RYAN HOWARD

Ryan Howard was inducted to the Reading Baseball Hall of Fame in 2018. Howard was drafted by the Philadelphia Phillies in the 5th round of 2001 MLB Amateur Draft out of Missouri State University.



Howard played for the Reading Fightin Phils in 2004 and made quite the impact over his 102 games with the team. During his run in Baseballtown, Howard hit .297 and ended with a total of 37 home runs, 102 RBI, 18 doubles and scored 73 runs. His home runs earned him the since-broken record for the most amount of home runs in a single season and held the record until 2012.

His impressive stats were not Howard's only legacy he left behind. During his time with the Fightin Phils he was named MVP, Post Season All-Star, and won both the MiLB Joe Bauman Home Run Award along with Rookie of the Year.

In September of 2004 Howard made his debut with the Philadelphia Phillies and would go on to play with them until 2016 as well as win the World Series with the Philadelphia Phillies in 2008. Throughout his time in the majors, Howard made a name for himself. He was named Rookie of the Year in 2005, a three-time National League All Star, National League MVP in 2006 and won the National League Slugger Award also in 2006.

Howard earned a spot as a top leader in multiple categories during his time in the majors including two-time National League Home Runs Leader (2006 & 2008), three-time National Leage RBI Leader (2006, 2008 & 2009) and the National League Total Bases Leader (2006). Lastly, Howard was one of the quickest players to reach both his 100th and 200th home runs. Howard ended his career hitting .258 with 382 home runs, 1194 RBI, and scored 848 runs.

This Day in HISTORY

April 15th to April 20th

April 15, 2003: At Reading, Brian Hitchcox hits a 2-run home run with two outs in the bottom of the 9th to rally the R-Phils past Akron, 5-4. Reading trailed 4-0 in the 6th and 4-1 going into the bottom of the 8th.

April 16, 2018: At Harrisburg, Ranger Suarez picks up his first Double-A victory as the Fightin Phils blank the Senators, 6-0. Suarez allows 6 hits and strikes out 10 over 8.0 innings and does not issue a walk. Zach Coppola goes 3-for-5 with 2 runs and a stolen base while Kyle Martin connects for a grand slam in the 5th inning.

April 17, 2004: At Reading, Ryan Howard hits his first home run at FirstEnergy Stadium, a two-run shot in the 1st inning off Akron's Kyle Evans. The Phils fall to the Aeros, 7-4.

April 18, 1993: At Reading, the Phils belt 5 HR in a 9-0 win over Binghamton. Jeff Jackson, Pat Brady, Ron Lockett, Keith Kimberlin and Sam Taylor each go deep.

April 19, 2015: At Reading, Zach Eflin holds Richmond scoreless over 8.0 innings to improve to 2-0 and extend his streak to 14 innings without allowing a run. He allows just 3 hits and a walk while striking out 5 in the 6-0 victory. Harold Martinez goes 3-for-3 with his first home run and drives in 3 for Reading.

April 20, 1921: At Lauer's Park in Reading, the Aces defeat Rochester, 6-5, in front of a record-breaking crowd of 10,000 on Opening Day.



Farquhar started for Reading in all three games of the opening series when they took on the Portland Sea Dogs as well as for the exhibition game against the Jersey Shore BlueClaws. Farquhar has also started in the first away series for the Fightin Phils as they traveled to New Jersey and took on the Somerset Patriots prior to this week.

During Farquhar's professional season he split his time between Clearwater (A) and the Phillies' Florida Complex League. For the total of the 2023 season, Farquhar appeared in 16 games, scoring 14 runs, earning 8 hits that included four doubles and totaled five RBI.

