RUMBLE PONIES ON SNY: The Binghamton Rumble Ponies are pleased to announce that SportsNet New York (SNY), the flagship television home of the New York Mets, will be carrying at least eight Rumble Ponies games this season. The first three games that are scheduled to air on SNY are Game 2 of tonight's double-header, along with Saturday (1:05 PM) and Sunday (1:05) of this week against Reading. Rumble Ponies broadcasters Jacob Wilkins and Matt Levine will announce the games, which will be produced by the Rumble Ponies production crew. The games will also be streamed live to SNY subscribers on the SNY App. The SNY app is available for download on iOS, Android, tvIOS, Android TV, Apple TV, Fire TV and Roku.

STUART'S NOT LITTLE: Mets No. 18 prospect RHP **Tyler Stuart** will make his second start of the season tonight. Stuart allowed three earned runs on nine hits over 4.2 innings at Erie in his first start of the year on April 10. The 6-foot-9 right-hander led full-season Minor League qualifiers with a 2.20 ERA and ranked 12th among the 183 on that list with his 1.10 WHIP last season. Stuart last faced Reading on the road on July 27 of last season, where he allowed three runs over five innings with four strikeouts and earned the first win of his Double-A career.

18 STRIKEOUTS, TIES FRANCHISE RECORD: The Binghamton Rumble Ponies had four pitchers combine to strike out 18 batters in Tuesday's win over Reading, which tied a franchise record for strikeouts in a single game. It first happened on April 10, 1995, against New Haven (Colorado Rockies). RHP Max Kranick made a rehab start and struck out six batters over 2.2 hitless and scoreless innings. Trey McLoughlin struck out the lone batter he retired in relief. Blade Tidwell was electric and punched out 10 batters over 5.0 innings of relief and Wilkin Ramos struck out a batter in a perfect ninth to earn the save.

BLADE WAS SHARP: Mets No. 10 prospect RHP **Blade Tidwell** made the first relief appearance of his career, after Max Kranick's rehab start on Tuesday. Tidwell struck out 10 batters over five innings of work out of the bullpen and earned the victory. The 22-year-old struck out the side in his first inning of work and came up one strike out shy of tying his career high in a single game. Tidwell has 15 strikeouts over 10.2 innings with a 1.69 ERA and 1.03 WHIP across his first two appearances of the season.

PATIENT PARADA: Mets top catching prospect **Kevin Parada** has drawn seven walks over his first seven games of the 2024 season. The 22-year-old currently ranks second in the Eastern League with a .483 on-base percentage. His on-base percentage across three levels in 2023 was .324 and was .250 in Double-A. Parada is averaging a career-high 4.7 pitches per plate appearance. Last season, Parada averaged seeing 3.7 pitches per plate appearance.

GUTS GLORY RAM: Mets No. 16 prospect **Alex Ramírez** is off to a hot start to his Double-A career. The 21-year-old is hitting .353 over his first nine Double-A games. Ramírez has three multi-hit games, four extra base hits, including a homer, two doubles, a triple, two walks, four RBIs, and is 5-for-6 in stolen bases in nine games. Ramírez is currently tied for the second-most stolen bases in the Eastern League. He is riding a four-game hitting streak, hitting .375 (6-for-16).

-Reid Brignac (pronounced Brin-yac) is coming off leading the Rumble Ponies to the postseason last season, for the first time since 2017. In 2023, under Brignac's tutelage, the Ponies went on a second-half surge, going 39-27 overall and 17-5 over their last 22 games. Brignac's team swept the Somerset Patriots in the Eastern League Division Series to lead the Ponies to the ELCS before falling to Erie.

Brignac also was the Mets' representative on the Arizona Fall League coaching staff after that season,

-Brignac enjoyed a long and successful playing career, spending parts of nine years in the major leagues with the Tampa Bay Rays, Colorado Rockies, Atlanta Braves, Philadelphia Phillies, New York Yankees, and Miami Marlins. He was initially drafted by the Rays in the second round of the 2004 MLB Draft, out of St. Amant High School.

-AJ Sager was named the 2023 New York Mets Minor League Staff Member of the Year for his efforts last year. Sager's pitching staff in 2023 set a Binghamton franchise record with 15 shutouts and took home five Eastern League honors, highlighted by Mike Vasil winning Eastern League Pitcher of the Month for May and Dom Hamel being named EL Pitcher of the Month for September. Sager's staff also ranked first among the 30 Double-A clubs in strike rate and walks issued, and second in opponent on-base percentage. On September 7 at Hartford, right-hander Joander Suarez threw the eighth no-hitter in franchise history, facing the minimum 21 batters over seven innings.

-Sager previously spent 20 years coaching in the Detroit Tigers organization and pitched for parts of five seasons in the major leagues, playing for the San Diego Padres, Colorado Rockies, and Tigers as part of a 12-year professional career. In 123 major league appearances, the right-hander was 12-15, with five saves and a 5.36 ERA. Sager was originally drafted by

the Padres in the 10th round of the 1988 MLB Draft, out of the University of Toledo.
