Playoff Picture: The Somerset Patriots currently own the best record in the Double-A Northeast League with two games left in the regular season. They are 0.5 games up on the Bowie Baysox and 1.0 game up on the Akron RubberDucks. The Portland Sea Dogs were eliminated from playoff contention Thursday night. Somerset needs to win just one of its final two games to clinch a playoff berth, meaning a win tonight gets them into the playoffs. If the Patriots are to win its final two games, it would clinch the No. 1 seed in the postseason. Should Somerset drop both games, they would need Bowie to also lose out to get in.

Kings of the North: With Somerset's win Thursday night over Akron, the Patriots clinched the 2021 Northeast Division Championship. It marks the team's first title under its new affiliation with the New York Yankees, and overall the team's 11th division championship in franchise history. Somerset's last division championship came as the 2015 Liberty Division champs in the independent Atlantic League

Road Warriors: Somerset is playing 14 of its final 18 games of the regular season on the road, including two relocated games from Bridgewater to Hartford, Conn. due to flooding caused by Tropical Storm Ida. The Patriots are 35-23 away from TD Bank Ballpark this season.

Hey Hayden: RHP Hayden Wesneski tossed seven shutout innings with three hits, no walks, and eight strikeouts in last night's 2-0 shutout win. Wesneski has now 12.2 consecutive innings without allowing a run. The right-hander is 3-0 with a 1.35 ERA (3 ER over 20.0 IP) with just two walks and 32 strikeouts across three starts in September. Additionally, the Patriots have won each of Wesneski's last 10 starts dating back to July 23rd. Over that stretch, the Texas native is 7-0 with a 2.48 ERA and 70 strikeouts against 14 walks over 58.0 innings pitched. He now owns a 1.86 ERA across eight starts since the beginning of August.

Home Run Happy: The Patriots hit four home runs Thursday night and have now hit eight longballs over the first four games of the season. Somerset has now hit 18 home runs over its last seven games. The Patriots have 172 home runs on the season - most in all of Double-A baseball. The team is now two home runs shy of tying a single-season record, set back in 2008 (174).

King Dermis: Dermis Garcia hit his league-leading 30th home run Thursday night. He is just the third player in franchise history to hit 30 home runs in a season, tying the single-season record set by Brandon Larson and Josh Pressley in 2008. Additionally, Garcia leads all current Yankees farmhands, leads all of Double-A, and is tied for sixth in all of MiLB in home runs. He is the first Yankee minor leaguer to hit 30 homers in a season since Peter O'Brien hit 33 in 102 games between Tampa (A+) and Trenton (AA) in 2014.

Count on Cabrera: INF Oswaldo Cabrera went 1-for-4 Friday and has reached base safely in seven-straight games. Cabrera's 23 home runs this season have surpassed his career total of 22 home runs over his first four pro seasons. He currently leads the league in hits (110), RBI (76), total bases (210) and extra-base hits (53), while ranking third in home runs (23). Additionally, Cabrera is the only player in the AANE to have 20+ home runs and stolen bases, and one of just two Yankees' minor leaguers to do so (Anthony Volpe).

Locked and Loaded: Brandon Lockridge is currently riding a 11-game on-base streak since Sept. 5th. Over this stretch, Lockridge is hitting .364 with two HR, nine RBI, 11 runs, five steals, six walks and a .457 OBP.

Arms Race: Somerset's pitching staff owns the lowest ERA (3.37) and most shutouts (17) across all MiLB levels. The team also ranks second in WHIP (1.16) and BAA (.212), and lists third in strikeouts (1,289).

'Pen Pals: The Patriots' bullpen has tossed 8.1 consecutive scoreless innings of its last three games. They have allowed five earned runs over the last 46.0 IP (0.98 ERA) taking away Tuesday's rough outing. Even with Tuesday included, the bullepn still owns a 2.02 ERA (11 ER over 79 IP) in its last 14 games. The 'pen still owns the lowest bullpen ERA (2.84), WHIP (1.11) and BAA (.198) in all of Minor League Baseball.
