DRILLERS CLUB THREE HOMERS, CARDS FALL 11-0: The Tulsa Drillers collected 15 hits, including three home runs, as the Cardinals dropped game two of their six-game series at ONEOK Field 11-0 on Wednesday afternoon. Springfield had just three hits, a sixth-inning double by **RJ Yeager** being the Cards only knock for extra bases. The Cardinals were shut out for the first time this season and have dropped five of their last six games.



OPPOSING STARTER: Right-hander **Orlando Ortiz-Mayer** makes his fifth start of the season for the Drillers...Last pitched on Thursday, April 25 against NW Arkansas at ONEOK Field and allowed 2 R on 3 H with 5 K over 5.0 IP...Did not factor in the decision, a 6-4 Drillers win...Got the win in his previous start with 5.1 shutout inning at Wichita...Allowed 7 ER on 8 H (including 4 HR) in his season debut against NW Arkansas on April 7 in Springdale...Has allowed 7 HR in 19.1 IP this season...Made 13 appearances (11 starts) with Tulsa last season and went 3-8 with a 5.79 ERA...Went 0-2 in 2 starts against the Cardinals last season with a 6.52 ERA...Began 2023 with High-A Great Lakes and went 6-1 with a 3.58 ERA over 14 appearances (2 starts)...Spent his first at Low-A Rancho Cucamonga making 20 appearances (3 starts) and going 2-4 with a 6.79 ERA...Signed as an undrafted free agent by the Dodgers in August 2021 out of Troy...Spent 2020-21 at Troy going 8-5 with a 4.13 ERA in 19 appearances (17 starts)...Born in Rio Piedras, Puerto Rico...26 years old

CARDINALS BEGIN 12-GAME ROAD TRIP WITH FIRST VISIT TO TULSA: The Springfield Cardinals hit the road for two straight series beginning with their first of four matchups with the Tulsa Drillers (Double-A, Los Angeles Dodgers). The Cards will host Tulsa later this month before making their final regular season trip to Drillville for a six-game series from July 30-August 4.



CARDINALS CELEBRATE 20 YEARS IN SPRINGFIELD

The 2024 season is a special one at Hammons Field, as it represents the 20th anniversary of the return of Cardinals baseball to Springfield. The franchise moved to the Queen City of the Ozarks from El Paso in 2005 and boast one Texas League title in 2012 and two North Division championships (2007 & 2012) since. The first iteration of the Springfield Cardinals spanned from 1931-46, an era that saw the Redbirds bring home five league titles.

HISTORIC START: With their nine-game winning streak to start the season, the Cardinals set a new franchise record for consecutive victories. Springfield had won eight straight games twice previously: in 2007 from June 9-16 and from September 2-10 last season during a 17-6 run over 23 games to claim the North Division 2nd half crown.

COMEBACK CARDS: Of the Cardinals' 23 games so far this season, they have fallen behind first in 15 of them. Of those 15 games, the Cards have won nine, making them 9-6 when their opponent scores first. Amazingly, despite Springfield's opponent scoring first in 11 of 12 games at Hammons Field, the Cardinals hold an 8-4 record at home this season.

BIRDS BOAST BEST DOUBLE-A OFFENSE: Despite being shut out for the first time this season and only managing three hits on Wednesday, Springfield's lineup still sits atop the Double-A level in several offensive categories. Through 23 games the Cardinals lead the three Double-A leagues with a .269 batting average; the Birmingham Barons are next at .264. The Cards also lead the the entire level in OBP (.359), RBIs (122) and runs scored (132), and are ranked 2nd in hits (207) and 5th in OPS (.745). Springfield has also been particularly productive hitting situationally, with 13 sacrifice flies this season, three more than any other team in Double-A.

The Cardinals have reached double-digit hits in 7 of their 23 games so far, and have 8 or more knocks in 17 games.

GRINDIN': Perhaps the Cardinal offense's greatest attribute is their ability to grind out at bats and put the ball in play. The Cardinals have struck out just 169 times in 23 games, the third-fewest in all of Minor League Baseball. The Cardinals only trail the Spokane Indians (143 K's) and Wisconsin Timber Rattlers (165 K's). The Indians, however, have played four fewer games than the Cardinals and Timber Rattlers (19). The Birds are averaging just 7.3 K's per game.

STAFF LOOKING TO GET BACK ON TRACK: Since the Cardinals' franchise-record nine-game winning streak to start the season, Springfield has struggled to prevent runs the way they did at the outset. Over their last 14 games since April 16, the Cards have a 6.37 ERA, the highest mark in the Texas League by nearly a run (Amarillo Sod Poodles, 5.43). Springfield's WHIP (1.67) and opponents batting average (.278) are also last in the league since April 16. Additionally, the 18 home runs the Redbirds have allowed over their last 14 games is most in the circuit during that time. The home run ball has not been a friend of the Cardinal staff so far this season: the Birds have allowed 28 longballs, tied for the highest total in the league with the Sod Poodles.

Over their first nine games, Springfield's staff sported a 2.88 ERA, the 2nd-best mark in the league during that time. The Cardinals are 6-8 since starting the season 9-0.

TORRES A TERROR: Springfield leadoff man Bryan Torres has set the tone atop the Cardinals lineup, leading the club with a .338 average and .417 OBP. Torres is also tied for 2nd in the Texas League in doubles (7) and is tied for 3rd in stolen bases (9).

YEAGER BOMBS: Cardinals infielder **RJ Yeager** has been Springfield's top run-producer so far this season, leading the club and ranking top-10 in the Texas League in home runs (5th), RBIs (t2nd), SLG (10th), and total bases (42)

TAKE ME TO CHURCH: Despite having a 13-game hitting streak snapped on Wednesday afternoon, Cardinals outfielder **Nathan Church** product ranks in the top 10 among qualified hitters in the Texas League in five different categories: batting average (6th; .333), RBIs (t3rd; 18), hits (2nd; 30), total bases (5th; 44), and runs (t6th; 17). **Church** was named Texas League Player of the Week two weeks ago after going 9-for-25 with 2 HR and 8 RBIs to go along with 6 BB in Amarillo from April 16-21. In 96 plate appearances this year, he has struck out just 7 times.

REDMOND TIES FRANCHISE RECORD FOR HOME RUNS: With his go-ahead two-run homer in the 8th inning on Tuesday night, Cardinals slugger **Chandler Redmond** tied the franchise record for most home runs in Springfield's 20-year franchise history. His 59 career home runs in a Springfield uniform bring him even with **Xavier Scruggs** (2010-13). **Redmond** already holds the Springfield record for career RBIs with 205.
