NOTES AND NUGGETS

BULLPEN OR BUST

The Omaha Storm Chasers are throwing a bullpen game today ... this is the team's 12th bullpen game of the season.

Going back to the home series against Norfolk, April 15 to 20, the Chasers have thrown at least one bullpen game every series.

Today is **Brandon Johnson's** 1st opener start, in his 5th Triple-A appearance ... this outing is Johnson's 1st professional start, after his first 111 Minor League outings were in relief ... he did not start a game in college at Ole Miss, over 42 NCAA D1 appearances ... Johnson's last start was March 7, 2020 while pitching for Columbia State Community College, he pitched 5.0 innings and allowed 2 runs on 4 hits with 0 walks and 9 strikeouts against Volunteer State CC.

The 11 bullpen games prior to today have been opened by 8 different pitchers ... **Anthony Simonelli** (3), **Nate Ackenhausen** (2) **Stephen Nogosek** (2), **Cruz Noriega** (1), **Jacob Wallace** (1), **Eric Cerantola** (1) and **John Gant** (1).

THAT'S WHAT SPEED DO

While the Storm Chasers do not lead the league in stolen bases, Omaha has one of the highest success rates on the basepaths in the Minors.

Omaha has successfully stolen 97 bases this year, and only been caught 14 times ... 97 steals rank 4th both in the International League and at the Triple-A level.

97-for-111 in steal attempts is a 87.4% success rate, the highest stolen base rate at the Triple-A level a 3rd-best among full-season Minor League teams (1st: New Hampshire Fisher Cats, 89.6%, 43-for-49).

U CAN'T TOUCH THIS

The Omaha Storm Chasers pitching staff sits near the top of the International League in strikeouts, with 583 strikeouts this season ... that is both 2nd in the league and at the Triple-A level.

Over 526.2 innings, Omaha pitchers are averaging 9.96 K/9, which ranks 3rd both in the International League and at the Triple-A level.

With 583 strikeouts through 61 games, an average of 9.56 strikeouts per game has the staff on pace for 1,424 strikeouts this season ... the franchise record is 1,282 strikeouts by the 2023 Storm Chasers.

SACRIFICIAL LOVE

The Omaha Storm Chasers lead the International League lead in both sacrifices (13) and sacrifice flies (27) as well.

The Chasers led the IL in sacrifice bunts last year, with 38 ... the 13 sacrifice bunt this year are the most in the league this year, 3rd at the Triple-A level, and tied 14th in the Minors.

27 sac flies are the most of any Triple-A club and tied for the 4th-most in Minor League Baseball.

Tyler Tolbert, **Harold Castro** and **John Rave** each have 3 sacrifice bunts, tied for the 2nd-most in the league ... **Tyler Gentry's** 6 sacrifice flies lead the IL and are tied for the most at the Triple-A level, one off the Minor League lead.

LEADING BY EXAMPLE

Omaha is one of the best teams in the International League at leading off innings.

The Storm Chasers lead the IL with 124 hits and 209 total bases when leading off innings this year ... a .264 average leading off innings is 3rd in the league, while a .793 OPS ranks 4th.

Cam Devanney is a .389 hitter when leading off innings (14-for-36), the 4th-best average leading off innings in the IL ... much of the success opening innings can be attributed to current Royal **John Rave**, who went 21-for-71 (.296) when leading off innings, his 40 total bases leading off innings are 2nd in the IL.

LET'S OBSERVE MERV

After a slow start at the plate in his return to Triple-A, outfielder MJ Melendez has been one of Omaha's best hitters over the last few weeks.

With hits in 4 straight, Melendez has hits in 17 of his last 21 games, for a .316 average (25-for-79) with a .955 OPS since May 16 ... he has 6 homers and 16 RBI in this stretch, with 6 multi-hit games.

Since May 16, Melendez is tied 2nd in the International League in homers (6) and 3rd in total bases (47) ... he has the most steals (11) in that stretch as well.

