BROOKLYN CYCLONES (16-21) vs. Winston-Salem Dash (23-15)

I LAST TIME OUT: The Cyclones won their 5th game in 6 contests besting the Dash, 7-3, on Tuesday night...LF Jaylen Palmer smashed a solo home run in the 7th and tallied 2 hits and 2 RBI on the day...RF Omar De Los Santos racked up 2 doubles, 2 RBI, and 2 stolen bags...SS William Lugo collected a multi-RBI game, while CF Alex Ramírez drove in 2 with a double in the 8th...RHP Blade Tidwell punched out 7 and collected his 2nd-straight win...RHP Paul Gervase and RHP Trey McLoughlin combined to yield 1 unearned run in relief, striking out 6, earning the hold and save, respectively...2B Loidel Chapellí walked 3 times and stole 2 bases for Winston-Salem.

START ME UP: After not registering a win in the team's first 31 games, Brooklyn starters collected 4-straight victories during the team's season-high win streak between May 17 and Game 1 of Sunday's double-header at Hudson Valley, and 5-of-the-last-6 games total...In their last 6, Cyclones starting pitchers have amassed a 5-0 record with a 0.86 ERA (3 ER in 31.1 IP)...Brooklyn's starters have walked 15 and struck out 36.

CAN'T TOUCH THIS: The Cyclones pitching staff has been marvelous over the course of the team's last 6 games...Since Wednesday afternoon, Brooklyn has permitted just 4 earned runs (10 total) on 30 hits through the last 51.2 innings...That is good for a microscopic 0.70 ERA... Cyclones' pitching has walked 25 and struck out 64 in that span... Brooklyn's strikeout rate is 30.9% during the streak...The 'Clones have outscored opponents, 34-10, over the 6-games stretch...Brooklyn is 5-1 during that span.

THRILL OF THE 'CHASE': After a bumpy month of April, INF Chase Estep has picked up the pace at the plate in season's second month... In his last 12 games played dating back to May 5, the 23-year-old is slashing .310/.370/.548 with a .918 OPS...Estep has accumulated 6 runs scored, 5 doubles, a triple, a home run, and 10 RBI in 46 plate appearances...The Corbin, Ky. native has also registered a 141 wRC+...Estep has garnered at least one knock in 10 of those 12 games...In his first 12 outings, he was just 2-for-43 (.047) at the dish with a wRC+ of -21.

OMAR ON THE RUN: In addition to his 16 stolen bases in 2023, OF Omar De Los Santos remains among the best base stealers in Minor League Baseball since the beginning of 2022...The 23-year-old has accumulated 86 stolen bases in that span, which is 4th most in MiLB...Only Red Sox prospect INF David Hamilton (93), Marlins farmhand INF Nasim Núñez (91), Aberdeen OF Luis Valdez (89)...De Los Santos has also snagged 50 more bases than any other Mets prospect in that time... Fellow Cyclone IF/OF Jaylen Palmer is 2nd with 36...Omar is already 16 swipes shy of matching INF Walter Rasquin's franchise record for single-season stolen bases (32) which was set back in 2017.

GUIGUE GUNSLINGER: Guigue, Venezuela's LHP **Daniel Juárez** has been as dominant as can be out of the bullpen for the Cyclones in 2023...In his first 12 outings of the campaign, the southpaw holds a 2-0 record with 1 save...He has not permitted an earned run (1 total) on 5 hits and 6 walks, striking out 24 (13.79 K/9)...In 17 regular season appearances with the 'Clones dating back to last season, Juárez has yielded only 2 unearned runs in 20.0 innings...The 22-year-old has not surrendered an earned run in 25 straight appearances dating back to last year...Juárez last allowed earned runs on June 22, 2022, with Single-A St. Lucie at Palm Beach...Since then, he is 4-0 with 10 hits allowed, 15 walks, and 39 strikeouts in 30.1 innings...Since the streak began, no pitcher in Minor League Baseball has thrown more innings without allowing an earned run.

STU'S CRUISE: RHP Tyler Stuart has been as consistent as any starting pitcher in the South Atlantic League in 2023...The 23-year-old extended his scoreless inning streak to 14.2 innings with 6.1 spotless frames in game one at Hudson Valley on Sunday...Stuart punched out 8 batters for his first pro win...Stuart is also 3rd in the league in batting average against (.197) and 6th in WHIP (1.13)...Analytically, the right-hander is also among the SAL's best...Stuart is 2nd in FIP (2.86), 3rd in xFIP (3.49), 4th in strikeout rate (32.3%), and 5th in strikeouts per nine innings (11.81).

WIZARD OF SUOZZ: OF/1B **Joe Suozzi** matched a season-high with 3 hits on Friday and enters Wednesday riding a 10-game on-base streak during the course of Brooklyn's road trip...The Glen Cove, N.Y. native is 12-for-his-last-31 (.387) with 5 runs scored, 3 doubles, 5 RBI, 4 walks, and a stolen base...Suozzi has registered a .943 OPS and 158 wRC+ in those 10 contests.

vs. WINSTON-SALEM: Brooklyn returns to Coney Island for a 6-game set against the White Sox High-A affiliate... The Dash posses 9 of Chicago's top 30 prospects per Baseball America...RHP Norge Vera (8), RHP Jonathan Cannon (11), RHP Kohl Simas (13), RHP Jared Kelley (14), OF Wilfred Veras (17), INF Wes Kath (18), OF Terrell Tatum (24), INF Loidel Chapellí (26), and RHP Andrew Dalquist (28) are featured...The Cyclones went dropped 5-of-6 to Winston-Salem in their first meeting at Truist Stadium from April 11-16...In last year's meeting at Maimonides Park, Brooklyn split the 6-game set from August 2-7.

