Today: It's Game 4 of a 12-game, 13-day homestand, with the Lansing Lugnuts, the High-A affiliate of the Oakland Athletics, looking for a fourth straight win in a six-game series against the Quad Cities River Bandits, the High-A affiliate of the Kansas City Royals. Tonight is a Dollar Deal Day, with \$1 specials at the concession stands.

Starting Matchup: Right-hander Joelvis Del Rosario, the first selection in the minor league portion of the 2022 Rule 5 Draft from Pittsburgh and the Lugnuts' 2023 Opening Day starter, makes his team-leading fourth start. Quad Cities counters with right-hander Champlain, making his fourth start of the season. Champlain was originally the Yankees' ninth-round selection in 2021 from USC, traded to the Royals with T.J. Sikkema and Beck Way for Andrew Benintendi on July 27, 2022.

Last Night: Lugnuts 6, River Bandits 5 (10 innings). In front of 5,955 fans, Daniel Susac drilled a two-out, two-strike, two-run triple off the glove of Gavin Cross and the center field wall, lifting the Nuts to a second walk-off win over the Bandits in a three-day span. Susac finished the game 3-for-5 with four RBIs. Lansing starter Mitch Myers tossed his first quality start of the year, allowing two runs in six innings.

On Deck: Tomorrow, the Lugnuts play for the first time this year as their Copa identity, the Lansing Locos!

#### Lug•Notes

Brisk Baseball: On Wednesday, the Nuts blanked the River Bandits, 5-0, in an hour and 58 minutes. Last night, Lansing and Quad Cities went extra innings... and still finished the game in a scant two hours and 25 minutes.

Streaking: OF Caeden Trenkle went 1-for-5 with a single last night, and has reached base in all 15 games he has played this year. OF Lazaro Armenteros went 2-for-5 with an RBI double yesterday and has hit safely in his last seven games (11-for-25, .400) and reached base in his last nine games.

Laz-er Show: Armenteros leads the league with six home runs, an .810 slugging percentage and 1,230 OPS, and is third with 34 total bases.

Other Nuts Among the League Leaders: Jonny Butler is tied for first in triples (3), Jack Winkler is tied for second in doubles (6), and Caeden Trenkle is tied for fourth in runs scored (12).

Winning Form: Last week, the Lugnuts were walked off in two straight games at Lake County; this week, they've walked off the River Bandits twice in the last three nights (accomplished coincidentally by identical 6-5 tenth-inning scores).

Hoosier Cannonball: Jack Perkins, who blanked the River Bandits in the opener through 5 1/3 innings, is second in the league in WHIP (0.78), tied for third in ERA (0.59) and third in opponent batting average (.132)

Starting Strong: The Nuts' rotation has an ERA of 2.93 this year, bolstered by three straight strong starts against Quad Cities. On Tuesday, the aforementioned Perkins tossed 5 1/3 scoreless innings. On Wednesday, Christian Fernandez fired six one-hit scoreless innings. And last night, Mitch Myers turned in the Nuts' second straight quality start, allowing two runs in six innings. All told, Nuts starters have allowed two runs in 17 1/3 innings during this series.

Two's a Charm: The Lugnuts lead the league with 19 double plays turned, including at least one double play in 13 of their 17 games, two last night.

First-Round Pediarees: The Lugnuts' roster boasts the A's last two first-round selections, 20-year-old Max Muncy was the 25th overall selection in the 2021 draft and enters the season ranked the A's No. 1 shortstop prospect by MLB Pipeline. 21-year-old Daniel Susac was taken 19th overall in 2022 and is the A's No. 2 catching prospect behind 1B/C Tyler Soderstrom.

They Know Their Trade: Lansing has four players acquired by the Oakland Athletics via trade on its roster: Christian Fernandez (Tampa Bay Rays, 7/9/22, for Christian Bethancourt), Euribiel Ángeles (San Diego Padres, 4/3/22, for Sean Manaea); Junior Pérez (San Diego Padres, 6/30/20, for Jorge Mateo); and Alexander Campos (Seattle Mariners, 11/15/17, for Ryon Healy).

#### **TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY**

**2008:** CBrad Mills struck out 11 Quad Cities River Bandits in just 4 2/3 innings, but Justin Roberson capped a two-run rally in the bottom of the 9th with a game-winning RBI single, pushing the Bandits to a 4-3 victory. It was the second straight game that the Lugnuts had been walked off. The game was played at Veteran Memorial Stadium in Cedar Rapids due to flooding in Davenport, with the next two games held in Clinton and Iowa City.

**2011:** During warm-ups before the start of the third inning in Game 2 of a doubleheader Lugnuts 3B Bryson Namba, taking grounders, got into a fight with Whitecaps pitcher Bruce Rondon, in the dugout. Both players were ejected. The Lugnuts swept the doubleheader, 4-0 and 4-2.

The King: First name is pronounced "yo-elvis," with the emphasis on the middle syllable... one other Joelvis played professional baseball, Joelvis Gonzalez, a Twins prospect from Venezuela in 2006-07 who hit .270 in 79 games but never made it higher than rookie ball.

Path Through the Pros: After signing at age 16, Del Rosario debuted as a reliever in 2018 in the Dominican Summer League before converting to a starter in the DSL in 2019, tossing 5 2/3 innings at most... made United States debut in 2021 in Florida Complex League; twirled five hitless innings in second start, July 5, striking out seven Orioles and walking one... made full-season debut with Bradenton in 2022, posting three six-inning starts in a four-start span in June; allowed .248 avg. to right-handers compared to .299 to lefties; runners stole six bases in 10 attempts; outstanding in the first inning, limiting opposition to .191/.295/.353 splits; far better on the road (2.95 ERA in 55 IP) than at home (4.74 in 38 IP).

Joining the Athletics: Del Rosario was the first overall selection of the 2022 MiLB portion of the Rule 5 Draft... in the Major League portion, the A's had selected 2018 Lugnut Ryan Noda from the Dodgers with the second overall pick; Noda debuted in the Majors on his birthday on March 30th and has already launched his first MLB home run... Del Rosario was one of a staggering 11 Pittsburgh Pirates prospects to be selected in the Rule 5 MiLB portion after two Pirates prospects, Jose Hernandez and Blake Sabol, were taken consecutively (3rd and 4th) in the MLB portion.

A Taste of the Cactus League: Del Rosario appeared in one Spring Training game for the A's, pitching well initially before bowing out having allowed four runs on four hits and three walks in 2 2/3 innings, striking out four, hitting one and tossing a wild pitch.
