#### INDY BITS

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Indianapolis Indians offense thrived as Ji Hwan Bae recorded two hits and a career-high tying five RBI in a 9-6 win over the Louisville Bats at Louisville Slugger Field on Thursday evening. With the game scoreless in the third, Indianapolis recorded its first baserunners on singles from Billy McKinney and Andrés Alvarez, leading into a three-run home run by Bae off Brett Kennedy to give Indy an early lead. Louisville responded in the following inning with two runs courtesy of an RBI single by Edwin Ríos and a run-scoring wild pitch from Connor Sadzeck. In the fifth, McKinney and Canaan Smith-Njigba recorded back-to-back singles before Alvarez roped a two-run double to right field to extend Indy's lead. In the bottom half of the inning, the Bats took one run back when Blake Dunn scored on a Livan Soto double. In response, Indianapolis padded its lead with four additional runs on four base hits in the sixth and seventh, the three-run sixth highlighted by a Bae two-run single. Louisville managed to tally two runs in the sixth, courtesy of a Peyton Burdick two-run blast. Malcom Nuñez singled in the seventh to score Henry Davis while Louisville continued to claw back in the eighth on a Nick Martini solo homer.

BAE'S BLAST: Ji Hwan Bae launched a three-run home run in the top of the third inning last night to give the Indians a lead they would not relinquish for their first win of the season. With the Indians leading by two in the sixth, Bae capped a three-run frame with a two-run single to add insurance runs. In the game, he went 2-for-5 with the home run and a career-high tying five RBI for the first time since 8/22/19 with Single-A Greensboro at Delmarva. The two-hit performance was his ninth of the season in 18 games with Indianapolis, and in total he owns a .362 batting average (25-for-69), 18 runs, five extra-base hits, 11 RBI and a .998 OPS. Since his season debut on 4/9, he leads International League hitters with a .476 on-base percentage and ranks among leaders in batting average (2nd) and OPS (10th).

FRANZUA TAKES THE BUMP: Southpaw Geronimo Franzua made his first start with Indianapolis and 22nd in affiliated baseball last night to begin a bullpen game for Indianapolis at Louisville. He tossed 3.0 one-hit innings with one walk and four strikeouts, exiting with a three-run lead that the Indians would not relinquish. Prior to last night, Franzua made his last start with FCL Pirates on 6/6/23, his first appearance after spending 10 years playing in Japan. He appeared with DSL Astros from 2011-13 and made 20 starts in 37 appearances. In his career as a starter in affiliated baseball, he is 1-9 with a 4.42 ERA (36er/73.1jp) and 59 strikeouts.

JAKE ON BASE: Jake Lamb went 0-for-4 with a walk and run last night at Louisville, snapping his nine-game hitting streak since 4/25 but extending his on-base streak to 15 games since 4/18. During his on-base streak, he is hitting .400 (20-for-50) with 10 runs, seven doubles, one home run, 12 RBI, .469 on-base percentage and 1.069 OPS. He has now reached base safely in 26 of 27 games this season and leads the International League in batting average (.371, 33-for-89) while also ranking third in on-base percentage (.459) and seventh in OPS (1.021).

**QUIT HITTIN' HENRY:** Catcher Henry Davis, was hit by a career-high 20 pitches during his 2022 campaign with FCL Pirates, Single-A Bradenton, High-A Greensboro and Double-A Altoona, has been hit four times in three games with Indianapolis this season after being hit once in 23 games with Pittsburgh. Despite being held hitless last night at Louisville, he scored a run while being hit by two pitches. Louisville's pitching staff has racked up 34 hit batters this season, the most out of all 30 Triple-A teams and second-most in Minor League Baseball behind High-A Modesto (40).

**WELCOME HOME:** University of Louisville product Henry Davis returns to his college town for the first time during his professional career this week. Davis began the season on the Pirates' Opening Day roster and hit .162 (11-for-68) with seven runs, three doubles and four RBI in 23 games with the big-league club before being optioned last week. In 14 Triple-A games with Indy last season, he hit .375 (18-for-48) with seven runs, six extra-base hits, a .516 on-base percentage and 1.120 OPS. He was the first baseball player from Louisville to be selected first overall and the fourth student-athlete taken No. 1 overall from the school regardless of sport.

**TONIGHT:** The Indians will look to tie up the six-game series at Louisville tonight at 7:15 PM at Louisville Slugger Field. The Bats took two of three meetings during the opening series between the two teams from 3/29-3/31 and lead the season series, 4-2. Continuing the series for the Indians today is RHP Wily Peralta (1-0, 5.21), who pitched on Tuesday and recorded two outs to end an inning. Countering for Louisville is RHP Randy Wynne (0-0, 0.00), who has faced Indianapolis seven times (four starts) since 2022 with a 0-4 record, 8.55 ERA (19er/20.0ip) and 15 strikeouts.

**NEWBIES:** Outfielder Matt Fraizer and right-handed pitcher Isaac Mattson were promoted from Double-A Altoona on Tuesday ahead of Indianapolis' series-opener at Louisville. Fraizer is set to make his Triple-A debut after spending the last two seasons with the Curve. Mattson was signed by Pittsburgh as a minor league free agent in the offseason and owns a career 1-2 record. 5.89 ERA (29er/44.1ip) and 57 strikeouts in 42 Triple-A appearances.

THIS DATE IN 1984: Mike Stenhouse recorded the fourth three-homer game in franchise history vs. Evansville at Bush Stadium. In a 17-4 victory for the Indians, Stenhouse went 3-for-5 with a team-leading eight RBI. Ron Johnson hit a home run of his own, going 4-for-4 with two RBI and five runs scored. Right-hander Greg Bargar went the distance and struck out 11 batters to earn the win. Stenhouse spent 27 games with Indianapolis in 1984, hitting .333 (31-for-93) with eight home runs and 27 RBI.