For the 2024 season, Farquhar began with Clearwater and then returned to the complex league for a rehab assignment for a short time before being assigned to Jersey Shore BlueClaws. STAFF PROFILE AL PEDRIQUE


Al Pedrique returns to Reading after leading the R-Phils the last two seasons. Pedrique, 64, finished 59-78 with Reading in 2024, but his team boasted many accomplishments on the field. He oversaw a roster that had 71 players pass through Reading, with 17 receiving a call up to Triple-A Lehigh Valley during the season. Additionally, three players that played with Reading last season also made their major league debuts last season, which were Max Lazar, Seth Johnson and Sam Aldegheri (with Angels). Oliver Dunn (Milwaukee) and Tyler Phillips both played under Pedrique in 2023 and made their big league debuts during the 2024 season.


Through two seasons in Reading, Pedrique holds 118 wins, which ranks 15th all-time in R-Phils managerial history (26 total managers). Through two seasons with Reading, eight players who played under Pedrique went on to play in the big leagues following their time in Reading (Drew Ellis, Johan Rojas, Orion Kerkering, Dunn, Phillips, Lazar, Johnson and Aldegheri). Pedrique will be the ninth manager in Reading history to manager at least three seasons and 2025 will mark the first time in Pedrique's managerial career he was with a singular team for three seasons or more.

"Getting back to Reading is always nice," Pedrique said. "My wife and I fell in love with the town and the stadium. The front office is awe-some to work with. The fan support was outstanding and we are very happy and pleased to be back in Reading."

Prior to beginning his managerial career, Pedrique played professionally from 1978-1994 after signing with the New York Mets at 17-years old in 1978. His playing career included stops within the Mets, Pirates, Tigers, Athletics, Royals and Marlins organization. He made his Major League debut in 1987 with the Mets and spent parts of three seasons with New York, the Pittsburgh Pirates and Detroit Tigers in the Major Leagues. Pedrique spent a total of 17 seasons in the Minor Leagues before retiring from playing in 1994.

"Our goal is to win more games and bring a Championship to Reading," Pedrique added. "We're very excited to be back. We love everything about Reading. I know it's going to be a good year and I'm looking forward to being back soon."







TOM SLATER - HITTING COACH



STRIKEOUT SCOOP GRIFF MCGARRY



#48 | PITCHER

Griff McGarry made his 2025 debut as starting pitcher for the Reading Fightin Phils during the last game of the season opening series and it was one to remember. This marked McGarry's first start since August of 2023 after spending time with the Lehigh Valley IronPigs (AAA) solely as a reliever while preparing to return to Reading as a starter.

McGarry went on to total eight strikeouts over a perfect four innings in his game against the Portland Sea Dogs. This became the most strikeouts for McGarry since July of 2023 against the Altoona Curves. This past week, following the series, McGarry was named Eastern League Pitcher of the Week for his performance.

McGarry was drafted by the Philadelphia Phillies in the fifth round of the 2021 draft out of Virginia. From there, he split his time during his first professional season with Clearwater (A) and the Jersey Shore BlueClaws (A+). In 2022 he was promoted to Reading where he posted a 2.20 ERA which ultimately led him to Lehigh by the end of the season. He finished out the year making eight appearances for the IronPigs as a relief pitcher.

In 2023, McGarry had to start out on the injured list and once finished, was assigned back here to Reading where he caught attention with is 3.13 ERA. Like the 2022 season, his achievements on the mound earned him another promotion to Lehigh towards the end of the 2023 season. McGarry spent the 2024 season with the IronPigs where he made 29 relief appearances with them. At the beginning of the 2025 season, McGarry was invited to join spring training where he had the chance to pitch during the Spring Breakout Game. Following spring training, McGarry was assigned to Reading and got back into the starting rotation by the end of the opening series.

The honor of Pitcher of the Week marks the first award this season for the Fightin Phils and the first time McGarry was named as one. While McGarry had some bumps in the road, his start to the season went as well as anyone could hope.

McGarry spoke with WEEU's Bob McCool during the Fightin Phils' annual media day where he spoke about how he hopes the season will go.

"I just want to get off on the right foot. Get off to a good start," said McGarry. "Things are a little different now coming back here with these amazing facilities so really excited to pitch here in front of the Reading Fightin Phils fans. Just really good to be back with a great group of guys."
