Home After the Break

The Fightin Phils return home from the All-Star Break to begin a three-game series against the Altoona Curve, Double-A affiliate of the Pittsburgh Pirates. It is the eighth-of-nine matchups between the teams this season and second-of-three at FirstEnergy Stadium in Reading. This weekend's series marks the first time that Altoona is at Reading since Apr. 25-30 of the 2023 season. Since then Reading has been to Altoona three times (2023, '25 and '26). Reading currently leads the season-series 4-3 after taking four-of-six at Altoona from June 23-28, and then dropping last night's contest.

Curve Takes Battle of the Bullpens

The Reading Fightin Phils (11-8, 41-47) fell 6-2 against the Altoona Curve (8-11, 39-49) on Friday night. Raider Tello led all Fightins batters, accounting for two of the teams five hits while swatting home both runs on a two-RBI single in the fourth inning. Reading starter Luke Russo took the loss in a day with mixed results, as the righty tossed 5.1 innings while allowing three runs on five hits with five punchouts. The Fightins bullpen allowed three more runs in a game where Altoona managed to pull away late. The Curve bullpen used a five-inning joint effort to hold the R-Phils scoreless after the fourth inning, relinquishing just one hit and one walk while striking out two. The Fightin Phils still sit in a three-way tie for first place in the Eastern League-Northeast second half standings, as they are 11-8 along with Portland and New Hampshire.

R-Phils in the Futures Game

Fightin Phils pitchers Gage Wood and Wen-Hui Pan both participated in the All-Star Futures Game last Sunday at Citizens Bank Park in Philadelphia. Wood started the game for the National League and allowed a run on a hit over one inning of work, while Pan surrendered two runs, and struck out one, over one-third of an inning on the mound. Pan re-joins the Fightin Phils bullpen on Friday night and Wood is scheduled to make his next start for Reading on Sunday. It marked the first Futures Game appearance for both players. Wood, the Phillies' 2025 first-round pick out of Arkansas, has posted a 3.44 ERA with 79 strikeouts over 55.0 innings in 16 starts between Clearwater and Reading this season. Pan, who joined the Fightins on June 13 after beginning the year on the injured list, owns a 2.81 ERA with 30 strikeouts in 25.2 innings and is a perfect 4-for-4 in save opportunities. The duo joins recent Reading representatives Mick Abel, Justin Crawford and Aidan Miller in the annual showcase of baseball's top prospects.

Happy Semi Saturday!

Saturday night's starter is the left-handed pitcher in Adam Seminaris, a veteran who has his name littered across the Eastern League leaderboards. Seminaris paces the league in earned run average (2.65), strikeouts (103), wins (8) and innings pitched (85.0). He is also second in WHIP (1.12) and eighth in opponent batting average. The 5th round pick from the 2020 draft (LAA) eclipsed 500 career MiLB strikeouts earlier this year, and he dazzled yet again in his most recent start on July 11. The southpaw tossed six innings of two-run ball while walking one and striking out nine in a win over the Somerset Patriots. This was the third time in the 2026 season that Seminaris has fanned at least nine hitters.

Binelas Bashes

Alex Binelas launched his team-leading 19th home run of the season last Thursday night, a ball that traveled an estimated 488 feet to center field. Binelas now ranks as tied for second in the Eastern League in home runs, but is tied amongst all active members of the league for the most homers, as current leader Garrett Martin (21 home runs) was recently promoted to Triple-A. Binelas is also second to Felix Reyes for the most home runs amongst Phillies Minor Leaguers. Binelas recently saw his 23-game on-base streak come to an end last Friday, a mark that was second-longest by a Fightin Phil this season and tied for sixth most in the Eastern League in 2026. Over the streak, that dated back to June 7, Binelas slashed .341/.437/.705 (1.142 OPS), along with 22 runs, eight doubles, eight home runs and 17 RBI. Binelas also set a new career-high with four runs scored in last Thursday night's win and followed that up with a double, triple and three runs scored last Friday night.

Raking Raylin

Raylin Heredia's season-best 14-game hit streak came to an end last Friday night. Over his 14-game hit streak, dating back to June 24, Heredia slashed .348/.377/.636 (1.013 OPS), along with 14 runs, four doubles, five home runs and 10 RBI. Over the hit streak, Heredia had multiple hits in six of the games, which included four contests in a row from June 26-30, along with a season-high (tied career-high) four hits on July 5 vs New Hampshire.

Hammering Homers

Last week's series featured the two teams that have hit the most home runs in the Eastern League this season in Somerset (126) and Reading (115). The Fightin Phils are currently on pace for 182 long balls, which comes after they hit 118 last season. Alex Binelas leads Reading with 19 home runs, and Raylin Heredia is shortly behind him with 17. Four different Fightins hitters have slugged at least 10 homers, with Bryson Ware (13) and Bryan Rincon (12) being the other two. The last time a Fightin Phils slugged 20 home runs in a season was Carlos De La Cruz (24) and Oliver Dunn (21) in 2023.

This Day in Baseballtown History

June 18, 2021: At Harrisburg, starting pitcher Jack Perkins takes the mound for just the second time in his Double-A career, and pitched six quality innings for the winning effort. He allowed just four hits and two walks in a shutout effort, striking out five. Perkins also showed the Senator's offense what they were supposed to do, as he launched his first homerun of the season in his first at bat. In his first three at bats in Double-A, Perkins now had a homerun and a triple to his name.

Here Come the Curve

Altoona enters play today with a 39-49 overall record and an 8-11 mark in the second half, which is fifth in the Eastern League's Southwest Division. The Curve were at home against Richmond the week prior to the All-Star Break and split a six-game series. Following this week, Altoona stays on the road and heads to Akron. The Curve's roster has four of the Pirates top-30 prospects: Murf Gray (17), Duce Gourson (26), Callan Moss (28) and Lonnie White Jr. (30).

Stumbo Toes The Rubber

Curve righty Peyton Stumbo will take the mound for game two of this three-game set. Stumbo holds a 1-8 record with a 5.84 earned run average this year. He was a 20th round pick in the 2023 MLB Draft.
