before he was promoted to the Stockton Ports on July 24, debuting on July 28 with three one-hit innings and five strikeouts vs. Lake Elsinore... in last of five California League starts, tossed four two-hit scoreless innings at Fresno on August 25... promoted to Lansing on August 30, his fourth different stop along the ladder... innings high: 4 IP, 2x; strikeouts high: 6, 6/20.

**2023 Lugnuts Debut:** Started vs. West Michigan at home on September 1... tossed 3 2/3 IP, 5 H, 3 R, 1 BB, 4 K, allowing 2 HR... 59 pitches, 35 strikes... fastball touched 99 mph... in 1st inning, struck out Seth Stephenson and Luke Gold while pitching around a single to Gage Workman (stranded at third)... in 2nd inning, allowed two-out, first-pitch solo HR to RF from Izaak Pacheco... in 3rd inning, allowed one-out, first-pitch solo HR to RF from Gage Workman... in 4th inning, departed with two outs and runners at 1st and 2nd base; reliever Jake Garland allowed RBI single, bringing in one inherited runner, before ending the inning with the score tied 3-3... Garland kept the game tied by blanking the Whitecaps until the 9th, when West Michigan plated two runs against him for a 5-3 victory.

**Home Cooking:** Born in Barquisimeto in the state of Lara, where former Lugnut and current Diamondbacks catcher Gabby Moreno was also born... cousin is Carlos "Cookie" Carrasco, in his 15th year in the Major Leagues and a current member of the Cleveland Guardians rotation; Carlos Carrasco led the Majors in victories (18) in 2017 and finished 4th in A.L. Cy Young voting.

**Minor League Path:** Signed at age 16 by Ruben Barradas in 2018... debuted on June 19, 2019, in the Arizona League... following the canceled season of 2020, split 2021 between the Arizona Complex League and the California League, working out of the Stockton bullpen... repeated in the AzCL and Cal League in 2022... spent all of 2023 pitching for Stockton... tossed six innings for the Ports on four different occasions, finishing the season with six shutout five-hit innings on September 7 at San Jose, with no walks and nine strikeouts... posted 6.57 home ERA in Stockton, 3.12 ERA on the road.
