### TONIGHT'S GAME

The Round Rock Express and Sugar Land Space Cowboys (Houston Astros affiliate) meet for game three of their six-game series at Constellation Field after Tuesday night's game was postponed due to rain. The two teams last faced off in a Thursday doubleheader. In game one, Round Rock struck first before Sugar Land briefly took the lead. The Express tied it in the sixth on an RBI single by Michael Helman, then pulled away in extra innings with RBI singles from Justin Foscoe and Trevor Hauver to secure a 5-3 win. In game two, Round Rock erupted for seven runs in the third inning. Sugar Land responded with four runs in the fourth, but the Express added three more in the sixth behind RBI singles from Helman and Richie Martin. Cam Cauley contributed two runs with a homer in the seventh as Round Rock closed out a 12-5 victory to complete the doubleheader sweep.

### RICHIE'S ROLLING

INF Richie Martin went 4-for-7 with two RBIs, two runs scored and two stolen bases in two games on Thursday. With hits in both games of the doubleheader, Martin now owns a six-game hitting streak, dating back to April 14. During the streak, he's slashing .391/.417/.696/1.113 with four doubles, a home run, six RBIs, four runs scored, five strikeouts and one walk. He also leads the Express with seven stolen bases. Since joining Round Rock on May 24, 2025, Martin is tied for fourth among Pacific Coast League base stealers (33).

### WALKING AWAY

E-Train hitters reached base 21 times via walks in the doubleheader on Thursday. The Express walked 11 times in the first game and followed with 10 in the second game. The last time the Express walked 20 or more times over two games was on April 18-19, 2023, at Sacramento, where they drew 22 walks. Round Rock ranks second in the PCL in walks (133) and owns the highest walk rate in the league (14.8%).

### IN A GROOVE

Round Rock is 6-2 in their last eight games. Over that span, the Express have scored 42 runs while holding opponents to 30 runs (+12). In the last 10 games, they are fourth in the PCL and 7th in Triple-A in runs (69) while they are second in walks (73) and OBP (.411) at the Triple-A level while owning the ninth fewest number of strikeouts (90) in that stretch.

### CAM CONTROL

In yesterday's doubleheader, INF Cam Cauley went 3-for-6 with a home run, four RBIs, three runs and four walks. Over his last seven games, Cauley is hitting .368 (.7-19)/.586/.684 with two home runs, seven RBIs and 10 walks. Seven of the 15 balls he put in play during that span reached over 95 mph. Cauley is also tied with INF Jonah Bride for the team lead in walks (18). His 20.5% walk rate ranks third amongst PCL hitters this season (min. 75 PA).

### ON THIS DAY IN NOLAN RYAN HISTORY - WEDNESDAY, APRIL 24, 1985

38-year-old Nolan Ryan took a no-hitter into the seventh inning. With one out, Dave Parker singled to center and ended the bid for his sixth no-no. The Reds scratched three off Ryan in the inning as Deer Park native Duane Walker hit a two-run homer and an error allowed another run to score and it was 3-1.

Ryan got the loss despite 8.0 innings with three runs, two earned, one walk and seven strikeouts. Player-Manager Pete Rose inserted Walker into the lineup because of his history with Ryan. "He started today because he hit two home runs off Ryan last year. Then he struck out seven straight times against him. But that's still two for nine and two home runs against Ryan and that's good enough for me." The Astros struck for two in the bottom of the eighth to tie the game when Jose Cruz drove in two with a single. The Reds scored five runs in the ninth to run away with it. Rose went 1-for-5 with an RBI while Dave Concepcion homered and went 1-for-3.

Rose's left hit him just 81 away from Ty Cobb as he sat at 4,110 for his career. Mario Soto earned the win for Cincinnati and improved to 4-1. Through the first six frames, Ryan faced only 19 Reds - he walked Concepcion in the second. In the seventh, eighth and ninth inning, 20 Reds came to the plate. "Nolan looked like he really did have no-hitter stuff. All he needed was nine more outs. He looked like he had the stuff to get it," Astros Manager Bob Lillis said postgame.