Over his first 19 games with the Storm Chasers, Melendez hit just .156 (12-for-77) with a .468 OPS, between April 22 and May 14 ... he had hits in 10 of 19 games in that stretch.

Underrated in MJ's time with Omaha has been the exit velocities he's produced ... an average exit velocity of 93.9MPH ranks tied 2nd among 322 Triple-A hitters with at least 100 plate appearances this season ... Worcester's Roman Anthony hits the ball hardest on average, at 94.6MPH.

CAREER REVIEW

- Brandon Michael Johnson is entering his 4th year with the Kansas City Royals organization, after being drafted in 2022 out of Ole Miss ... he reached Double-A for the first time in 2024 and has not yet made it to Triple-A.
- Has exclusively pitched out of the bullpen in his professional career, with 90 relief appearances across three seasons ... 82 of his 90 career outings have been at least 1.0 outing, while he's finished at least 2.0 innings 26 times ... 80.1 of his 122.0 career innings (66%) have come in the 7th, 8th or 9th inning.
- Over the last two years (2023-24), his 13.08 K/9 ranks 1st among Royals Minor League arms with at least 100.0 innings.

2024 HIGHLIGHTS

- Split his season between Quad Cities (A+) and NW Arkansas (AA), appearing in 45 games between the two levels with a 4.23 ERA (26 ER in 55.1 IP) and 78 strikeouts to 23 walks (3.39 K/BB) ... promoted to Double-A on June 11.
- Opened his season with 12.0 scoreless innings, did not allow a run across his first 9 outings of the year ... also did not allow a home run over his first 12 games of the season, for a 29.0-inning homerless streak dating back to August 2023.
- Did not allow an earned run in 14 of 18 games with the River Bandits prior to his promotion ... allowed multiple runs in 3 of 4 games where he allowed an earned run.
- Tied a career-high with 5 strikeouts over 1.2 innings on April 17 vs. Peoria (STL) ... struck out 5 of 6 batters he faced.
- While he had a 4.80 ERA (8 ER in 15.0 IP) across his first 14 games and 2 months in Double-A (June and July), produced a scoreless month of August for the Naturals, not allowing a run and surrendering just 5 hits over 10.0 innings.
- Pitched in 8 games for the Surprise Saguaros in the Arizona Fall League when the Minor League season ended, striking out 11 across 8.2 innings (11.4 K/9).

- Spent the entire year with Quad Cities (A+), appearing in 40 games out of the bullpen with a 6-3 record and 5.04 ERA (34 ER in 60.2 IP), while striking out 80 (11.87 K/9).
- Produced his best month of the season in May, pitching to a 1.76 ERA (3 ER in 15.1 IP) over 9 outings, with 20 strikeouts.
- Worked 21 scoreless appearances, 14 of which were longer than 1.0 inning.
- Threw a career-high 2.2 innings on August 16 vs. Beloit (MIA), allowed just 1 hit and no walks with 3 strikeouts ... is the only outing of his professional career longer than 2.0 innings.

- SENIOR (2022):** Recorded 12 saves across 24 relief appearances, with 71 strikeouts in 41.2 innings (15.3 K/9) ... won the 2022 College World Series with Ole Miss and threw the title-clinching pitch of the CWS to Oklahoma's **Hayden Dunhurst**, who the Royals selected in the 6th round of the 2022 Draft ... struck out three to earn the save in the title-clinching Game 2 of the CWS Finals on June 26.

Scorigami: A portmanteau of score and origami, a scorigami is a scoring combination that has never happened before in a team, sport or league's history. The term was originated by SB Nation writer Jon Bois for NFL scores.

Above is a matrix of every final score that has happened in a Triple-A Omaha game since 2000. Green squares represent Omaha wins, while red squares represent Omaha losses. The number inside the square refers to the number of times that result has occurred. Empty squares represent a scoring combination or result that has not happened.

Since 2000, there are **58** results in Triple-A Omaha games that have only happened once. **34** of those results (wins or losses) are a true scorigami, a scoring combination that has only happened once. Recent scorigami occurrences are listed to the right, with true scorigamis in bold.