HIT PARADA: C Kevin Parada cracked a home run last Tuesday night and has been on a tear since the calendar flipped to May...In 17 games during the season's second month, the 21-year-old is slashing .286/.384/.524 with a .907 OPS...Parada is 18-for-63 at the dish (.286) with 10 runs scored, 7 doubles, a triple, 2 home runs, and 8 RBI...In that time frame, the Los Angeles native holds a .408 wOBA and a 143 wRC+...In the month of May, Parada is 2nd in the league in doubles (7) and tied for 6th in extra-base hits (10)...For the entire campaign, the Georgia Tech alum is 3rd in the SAL in two-base hits (11)...Parada has also reached base safely in 8-straight games dating back to May 13 at Wilmington.

BROOKLYN BRUISING COMPANY: In Friday's victory, the Cyclones were drilled with pitches on 6 different occassions...That is the most times a single team has been plunked in a South Atlantic League game this season...It also set a new franchise record for hit-by-pitches in a single game...The previous high-water mark was 5 on July 24, 2022, at Jersey Shore...In addition, with LF Jaylen Palmer and 1B Joe Suozzi drilled twice and once, respectively, they have tied OF Matt Rudick's Cyclones record for career hit-by-pitches with 16...Rudick still holds the single-season mark as all 16 of his came in the 2022 season.

BREAK OUT THE RYE BREAD: 3B Mateo Gil's grand slam in the top of the 6th inning on Thursday marked the first 4-RBI home run by a Cyclone in 2023...lt marked Brooklyn's first grand slam since 1B JT Schwartz smashed one off RHP Ryan Miller at Hudson Valley on July 27, 2022... Last season, the Cyclones smashed a pair of grand salamis...CF Jaylen Palmer hammered the first off RHP Alex Pham vs. Aberdeen on June 12.

RAMÍ ROCKETS: OF Alex Ramírez reached base 4 times and tied a season-high with 3 hits on Thursday night at Hudson Valley...The 20-year-old doubled twice, worked a walk, scored a run and drove in another... It was Ramírez's first multi-extra base hit game since he doubled twice on August 25, 2022, at Jersey Shore...Since joining Brooklyn's roster on July 4 of last year, Ramírez leads the South Atlantic League in hits (98), doubles (25), and total bases (146)...He only trails teammate OF Stanley Consuegra in extra-base hits (33) and is tied with Jersey Shore's 1B Rixon Wingrove in RBI (56).

ROAD WARRIOR: OF Stanley Consuegra has thrived away from Maimonides Park in 2023...Coming into Wednesday, the 22-year-old has posted a batting average 125 points higher on the road (.313) than at home (.176)...Away from home, Consuegra is slashing .296/.342/.577 with a .919 OPS adding 10 of his 15 extra-base hits and all 5 of his home runs...17 of his 19 RBI have been on the road, as well...As a team, the Cyclones are hitting 20 points better in visiting parks (.223) than on Coney Island (.203).

MEET THE 'NEW' BOSS: Chris Newell takes over as the manager of the Brooklyn Cyclones in 2023 after serving as the team's bench coach in 2022...Newell served as skipper of the Birmingham-Bloomfield Beavers of the United Shore Professional Baseball League from 2016-19...The 49-year-old won consecutive championships (2017-18) and was named Manager of the Year three times (2016-18).

PROSPECTS: Brooklyn hosts 3 of the Mets Top 10 prospects, according to *MLB Pipeline* and *Baseball America* and 5 of the Top 30...They include C Kevin Parada (No. 1 *MLB Pipeline*/No. 4 *Baseball America*), OF Alex Ramírez (2/5), and RHP Blade Tidwell (5/9)...INF William Lugo (24/26) and RHP Christian Scott (28/26) also appears on both lists...OF Stanley Consuegra ranks as the organization's No. 19 farmhand per *MLB Pipeline*

HOME AWAY FROM HOME: Despite Maimonides Park's pitcher-friendly tendencies, Foster has faired better away from Coney Island in 2023...The 24-year-old holds an 1-1 mark, but a 1.74 ERA (4 ER in 20.2 IP) with 8 walks and 20 strikeouts in 4 road starts...At home, Foster is 0-2 with a 15.88 ERA (10 ER in 5.2 IP) and more walks (7) than strikeouts (4).

2022: Composed a 4-2 record with a 1.86 ERA (13 ER in 63.0 IP), 12 saves, and 84 strikeouts in 29 appearances at McNeese State University...Named Southland Conference Reliever of the Year...Recognized on the All-Southland Conference First Team...Selected by the New York Mets in the 14th round...Signed on August 1 for \$40,000...Assigned to the Florida Complex League Mets, but did not pitch.

START ME UP: Foster is slated to make the 6th start of his season and pro career on Thursday night...The 24-year-old did not start at McNeese State in 2022 and only made 4 total over 3 seasons...During 2 campaigns at Wharton (Texas) County Junior College registered just 8 starts in 23 appearances...Prior to this season, his last official start came on February 28, 2021, for McNeese State vs. Prairie View A&M University.
