#### INDY BITS

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: Joshua Palacios logged four hits and three RBI as the Indianapolis Indians were defeated by the Rochester Red Wings on Friday evening at Innovative Field, 14-7. With Indianapolis leading 3-0 after two RBI singles courtesy of Malcom Nuñez and Palacios, Rochester quickly responded. Following a one-out throwing error by Luis Cessa to score the first run, the Red Wings took advantage with eight additional runs, all unearned on Cessa's line. The frame was highlighted by a grand slam from Trey Lipscomb. In the third, Seth Beer crushed a two-run line drive single to right field off a Spenser Watkins sinker as the Indians started to cut away at the lead. The Red Wings tacked on four runs between the fifth and sixth innings courtesy of RBI doubles from Carter Kieboom, Darren Baker and James Wood. They added another insurance run in the eighth inning, plating Dylan Crews for the fourth time to cap their scoring.

**FOURTEEN:** The Indians were outhit by Rochester 17-14 in yesterday's loss. It was the first time the Indians have had at least 14 hits in a losing effort since Sept. 10, 2022, at Omaha when they outhit the Storm Chasers 14-10 but lost 9-6. The Indians lost three contests during the 2022 season while tallying at least 14 hits, also on July 3 at Nashville (L, 7-4) and April 16 at St. Paul (L, 16-13).

JP FOR FOUR: Joshua Palacios led the Indians offense yesterday, going 4-for-5 with two runs, a double and three RBI, setting season-highs in hits and RBI with the performance. It was his fourth career-high four-hit game, the last coming in just his second big-league game on April 10, 2021, with Toronto vs. Los Angeles (AL). In that contest, he became the second player in American League history with four-plus hits and four-plus runs in one of his first two career games, following Milwaukee's Wid Conroy on April 25, 1902. It was also Palacios' sixth multi-hit game in 11 contests since being reinstated from the injured list on June 11, and in that time he is hitting .341 (14-for-41) with four runs, three doubles, one home run and five RBI.

BAE'S BACK: Ji Hwan Bae followed Joshua Palacios last night, going 3-for-5 with two runs as the Indians piled on 14 hits in a comeback attempt against the Red Wings. It was his second three-hit performance in his last three games and his third multi-hit performance in his last six. All eight of his hits in six June games have been singles. Bae has been a consistent Triple-A hitter across his time with Indianapolis, logging a .361 batting average (44-for-122) in 33 games this season and .307 batting average (176-for-573) in 150 career games with the Indians since his Team MVP campaign in 2022.

PEGUERO POPS: Liover Peguero broke an 0-for-15 stretch with at least one hit in each of his last three games, extended by a 2-for-5 performance last night at Rochester. Since Game 1 in Thursday's doubleheader, he is 5-for-11 with three runs, two extra-base hits and three RBI. He kicked off the stretch with his fifth homer of the season and third in June during Thursday's opening contest. It was his first since homering in consecutive games on June 13-14 at Jacksonville. His back-to-back two-hit performances in Game 2 of the doubleheader and last night were his first back-to-back multi-hit contests since going 6-for-8 in two games from June 18-19 vs. Iowa.

**NO BEER:** Seth Beer singled home two runs last night for his second consecutive game at Jacksonville with at least one hit and two RBI. The four RBI in his past two games were his first in seven games with Indianapolis since being promoted from Double-A Altoona. In 55 games with the Curve, he logged four two-RBI games and two three-RBI performances.

**TONIGHT:** The Indians are looking for their first win of the six-game road trip at Innovative Field, home of the Rochester Red Wings, in the fifth game this week. It is their first road trip to Rochester since 2019 after going 8-4 vs. the Red Wings at Victory Field from 2022-23. On Sept. 19, 2023, the Indians defeated Rochester 19-1 for their largest margin of victory again the opponent in the all-time head-to-head series. Taking the mound for the Indians tonight is RHP Domingo Germán (2-4, 5.55), making his third career outing (second start) against the Red Wings and first since 2017 with Scranton/Wilkes-Barre. In those appearances, he is 2-0 with a 2.53 ERA (3er/10.2ip) and 11 strikeouts. Countering for Rochester is RHP Jackson Rutledge (4-4, 6.16) in his first career start against the Indians.

**GERMÁN'S GEM:** Domingo Germán suits up for his eighth start with the Indians tonight, one year and one day after throwing a perfect game with the Yankees (see below). He earned his second consecutive win in his last start with Indy on Sunday vs. lowa, tossing 5.0 one-run innings with just one hit allowed and seven strikeouts. In two starts against lowa last week, he went 2-0 with a 2.45 ERA (3er/11.0ip) and 12 strikeouts. It was his third consecutive start with less than one earned run allowed after surrendering three-plus earned runs in each of his first four starts with Indianapolis. Since June 12 at Jacksonville, he is 2-1 with a 2.35 ERA (4er/15.1ip) and 16 strikeouts.

**PERFECTION:** One year and one day after throwing the 24th perfect game in Major League Baseball history for the New York Yankees, Domingo Germán is set to make his eighth start with the Indians. On June 28, 2023, Germán blanked the Oakland Athletics with 9.0 sparkling frames at the Oakland Coliseum in California with nine strikeouts and just 99 pitches thrown. It was the first perfect game in MLB since Félix Hernández on Aug. 15, 2012, for Seattle and the Yankees' fourth in franchise history to lead the league. Germán was also the first Dominican-born pitcher to throw a perfect game and the first Latino-born pitcher to throw a no-no for the Yankees.

THIS DATE IN 2003: Pete Zoccolillio launched a two-out, solo home run in the bottom of the 12th inning to defeat Richmond in walk-off fashion, 3-2. After Indy took a 2-0 lead in the fourth, Richmond ran down to the wire and plated a pair to tie the game in the top of the ninth. Zoccolillo was one of four Indians batters (also: Jim Rushford, Keith Luuloa and Alex Delgado) to notch multi-hit games in the win.

# TONIGHT'S PITCHER

**Domingo Germán:** Right-hander Domingo Germán is set to make his eighth start of the year for Indianapolis against Rochester, tonight at 6:45 PM at Innovative Field.

**Last Outing:** Germán toed the rubber against the I-Cubs on 6/23 for the third time this season as he punched out seven batters across 5.0 innings while picking up the win.

**Against the Red Wings:** Germán made two starts vs. Rochester in 2017, going 2-0 with a 2.53 ERA (3er/10.2ip) and 11 strikeouts.

**Historic Germán:** Domingo Germán spent the 2023 season with the New York Yankees. He made 20 total appearances (19 starts) while tossing the 24th perfect game in major league history on 6/28 at Oakland which was the fourth in Yankees history. He was placed on the restricted list on 8/2 and missed the remainder of the season.

**Miscellaneous:** Germán was signed by the Florida Marlins as an international free agent on May 27, 2010. On Dec. 19, 2014, he was traded to New York (AL) with RHP Nathan Eovaldi and RF Garrett Jones in exchange for RHP David Phelps and 3B Martin Prado. He had his contract first selected by the Yankees on November 4, 2016 and he made his MLB debut on June 11, 2017 vs. Baltimore. He was signed by Pittsburgh as a minor league free agent on March 16, 2024.
