Today: The Lansing Lugnuts, the High-A affiliate of the Oakland Athletics, play the third game in a six-game series (and 18-game season series) with the Fort Wayne TinCaps, High-A affiliate of the San Diego Padres. Lansing has dropped three in a row while Fort Wayne has won its last seven games, including routs in the first two games of this series.

On the Air: Today's game is available on MiLB TV with **John Nolan**, or tune in via StreamGuys with **Jesse Goldberg-Strassler** and **Adam Jaksa** on the call.

Last Night: TinCaps 12, Lugnuts 5. Fort Wayne scored seven in the fifth and five more runs in the sixth inning keyed by a three-run homer and two-run double from substitute outfielder **Tyler Robertson** (replacing the injured **Albert Fabian**), as the TinCaps scored 12 runs for the second straight game in handing Lansing a lopsided loss. A Fort Wayne starter tossed seven innings for the second straight game as well, with lefty **Jagger Haynes** following **Enmanuel Pinales'** lead.

On Deck: The Lugnuts play the TinCaps through Sunday, then return home for a six-game series against the Peoria Chiefs from May 28-June 2.

LUG•NOTES

Prospecting: The Nuts' roster includes four MLB Pipeline Top 30 A's prospects in pitcher **Luis Morales** (No. 2), outfielder **Henry Bolte** (No. 10), first baseman **Will Simpson** (No. 27) and southpaw **Will Johnston** (No. 30). In Eric Longenhagen's Top 32 A's prospects for Fangraphs, he gives a nod to Morales at No. 3, Simpson at No. 28 and Johnston at No. 32. Keith Law placed Morales at No. 7 and Bolte at No. 17, giving a nod to Morales as his sleeper prospect of the organization.

Scar at the Helm: Lansing is managed this series by **Steve Scarsons**, replacing second-year manager **Craig Conklin** during Conklin's prescheduled week-long break. Scarsons was drafted by the Phillies in the second round in 1986 from Santa Ana College, rising through the ranks to play seven years and 350 games in the Majors with Philly, Baltimore, San Francisco, St. Louis and Kansas City. He managed in the Midwest League with South Bend in 2001 and Kane County in 2009. Scarsons's current title within the A's system is Minor League Outfield and Base Running Coordinator, a position he has held since 2020. He also served as interim manager last season, skipping the Lugnuts to a six-game split at Quad Cities, July 25-30.

Offensively Speaking: The Lugnuts have scored the most runs in the Midwest League (227) and have the second-most hits (350), but have also allowed the most hits (396) and runs (253) in the league. The Nuts have scored double-digits in six different games this season while allowing double-digits in eight games (including seven of allowing at least 12 runs). Lugnuts pitchers have allowed 48 runs over the last four games: a 15-11 win on Saturday over Lake County, a 13-9 10-inning loss to the Captains on Sunday, and 12-1 and 12-5 defeats to Fort Wayne the last two nights.

Pride of Palo Alto: 20-year-old **Henry Bolte**, the youngest player on the team, was named the Midwest League Player of the Week for the week of May 13-18 and a member of Minor League Baseball's Prospect Team of the Week after going 10-for-22 (.455/.586/1.000) with four doubles, one triple, two homers, six walks, nine runs scored, seven runs batted in, and four steals against Lake County. Bolte is 1st in the Midwest League in runs scored (37), 1st in total bases (80), tied for 1st in extra-base hits (20), tied for 2nd in RBIs (34), tied for 3rd in stolen bases (17), tied for 3rd in triples (3), tied for 6th in home runs (7), tied for 7th in base hits (43) and 9th in slugging percentage (.523).

Others of Note: Closer **Colton Johnson** is tied for 1st in the Midwest League with 15 appearances and tied for 3rd with five saves. **Colby Halter** is 2nd in walks (30); **Brayan Buelvas** is tied for 3rd in walks (29), 4th in runs (32), tied for 1st in extra-base hits (20), tied for 4th in total bases (75), tied for 8th in stolen bases (13) and tied for 7th in RBIs (29); and **Euribiel Angeles** is tied for 1st in triples (4), tied for 2nd in RBIs (34) and tied for 10th in total bases (68).

TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2011: 13 more hits and a 12-7 win for the Lugnuts, capping a three-game stretch against Bowling Green with 46 hits and 39 runs at Cooley Law School Stadium. Thank goodness for the offense, because the defense committed five errors (including three fielding errors by SS Gustavo Pierre), causing all seven Hot Rods runs to be un-earned. Pierre now has 27 errors, and the Lugnuts have played only 43 games. The legendary Steve Hiscock gave up four runs on six hits in 1 2/3 innings of relief for Bowling Green, which went 2-for-18 with runners in scoring position.

