LAST OUTING: Alexander had the makings of a strong outing on July 20 vs. Jacksonville, allowing two earned runs through his first six frames before surrendering five unearned runs in the seventh inning. He departed with his first quality start (6.1 IP, 2 ER) of the season, earning the win in Nashville's 12-10 victory.

AGAINST OPPONENT: Alexander has five career appearances (3 starts) against Norfolk, posting a 2-1 record and 1.96 ERA (23.0 IP/5 ER) with 19 strikeouts. On June 25 of this season, he allowed one unearned run in 4.2 frames against the Tides. The Sounds won the contest 3-2.
