FROM THE CROWS NEST

0 LASTTIME OUT: The Bradenton Marauders scored six unanswered runs to defeat the St. Lucie Mets 9-4 on Friday night at Clover Park. Clevari Tejada picked up his first win of the season, striking out five in 4.2 scoreless innings. In his return of the injured list, Magdiel Cotto struck out five in two scoreless frames. Four different Marauders recorded multi-hit games with Javier Rivas pacing the offense with three hits.

THREE BAGS PLEASE: Braylon Bishop recorded a triple in the second inning on Friday night, which was the third hit by a Marauder this week. Bradenton is just one of six teams in Minor League Baseball this week to have three or more three-baggers

CURSE REVERSED: With a win on Friday night, the Bradenton Marauders clinched their first road series victory of the season. Bradenton had split a pair of road trips in June in Clearwater and Dunedin. Their previous road series victory came in their last in the 2023 season when they won four out of six in Fort Myers.

GRAND SALAMI: C Derek Berg's first professional home run came on an inside-the-park grand slam on Thursday night in Port St. Lucie. For the Marauders, it's their second inside-the-park grand slam this year, with the other coming from Esmerlyn Valdez against the Mets at LECOM Park on May 10. Bradenton has five grand slams this year, which is the second-most in Single-A and tied for the 10th-most in all of Minor League Baseball.

NEW KIDS ON THE BLOCK: Since their promotions from the FCL Pirates last week, both INF Jhonny Severino and INF Yordany De Los Santos have held their own. Severino has reached base in all eight games while De Los Santos has reached in his first seven. Severino's best game of the season came on Thursday night, when t 4-for-5 with two triples, a walk, and three runs. The four hits tied his career-high, last accomplishing the feat on 7/2/22 when he was a member of the DSL Brewers. The four-hits are also the most by a Marauder batter in a single-game this year.

CUE LAZY MARY: On Saturday, the Bradenton Marauders continue their lone trip of the season to Clover Park. Last year, Bradenton won five out of the six games in St. Lucie and have won 13-straight overall meetings against the Mets after they won all six at LECOM Park against them in May. The serie-finale victory in that series marked the Marauders' 10th-straight win which set a franchise record. Bradenton also walked-off St. Lucie three times that week including the Sunday finale.

AMONG LEAGUE LEADERS: The Marauders hold three of the top eight home run leaders in the Florida State League, with Esmerlyn Valdez leading the way in second with 17 longballs. Axiel Plaz is currently in third with 15 and Shalin Polanco is tied for eighth with 10. Valdez is one just HR shy of tying league leader in Ariel Almonte (Daytona). The 17 HR hit by a Valdez are the second-most by a Marauder since the Florida State League was moved from High-A to Low-A. Rodolfo Nolasco hit 20 bombs last year for Bradenton to lead the way.

LOST AT SEA: The Marauders have the first three games in St. Lucie and are just two wins shy of tying their season-high in road winning streak (5). The .288 win percentage on the road is the worst in Minor League Baseball this season. Bradenton dropped their first nine road games to the start the year as well. The .288 win percentage is the 15th-worst on record in the Minor League Baseball research portal with the 2014 Modesto Nuts (Single-A, SEA) owning the worst after they posted a 14-56 (.200) record.

MINI VACATION: The Bradenton Marauders continue their longest stretch of games away from LECOM Park this week with a six-game series against the St. Lucie Mets. Bradenton dropped five of the six games in Palm Beach before they headed north to battle the St. Lucie Mets.

BOMBS AWAY: Since May 1st, the Bradenton Marauders have clubbed 83 home runs in 84 games which is the most by any team in Single-A. Bradenton led Single-A with 31 longballs in the month of June and were just three shy of tying their franchise record. In July, Bradenton racked up 26 in 22 games with Axiel Plaz and Esmerlyn Valdez accounting for 12 of the 26. The 26 home runs were the third-most in Single-A in July, trailing the Inland Empire 66ers who had 29.

CLOSE QUARTERS: Sunday afternoons loss to the Cardinals marked the Marauders' 37th one-run contest of the season. The Marauders own an 18-19 record in those games. Bradenton has lost their last four one-run games.
