Longest Win Streak Longest Losing Streak **AUSTIN MARTIN HITS FIRST CAREER HR IN 9-3 LOSS:** Despite the first career home run from top prospect Austin Martin and the third blast of the year from LJ Talley, the Fisher Cats were out-homered by the Rumble Ponies in a 9-3 loss on Thursday night at Delta Dental Stadium. Binghamton hit four home runs on the night, including two by lead-off hitter Carlos Cortes, who went 4-for-5 with 5 RBI. The Fisher Cats have dropped four straight games.

**MARTIN MAKING STRIDES:** With just 97 plate appearances as a pro, Austin Martin has upped his batting average to .278, and has a .402 OBP. He has 22 hits in 22 games, with five doubles, a triple, a homer. He also has walked 12 times. Martin has made 10 starts at shortstop (3 errors), and 12 starts in center field (3 assists) for the Fisher Cats. Martin was drafted by the Blue Jays in the first round (5<sup>th</sup> overall) in 2020. He has now reached safely in eight consecutive games—and 21 of his first 22 games.

**BACK END OF BULLPEN SOLID:** Connor Law threw two hitless innings in relief last night with four strikeouts and Jon Harris worked around a walk in the top of the ninth. The four strikeouts were a season-high for Law. Harris has not allowed a run in his last five outings – after giving up solo homers in his first appearances of 2021. Last night also marked the season debut for RHP Sean Rackoski, who yielded a two-run homer to Binghamton's Desmond Lindsay in his two innings of work.

**BOB LIPMAN'S** *THIS DATE IN FISHER CATS HISTORY*: June 4, 2019---Nate Pearson, Willy Ortiz, Jake Fishman, and Ty Tice combined on a four-hitter as the Fisher Cats opened a series with the Bowie Bay Sox with a 3-0 win at Delta Dental Stadium. Pearson worked two perfect innings with three strikeouts before giving way to Ortiz. Ortiz allowed two hits and had four strikeouts in five innings to earn his first win. Santiago Espinal had RBI singles in each of the first two innings.

**MANCHESTER BOSTON REGIONAL AIRPORT FLIGHT TO THE MAJORS:** The Blue Jays were off on Thursday and will open a series in Buffalo with the Astros tonight. Vladimir Guerrero Jr. is hitting .335 in 54 games with 17 homers (T1st) and 45 RBI (2<sup>nd</sup>). He has a .440 OBP (1<sup>st</sup>) and 1.105 OPS (1<sup>st</sup>)...The Triple-A Bisons were rained out last night in Trenton with Syracuse. The teams play a doubleheader today starting at 5pm. Vancouver won 7-5 over Eugene...Bradenton 9 Dunedin 7.

**COMING UP:** The Fisher Cats get their first look at Binghamton (New York Mets) this week before heading to face a familiar foe, the Portland Sea Dogs, next week.

**ROSTER MOVES:** June 3: RHP Sean Rackoski activated from IL. June 2: RHP Willy Gaston transferred to Adv. A Vancouver.

**ON THE HILL:** LHP Zach Logue makes his sixth start of the season. Comes off back-to-back quality starts, including last Saturday at Somerset. Logue went six in New Hampshire's 6-1 win over the Patriots, with a career-high 12 strikeouts. He has a 0.77 WHIP, which is the fifth lowest in all of Double-A. He has a chance to become the second four-game winner in the Double-A Northeast League (Matt Frisbee, RIC).

Binghamton seeks its fourth consecutive win in the series with Adam Oller on the mound. The 26-year old RHP was originally drafted by the Pirates in the 20<sup>th</sup> round of the 2016 draft (Northwestern State -La.). After Giants signed him to a deal for 2019 after his release, and the Mets picked him up for this year. This is his first season at Double-A, and he's looking for his first win in what will be his sixth start.