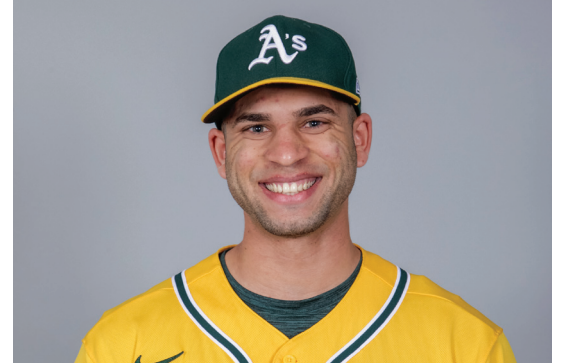
2014: An ugly one at Parkview Field: The TinCaps built a 6-1 lead with three runs in each of the first two innings, gave up four runs in the third (including an L.B. Dantzler three-run homer) to narrow the score to 6-5, and then broke the game open with a six-run bottom of the third that saw starter Matt Dermody and manager John Tamargo, Jr., get ejected after Dermody drilled Dustin Peterson purposefully, followed by a member of the TinCaps in the home dugout shouting at Dermody as he walked past on his way back to the clubhouse (the path to the clubhouse leads directly past the dugout at Parkview). Tamargo got involved, shouting back, and the two sides needed to be separated. The TinCaps went on to romp, 17-6, scoring in seven of their eight at-bats (blanked in only the sixth).

Retrospective: Signing bonus of \$3 million broke the record given to Sandy Gaston by Tampa Bay in 2018 (\$2.61m)... declared a free agent on August 25, 2022... signed on the first day of the international signing period, January 15, 2023, and motored through four levels in his professional debut.

In a Nutshell: Opened 2024 on the Lugnuts' Injured List, activated April 29... glove this year is green and black to represent the A's green and the Lugnuts' black... set a career high for professional innings pitched in April 30th season debut with 4 2/3 innings... limiting right-handers to .182/.250/.318 (4-for-22, 2 BB, 5 K) compared to lefties (.320/.452/.520, 8-for-25, 1 HR, 6 BB, 4 K).

Prospecting: Morales is ranked the Oakland Athletics' no. 2 prospect and top pitching prospect by MLB Pipeline, which grades his fastball at 60, his curve at 50, his slider at 55, his change at 50 and his control at 50.

They write, "Morales was billed as the consensus top pitching prospect of the 2023 international signing period when he signed for \$3 million with the A's in January that year. After setting a U-18 record for strikeouts with 161 across 82 2/3 innings between 2019-20 in Cuba's Serie Nacional, he defected in 2021 to Mexico, where he trained with Maels Rodríguez, a former Cuban National team pitcher and Olympian who regularly threw 100 mph fastballs. Initially expected to pitch solely in the Dominican Summer League for his introduction to pro ball, his excellent performance earned him stops at four different levels. He finished the year at High-A Lansing, combining for a 2.86 ERA with 53 strikeouts in 44 innings.

Morales' whip-like delivery produces an electric fastball that sits around 94-97 mph and can reach up to 99. His four-pitch mix also includes a slider, a changeup and a curveball, all of which appeared to be quality secondary pitches as he rapidly ascended through the Minors in his debut season.

Adding about 10 pounds of muscle to his 6-foot-3 frame in preparation for his first full season as a pro, Morales will see his durability tested as he looks to navigate the rigors of pitching. While his command was solid upon joining the A's, he has struggled with controlling his pitches in the past. If he can keep that control steady, he has a chance to make another significant jump through the system in 2024, with enough potential to evolve into a frontline starter in the future."

Path to Lansing: Luis opened the 2023 season in the Dominican Summer League, making his professional debut on June 6 with 1 2/3 hitless innings vs. DSL Astros Blue, striking out three... struck out six batters in three one-hit innings on June 20... struck out five batters in four one-hit innings on June 27... made four appearances in DSL before he was promoted to the Arizona Complex League Athletics on July 2, debuting on July 4 with three innings, allowing one run with three strikeouts vs. D-Backs Black... made three starts in AzCL before he was promoted to the Stockton Ports on July 24, debuting on July 28 with three one-hit innings and five strikeouts vs. Lake Elsinore... in last of five California League starts, tossed four two-hit scoreless innings at Fresno on August 25... promoted to Lansing on August 30, his fourth different stop along the ladder... strikeouts high: 6, 6/20/23.

In a Nutshell: Opened the season in a tandem with Jose Dicochea, relieving Dicochea the second day of the season, April 6 at Dayton, and receiving his first start of the year, April 13 vs. Great Lakes... moved full-time to a relief role following Luis Morales starts when Morales joined the Lugnuts on April 29.

Statistically Relevant: Has dominated right-handers (.149/.241/.298, 5 BB, 16 K) compared to left-handers meeting slightly greater success (.208/.323/.302, 10 BB, 5 K)... holding leadoff hitters to .154/.267.308, 4-for-26, 4 BB... home games: 4.66 ERA, 19 1/3 IP, 13 R (10 ER), 3 HR, 9 BB, 12 K; road games: 1.04 ERA, 8 2/3, 1 R, 6 BB, 9 K.

Home Cooking: Born in Barquisimeto in the state of Lara, where former Lugnut and current Diamondbacks catcher Gabby Moreno was also born... cousin is Carlos "Cookie" Carrasco, in his 15th year in the Major Leagues and a current member of the Cleveland Guardians rotation; Carlos Carrasco led the Majors in victories (18) in 2017 and finished 4th in A.L. Cy Young voting.

Minor League Path: Signed at age 16 by Ruben Barradas in 2018... debuted on June 19, 2019, in the Arizona League... following the canceled season of 2020, split 2021 between the Arizona Complex League and the California League, working out of the Stockton bullpen... repeated in the AzCL and Cal League in 2022... spent all of 2023 pitching for Stockton... tossed six innings for the Ports on four different occasions, finishing the season with six shutout five-hit innings on September 7 at San Jose, with no walks and nine strikeouts... posted 6.57 home ERA in Stockton, 3.12 ERA on the road.
